With More than 4 Cr COVID19 vaccine doses, India crosses a Landmark Milestone

18.16 lakh vaccine doses given till 7 pm today

India has scaled a landmark peak in its fight against COVID. As part of the world's largest vaccination exercise, more than 4 Crore doses have been administered.


A total of 4,11,55,978 vaccine doses have been given, as per the provisional report till **7pm** today.

These include **76,86,920** HCWs who have taken the 1st dose and **47,69,469** HCWs who have taken the 2nd dose, **79,10,529**FLWs (1stdose), **23,16,922** FLWs (2nd dose), **1,53,78,622** beneficiaries more than 60 years old and **30,93,516** beneficiaries aged 45 and above with specific co-morbidities.

Total 18,16,161**vaccine doses were given till 7 pm today, the Sixty Third day** of nationwide COVID19 vaccination. Out of which 16,43,357 beneficiaries were vaccinated for 1st dose and 1,72,804 HCWs and FLWs received 2nd dose of vaccine as per the provisional report. Final reports would be completed for the day by late tonight.
