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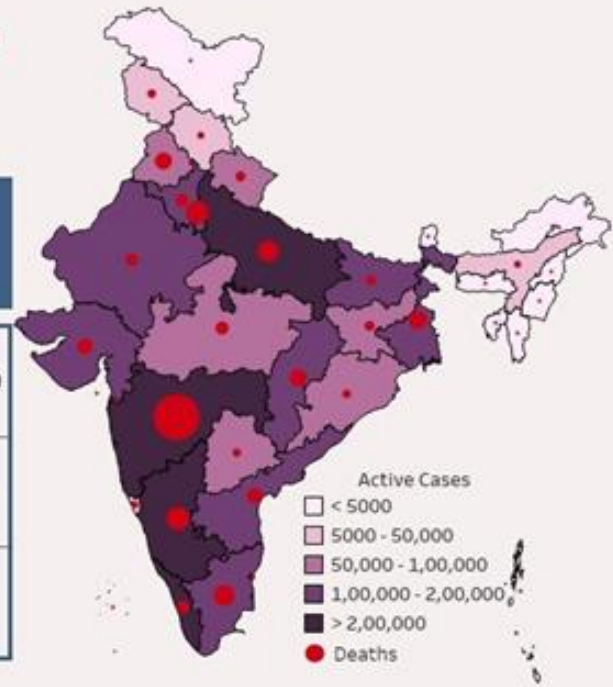

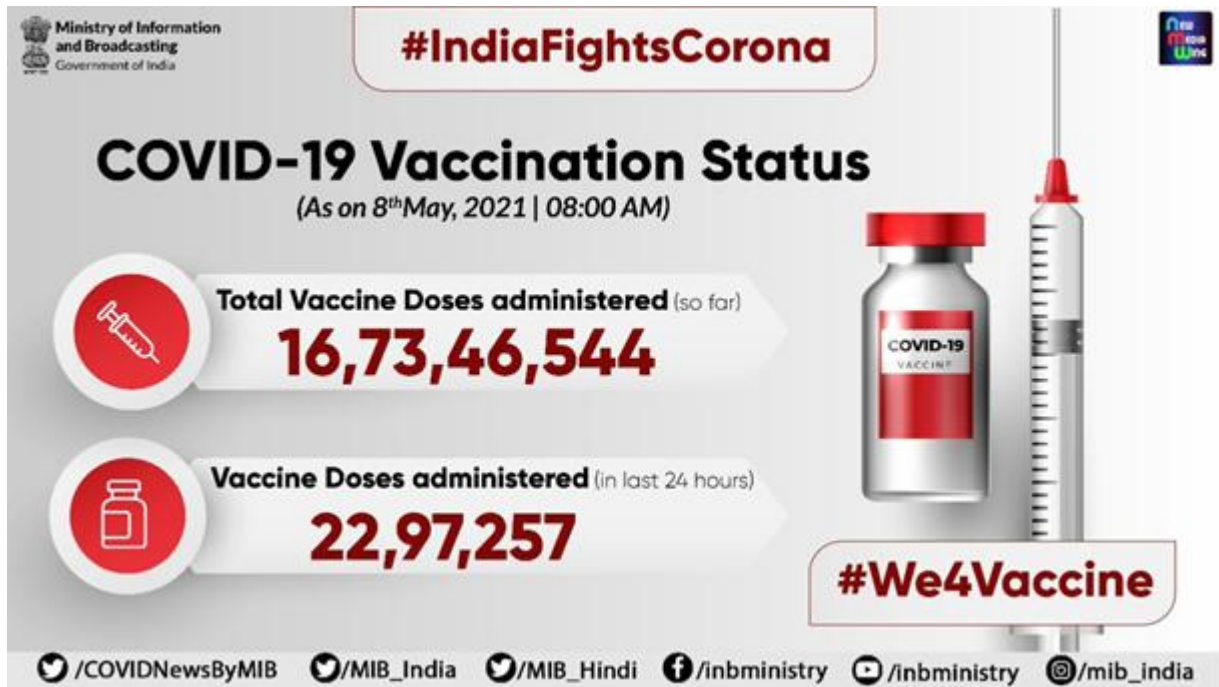

DCGI approves anti-COVID drug developed by DRDO for emergency use

f An anti-COVID-19 therapeutic application of the drug 2-deoxy-D-glucose (2-DG) has been developed by Institute of Nuclear Medicine and Allied Sciences (INMAS), a lab of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), in collaboration with Dr Reddy's Laboratories (DRL), Hyderabad. **t** Clinical trial results have shown that this molecule helps in faster recovery of hospitalised patients and reduces supplemental oxygen dependence. Higher proportion of patients treated with 2-DG showed RT-PCR negative conversion in COVID patients. The drug will be of immense benefit to the people **c** suffering from COVID-19.

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Positive Test for COVID-19 virus Now Not Mandatory for Admission to a COVID Health Facility

- a. Requirement of a positive test for COVID-19 virus is not mandatory for admission to a COVID health facility. A suspect case shall be admitted to the suspect ward of CCC, DCHC or DHC as the case may be.
- b. No patient will be refused services on any count. This includes medications such as oxygen or essential drugs even if the patient belongs to a different city.
- c. No patient shall be refused admission on the ground that he/she is not able to produce a valid identity card that does not belong to the city where the hospital is located.
- d. Admissions to hospital must be based on need. It should be ensured that beds are not occupied by persons who do not need hospitalization. Further, the discharge should be strictly in accordance with the revised discharge policy available at <https://www.mohfw.gov.in/pdf/ReviseddischargePolicyforCOVID19.pdf>

पान के पत्ते के सेवन से कोरोना वायरस के प्रकोप से बचा जा सकता है। यह कहना है हरिद्वार के प्रसिद्ध वैद्य एमआर शर्मा का। विश्वने शीतल दशको से आयुर्वेद के अध्ययन से देश के लोगों को सेवा कर रहे वैद्य एमआर शर्मा ने एक विशेष श्रेट में बताया कि पान का पत्ता एक औषधि के रूप में इस्तेमाल किया जाता है, जिसमें कोरोना वायरस जैसे भयंकर संक्रमण से बचा जा सकता है। वैद्य एमआर शर्मा ने बताया कि एक पान का पत्ता सुबह और एक पत्ता रात को खाने से कोरोना वायरस के भयंकर को खति नहीं होगी। यदि किसी को वायरस है तो वह भी खत्म हो जाएगा, कोरोना वायरस के भयंकर को पान के पत्ते का रस देने से उसको खत्म मिलेगा। वैद्य एमआर शर्मा ने कहा कि 10 वर्षों से काम के बन्धु को आधा पत्ता सुबह और आधा पत्ता रात को देते लक्षण मिलेगा। उन्होंने बताया कि पान को

कि यदि रस के रूप में पान का सेवन करना है

तो साठ या बीस पान का इस्तेमाल किया जा सकता है। आपको कहते हैं कि पूरा और धार्मिक कार्य में इसका उपयोग करने से लेकर इसे 'पान' के रूप में खाने तक, पान के पत्ते में कई रोगों को ठीक करने के औषधीय गुण और हीलिंग गुण लभ होते हैं। पान के पत्ते में विटामिन सी, थायामिन, निपासिन, राइबोफ्लेविन और कैरोटीन जैसे विटामिन पाए जाते हैं और ये कैल्शियम का एक बड़ा स्रोत है। पान में विटामिन सी, थायामिन, कैरोटीन, फाइबर, आयरन और थायामिन पाए जाते हैं, इसलिए इसका उपयोग आयुर्वेदिक चिकित्सा में किया जाता है।

पान का इस्तेमाल कर लोगों को खराब होने से रोकना जा सकता है। अन्ना और भुजिया का इस्तेमाल किया जा सकता है, खांसी से राहत पान में मदद की जा सकती है और ओकटाटिस जैसे रक्तस्राव विकारी को भी ठीक किया जा सकता है। यह भी कहा जाता है कि पान में मौजूद पटक रक्त में शर्करा के स्तर को कम कर सकते हैं। इस प्रकार पान के पत्ते का औषधीय गुण

Can you get COVID-19
even after vaccination?



Vaccination is crucial to prevent COVID-19. **Only 0.03%-0.04% of the people have contracted COVID-19** after vaccination and even then they have had mild symptoms.

Vaccine will not allow the virus to further replicate and it will not allow the disease to become more severe. But during that time, your RT-PCR test can be positive and you maybe infectious to others so it's important to follow COVID-19 appropriate behaviour even after vaccination.
