## COVID-19 Vaccination Update- Day 119



India crosses a major landmark with more than 18 Cr Cumulative Vaccination Coverage



Over 3.25 lakh beneficiaries of age group 18-44 Vaccinated today till 8 pm

More than 10.79 lakh vaccine doses administered today

India has crossed a significant landmark in its fight against COVID19 pandemic today. The cumulative number of COVID19 vaccine doses administered in the country has crossed **18 Cr**. The cumulative number of COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in the country stands at **18,04,29,261** as per the 8 pm provisional report today.

3,25,071 beneficiaries of the age group 18-44 years received their first dose of COVID vaccine today and cumulatively **42,55,362** across 32 States/UTs since the start of Phase-3 of the vaccination drive. Table below shows the cumulative vaccine doses administered to 18-44 years age group till now.

The total of **18,04,29,261** include **96,27,199** Healthcare Workers (HCWs) who have taken the 1<sup>st</sup> dose and **66,21,675** HCWs who have taken the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose, **1,43,63,754** Frontline Workers (FLWs) (1<sup>st</sup> dose), **81,48,757** FLWs (2<sup>nd</sup> dose), and **42,55,362** for 18-44 years of age group (1<sup>st</sup> dose). **5,67,99,389** for over 45 years old to 60 years old (1<sup>st</sup> Dose), **87,50,224** for over 45 years old to 60 years old (2<sup>nd</sup> dose), **5,43,15,317** for above 60 years (1<sup>st</sup> Dose) and **1,75,47,584** for above 60 years (2<sup>nd</sup> Dose).

As on Day-119 of the vaccination drive (14<sup>th</sup> May, 2021), total **10,79,759** vaccine doses were given. 6,16,781 beneficiaries were vaccinated for 1<sup>st</sup> dose and 4,62,978 beneficiaries received 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of vaccine as per the provisional report till 8 P.M. Final reports would be completed for the day by late night.
