
Recovery Rate increases to 95.26%




India has been witnessing a continuous fall in the active caseload. The country's Active Caseload today stands at 10,26,159. The Caseload has been below 20 lakhs for thirteen successive days.

A net decline of **54,531** is witnessed in the last 24 hours and active cases are now only **3.49%** of the country's total Positive Cases.




As more people are getting recovered from COVID-19 infection, India's Daily Recoveries continue to outnumber the Daily New Cases for 31 consecutive days now. **1,32,062** recoveries were registered in the last 24 hours. **51,228** more recoveries were reported during the last 24 hours as compared to the daily new cases.


Out of the people infected since the beginning of the pandemic, 2,80,43,446 people have already recovered from COVID-19 & 1,32,062 patients have recovered in the last 24 hours. This constitutes an overall recovery rate of 95.26%, which is showing a sustained increasing trend.



With substantially ramped up testing capacity across the country, a total of 19,00,312 tests were conducted in the last 24 hours in the country. Cumulatively India has conducted over 37.81 crore (37,81,32,474) tests so far.

While on one side testing has been enhanced across the country, a continued decline in weekly case positivity is noticed. Weekly Positivity Rate is currently at 4.74% while the Daily Positivity rate stands at 4.25% today. It has remained less than 10% for 20 consecutive days now.
