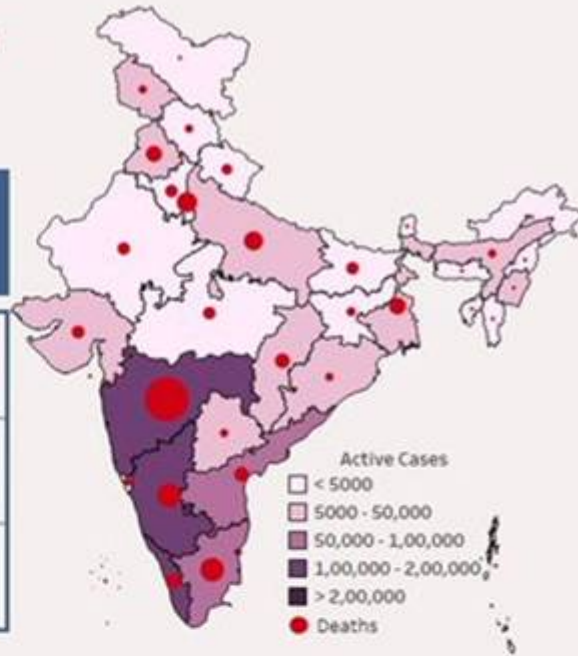

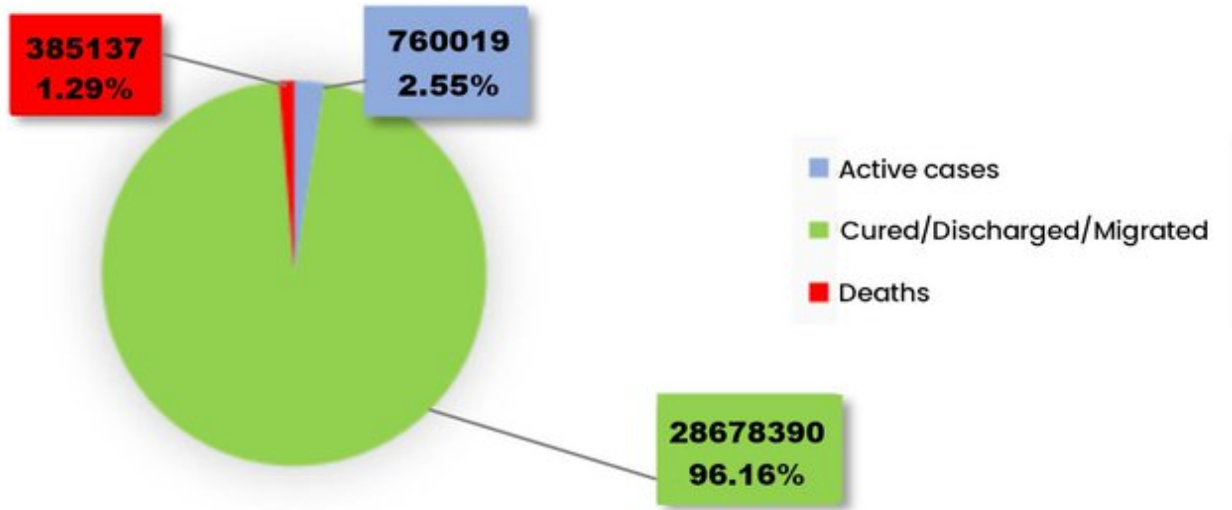

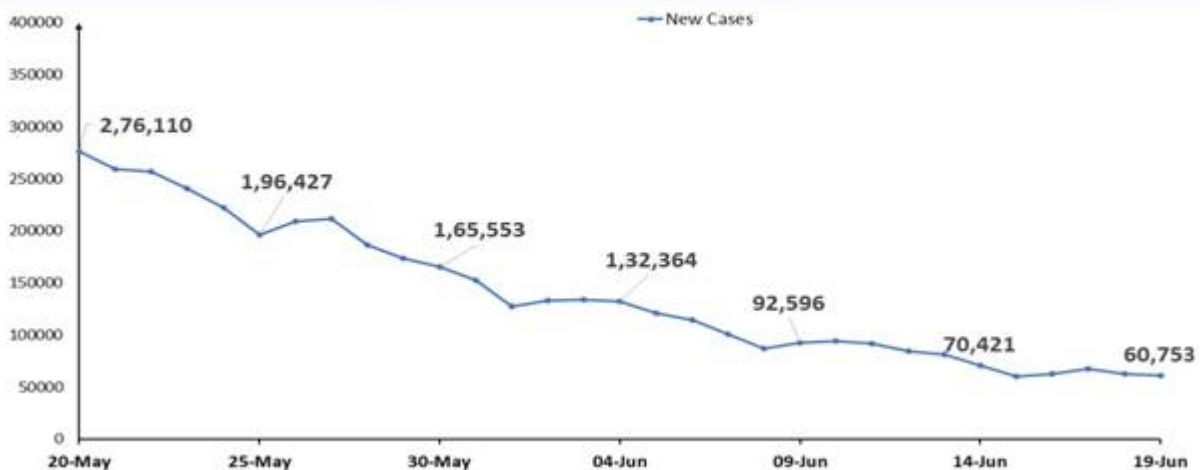
India reports 60,753 New Cases in the last 24 hours

- Active Caseload declines to 7,60,019; lowest after 74 days
- Daily Recoveries continue to outnumber Daily New Cases for the 37th consecutive day
- Recovery Rate steadily increases to 96.16
- Daily Positivity Rate stands at 2.98%; less than 5% positivity for 12 consecutive days

India continues to report a sustained slide in the daily new COVID cases. The country has reported **60,753 Daily New Cases** in the last 24 hours.

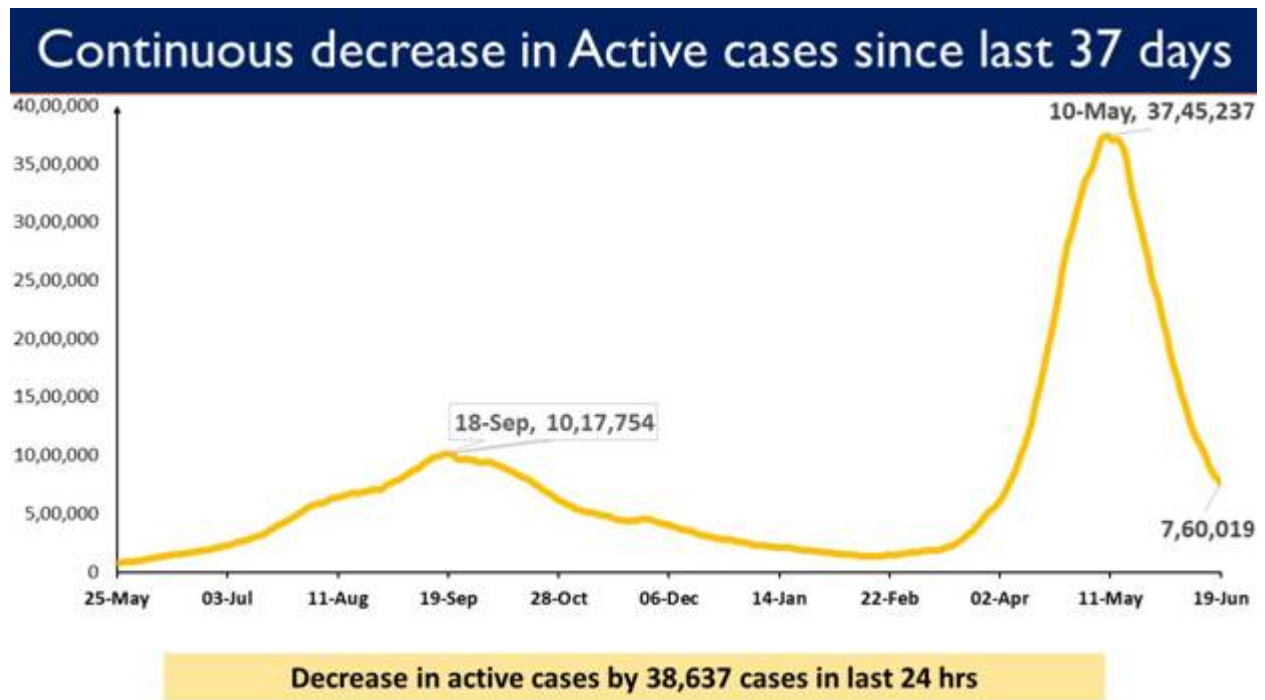
**Less than 1 lakh Daily New Cases** have been reported for **12 continuous days now**. This is a result of sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs.

### Decline in daily new cases (60K reported in last 24 hrs)



India has also been witnessing a continuous fall in the active caseload. The country's Active Caseload today stands at 7,60,019. **This is the lowest reported active cases after 74 days.**

A net decline of **38,637** is witnessed in the last 24 hours and active cases are now only **2.55%** of the country's total Positive Cases.



As more people are getting recovered from COVID-19 infection, India's Daily Recoveries continue to outnumber the Daily New Cases for 37 consecutive days now. **97,743** recoveries were registered in the last 24 hours.

Nearly 37 thousand (**36,990**) more recoveries were reported during the last 24 hours as compared to the daily new cases.

### COVID-19 Vaccination Update

More than 28.50 crore (28,50,99,130) vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far, through Government of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category. Of this, the total consumption, including wastages is 25,63,28,045 doses (as per data available at 8 AM today).

More than 2.87 crore (2,87,71,085) COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered. Furthermore, more than 52,26,460 vaccine doses are in the pipeline and will be received by the States/UTs within the next 3 days.

### **New Software helps identify patients likely to require ventilator support thus detecting emergency & ICU needs early**

 A software can now identify patients likely to require ventilator support in an ICU and referral in time and make necessary arrangements before emergency sets in. The software called Covid Severity Score (CSS) Software consists of an algorithm that measures a set of parameters. It scores each against a pre-set dynamic algorithm multiple times for each patient and allocates a Covid Severity Score (CSS) mapping it in a graphical trend.

in The technology is being used in three community Covid care centres at Kolkata and suburbs including a 100-bed government mandated Covid care centre at Barrackpore, Kolkata.

### **Union Minister Shri Hardeep Puri addresses media on installation of Oxygen Generation Plants in Punjab (18<sup>th</sup> June, 2021)**

The recent experience with Covid-19 pandemic has shown the importance of ensuring adequate availability of oxygen in hospitals. Installation of Pressure Swing Adsorption (PSA) Oxygen Generation Plants in various health care facilities would help avoid disruption of oxygen supplies, reduce dependence on LMO storage and supply of cylinders or tanks.

Accordingly based on the requests received from States/UTs, earlier 162 PSA Plants in October, 2020 and recently 75, 52 and 200 plants were sanctioned under PM Cares Fund on 10.05.2021, 10.05.2021 and 22.05.2021 respectively. Considering further demand and need to make available these facilities in each district of the country, all the requests received from States/ UTS have been reviewed comprehensively in close consultation and collaboration with States/ UTs. Based on this exercise, a total of 1,215 PSA Plants (including those already conveyed earlier) have been sanctioned under PM Cares Fund.
