India's COVID19 Vaccination Coverage crosses the landmark of 29 cr



India reports 50,848 New Cases in the last 24 hours



On a downward trajectory, India's Active Caseload further declines to 6,43,194; lowest in 82 days

Daily Recoveries outnumber Daily New Cases for 41st consecutive day

Recovery Rate increases to 96.56%

Daily Positivity Rate stands at 2.67%, less than 5% positivity for 16 consecutive days

In yet another significant development, India's cumulative vaccination coverage has exceeded 29 Crores yesterday. A total of **29,46,39,511** vaccine doses have been administered through 39,49,630 sessions, as per the provisional report till 7 am today. 54,24,374 vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours.

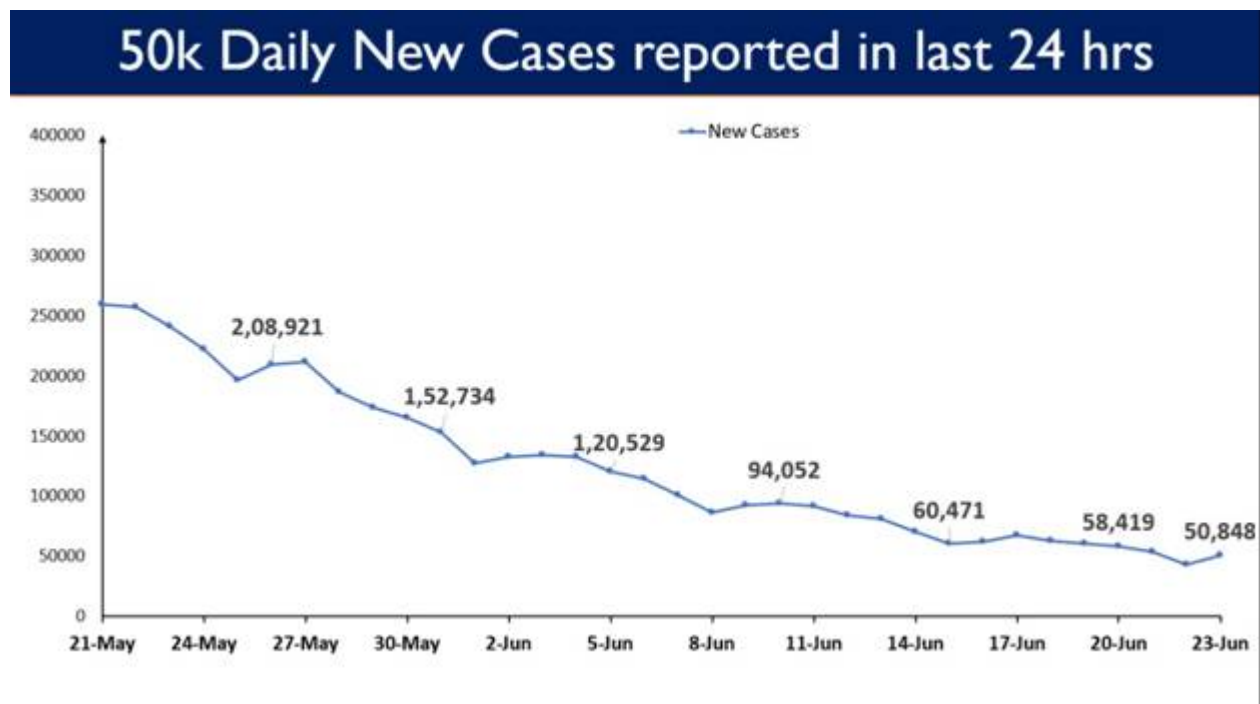

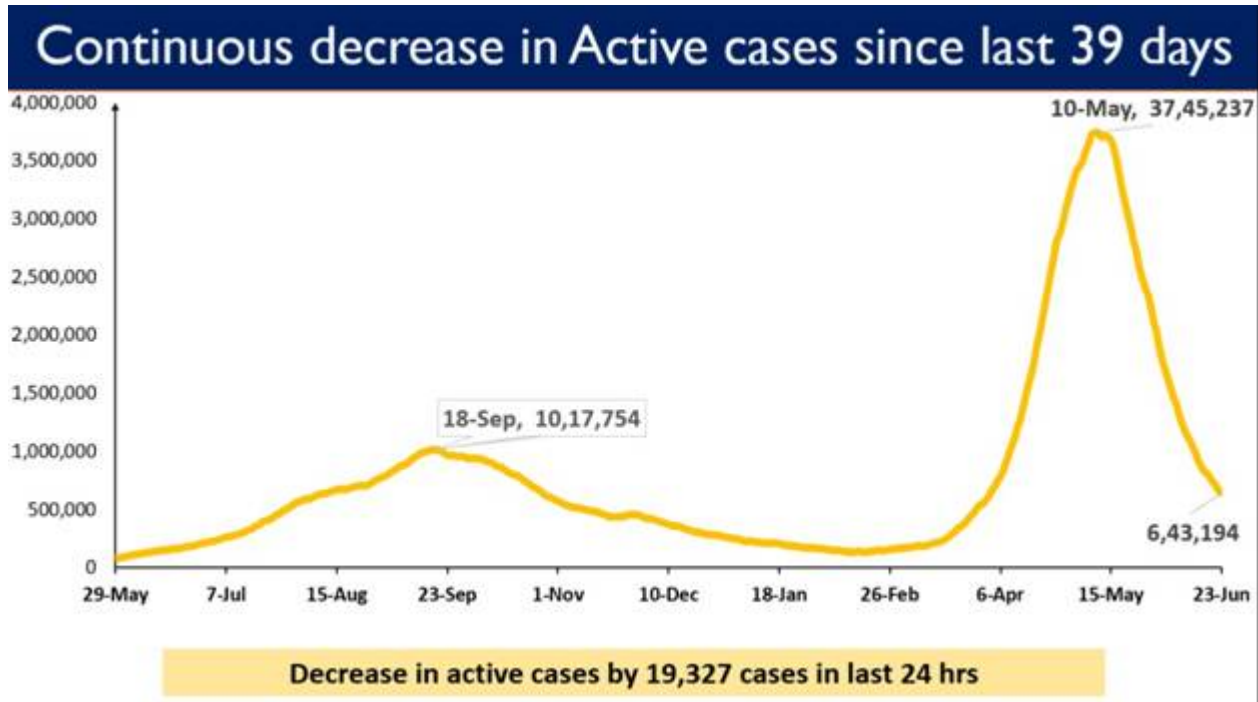
**India has reported 50,848 new cases in the last 24 hours.**

**Less than 1 lakh Daily New Cases** have been reported for **16 continuous days now**. This is a result of sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs.



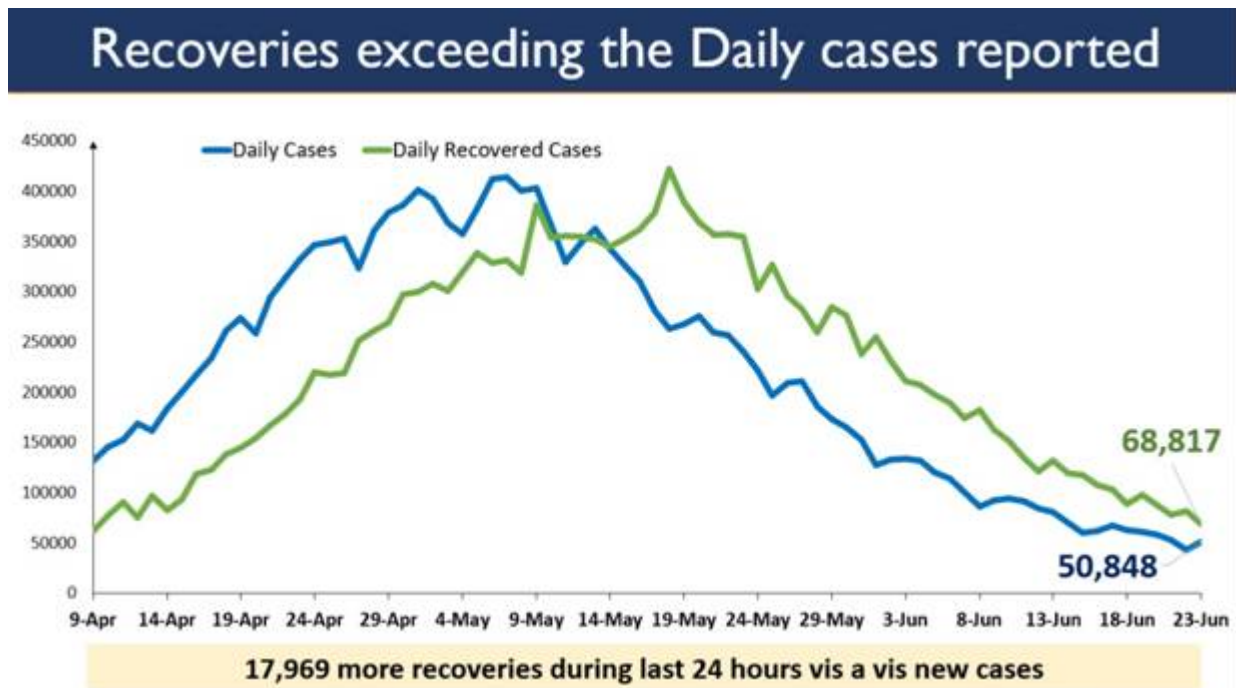
India has also been witnessing a continuous fall in the active caseload. The country's Active Caseload today stands at 6,43,194 today. This is the lowest in 82 days.

A net decline of 19,327 is witnessed in the last 24 hours and active cases are now only 2.14% of the country's total Positive Cases.

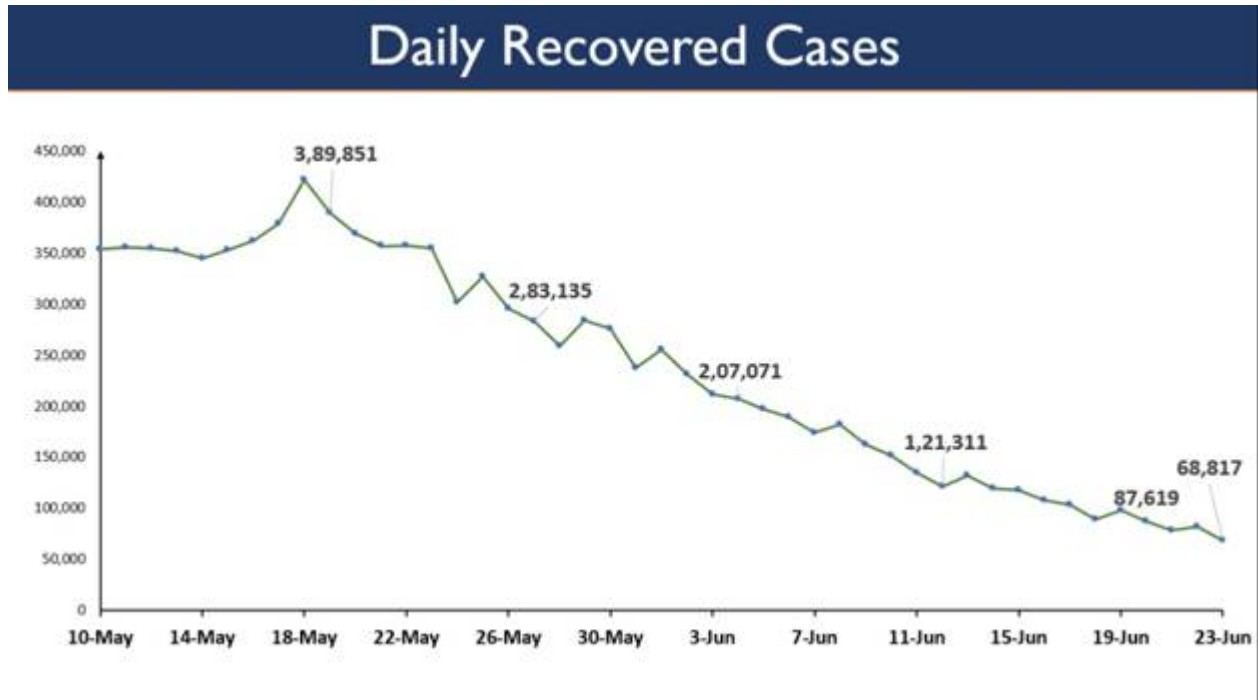


As more people are getting recovered from COVID-19 infection, India's Daily Recoveries continue to outnumber the Daily New Cases for 41 consecutive days now. 68,817 recoveries were registered in the last 24 hours.

Nearly 18,000(17,969) more recoveries were reported during the last 24 hours as compared to the daily new cases.

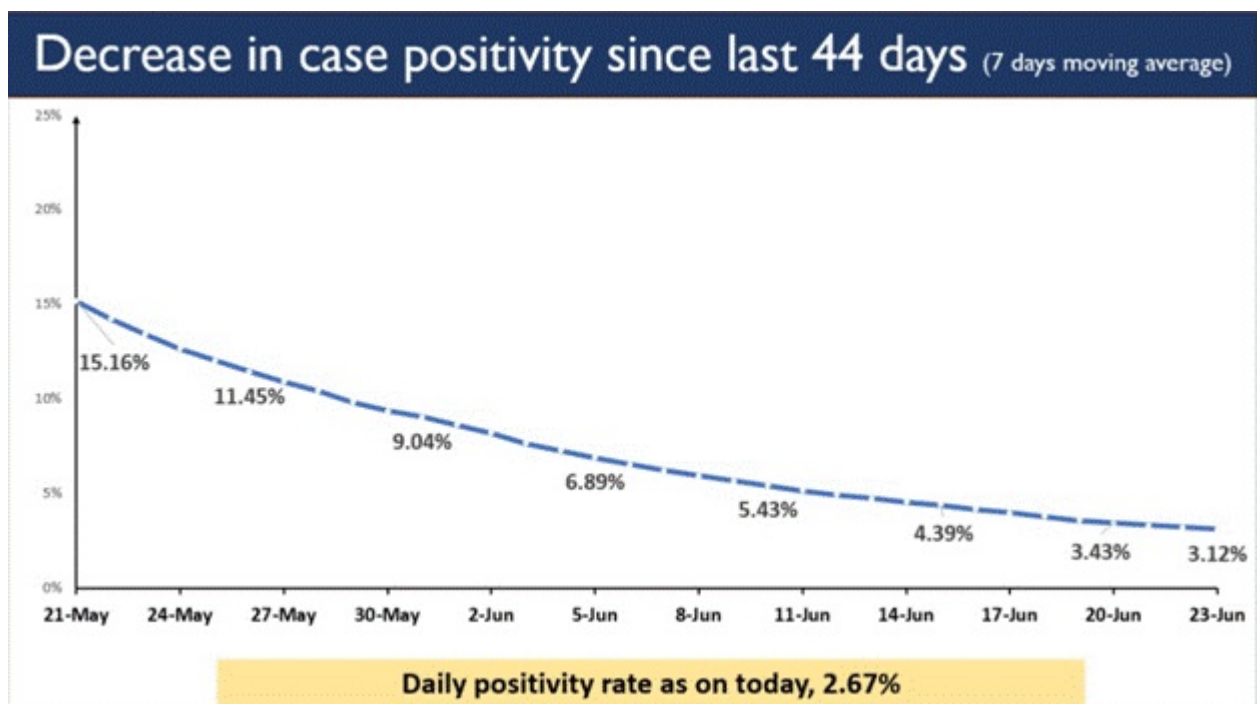


**f** Out of the people infected since the beginning of the pandemic, **2,89,94,855** people have already recovered from COVID-19 and **68,817** patients have recovered in the last 24 hours. This constitutes an overall recovery rate of **96.56%**, which is showing a sustained increasing trend.



With substantially ramped up testing capacity across the country, a total of 19,01,056 tests were conducted in the last 24 hours in the country. Cumulatively, India has conducted over 39.59 crore (39,59,73,198) tests so far.

While on one side testing has been enhanced across the country, a continued decline in weekly case positivity is noticed. **Weekly Positivity Rate is currently at 3.12%** while the **Daily Positivity rate stands at 2.67% today**. It has remained less than 5% for 16 consecutive days now.
