India's COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage achieves landmark milestone of 45 Cr

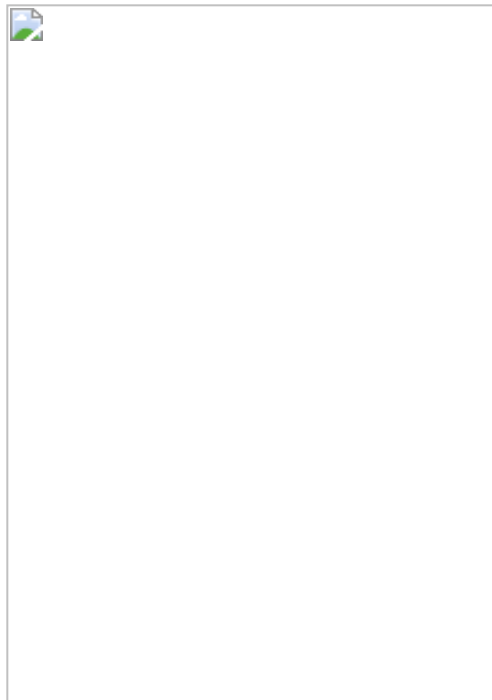


**in** Nearly 40 lakh Vaccine Doses administered today till 7 pm

More than 15.38 Cr Vaccine doses administered in the age group 18-44, so far

India's Cumulative COVID Vaccination Coverage has achieved the landmark milestone of **45 crore (45,02,55,460)**, as per the 7 pm provisional report today. The new phase of universalization of COVID-19 vaccination commenced from 21<sup>st</sup> June. **Nearly 40 lakh (39,42,457)** Vaccine Doses have been administered today, as per the 7 pm provisional report.



**f** **20,54,874** vaccine doses were administered as first dose and **3,00,099** vaccine doses given as second dose in the age group 18-44 years today. Cumulatively, **14,66,22,393 persons in the age group 18-44 years** across 37 States/UTs have received their first dose and total **71,92,485** have received their second dose since the start of Phase-3 of the vaccination drive. Five States namely **Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh** have administered more than 1 Crore Cumulative Doses of COVID-19 Vaccine in the age group 18-44 years. Also, **Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Haryana, Jharkhand, Kerala, Telangana, Himachal Pradesh, Odisha, Punjab, Uttarakhand and West Bengal** have vaccinated more than 10 lakh beneficiaries of the age group 18-44 years for the first dose of COVID vaccine.

Final reports would be completed for the day by late tonight.
