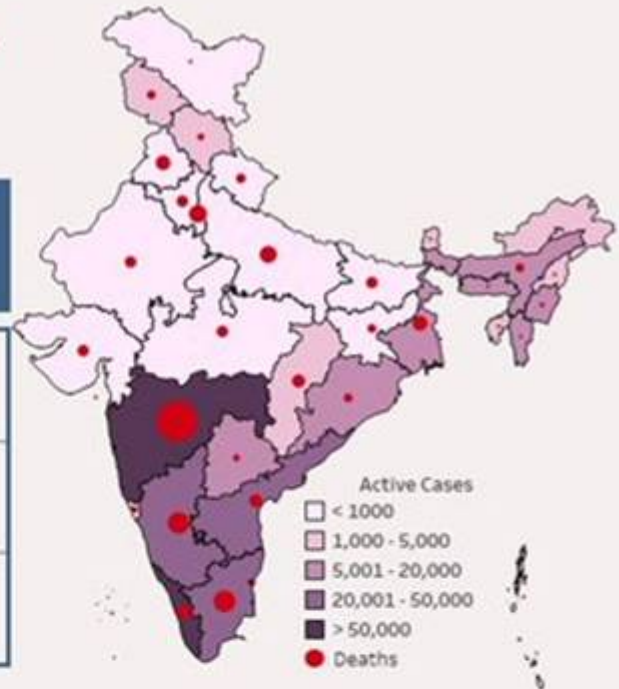

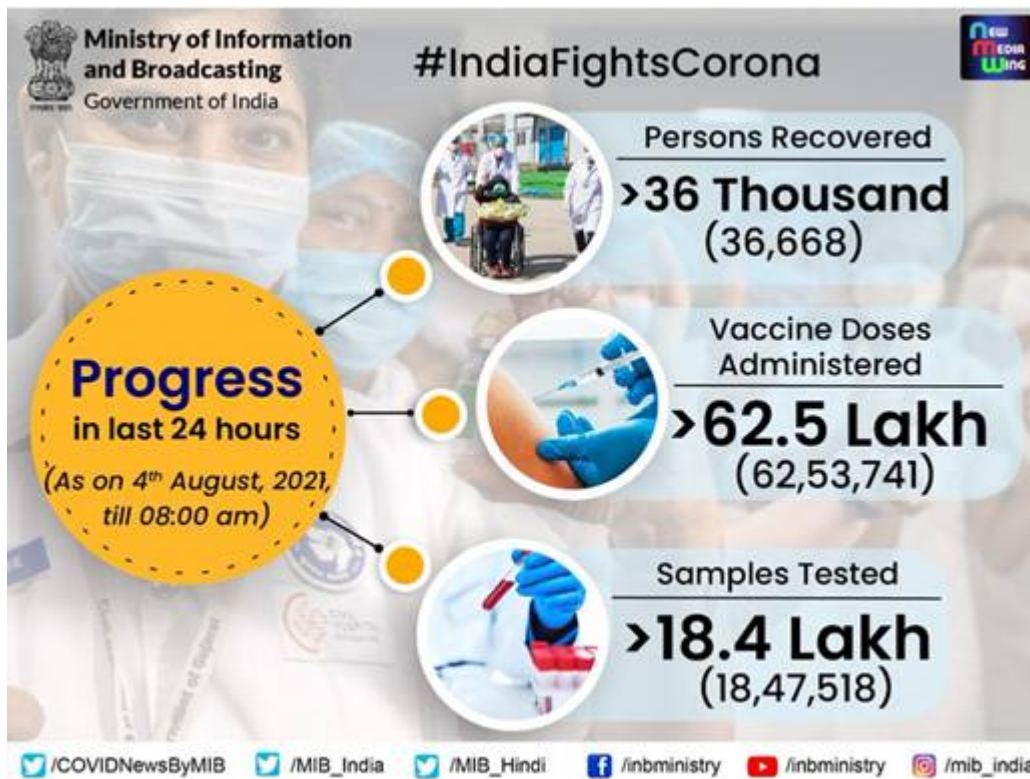
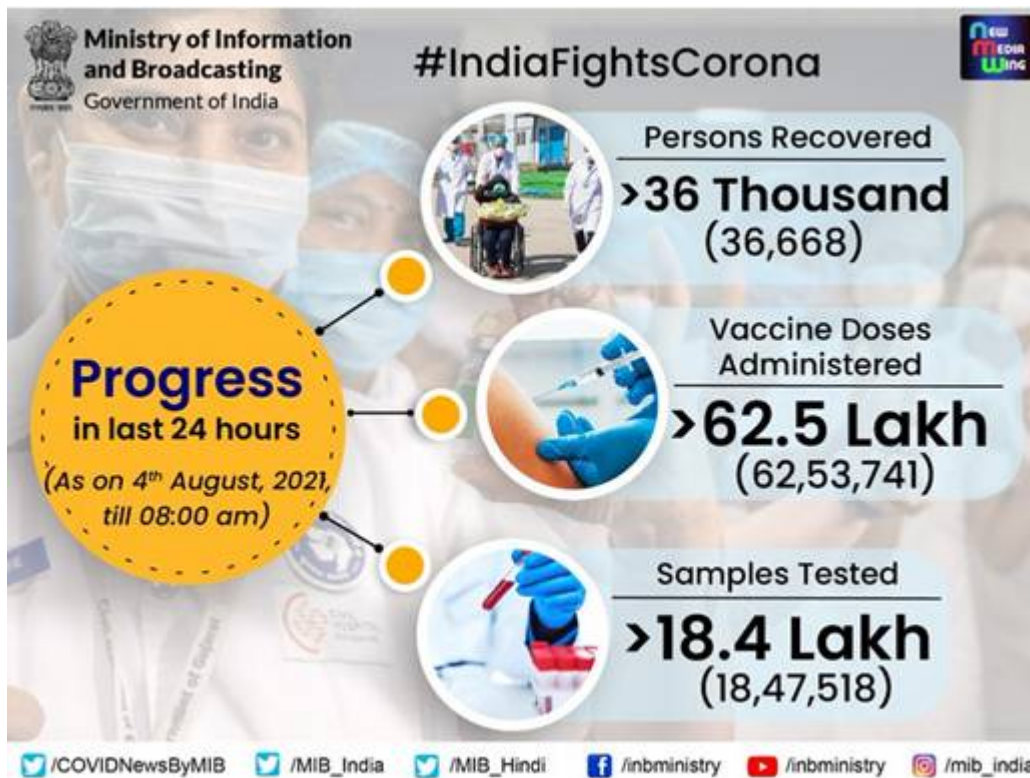

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India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has crossed a landmark of 48 Cr yesterday.

Cumulatively, **48,52,86,570** vaccine doses have been administered through **56,83,682** sessions, as per the provisional report till 7 am today. **62,53,741** vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours. These

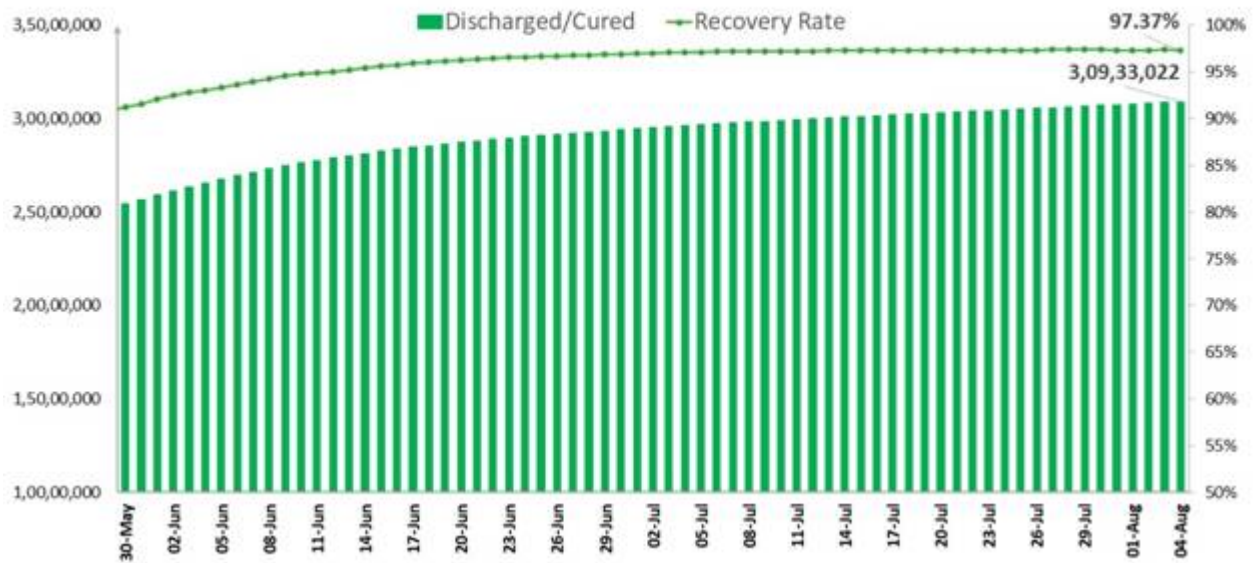

The new phase of universalization of COVID-19 vaccination has commenced from 21st June, 2021. The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country.

Out of the people infected since the beginning of the pandemic, **3,09,33,022 people have already recovered from COVID-19** and **36,668** patients have recovered in the last 24 hours. This constitutes an overall recovery rate of **97.37%**.



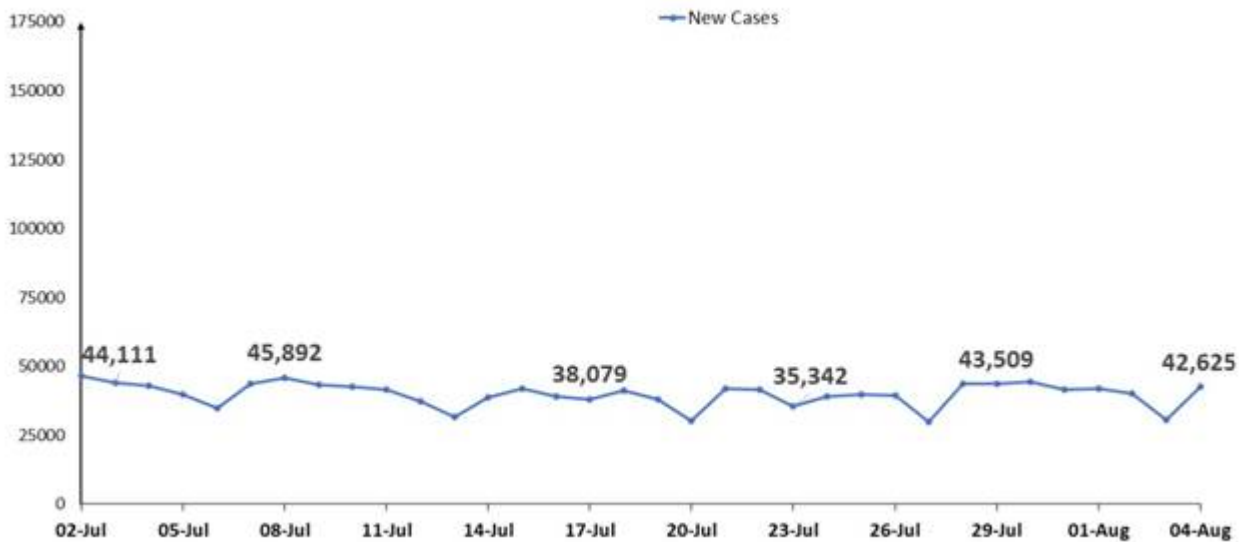
# Recovered cases over 3.09 Cr & Recovery rate at 97.37%



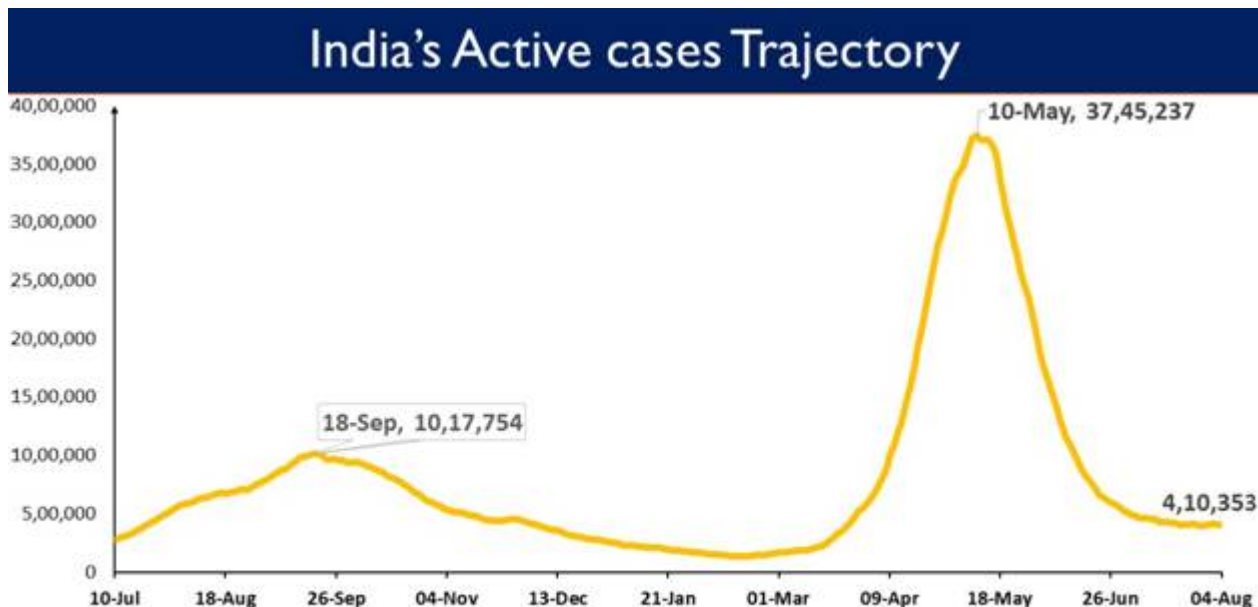
India has reported 42,625 daily new cases in the last 24 hours.

Less than 50,000 Daily New Cases have been reported since thirty-eight consecutive days. This is a result of sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs.

# 42k Daily New Cases reported in last 24 hrs



India's Active Caseload today stands at **4,10,353** and active cases now constitute **1.29%** of the country's total Positive Cases.



With substantially ramped up testing capacity across the country, a total of 18,47,518 tests were conducted in the last 24 hours in the country. Cumulatively, India has conducted over **47.31 crore (47,31,42,307)** tests so far.

While on one side testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate is currently stands at 2.36%** and the **Daily Positivity rate stands at 2.31% today**. Daily Positivity rate has remained below 5% for 58 consecutive days now.

### COVID-19 Vaccination Update

**More than 50.37 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs**

**More than 2.60 Crore balance and unutilized doses still available with States/UTs and private hospitals to be administered**

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **50.37 crore (50,37,22,630)** vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far, through all sources and a further **49,19,780** doses are in the pipeline.

Of this, the total consumption including wastages is **48,19,75,798** doses (as per data available at 8 AM today).

More than **2.60 Cr (2,60,17,573)** balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs and private hospitals to be administered.

### **COVID-19 Mortality- Myths Vs. Facts**

**Union Health Ministry has highlighted need for all states to monitor district wise cases and deaths on a daily basis**

**MoHFW has advised States and UTs through formal communications, video conferences and through deployment of Central teams for recording of deaths in accordance with prescribed guidelines**

**Robustness of statute based Civil Registration System (CRS) ensures proper recording of births and deaths in the country**

There have been some speculative media reports inferring undercounting of COVID-19 deaths from eight states, while also stating that the deaths can only be estimated and the exact data may never be known. The report highlights data from the Civil Registration System (CRS) and Health Management Information System (HMIS) including all-cause death numbers, leading to erroneous inferences terming it as 'counting the uncounted.'

It is clarified that given the robust and statute-based Death Registration System in India, while some cases could go undetected as per the principles of Infectious Disease & its management, missing out on deaths is completely unlikely. This could also be seen in the case fatality rate, which as on 31st December 2020 stood at 1.45% and even after an unexpected surge observed in the second wave in April-May 2021, the case fatality rate today stands at 1.34%.

Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India Prof. K. Vijay Raghavan virtually inaugurated a decentralized biomedical waste incinerator at Buxar Municipality, Bihar. The technology developed by Ganesh Engineering Works was selected through the Biomedical Waste Treatment Innovation Challenge launched in June 2020 by the Waste to Wealth Mission. The mission is one of the nine scientific missions of the Prime Minister's Science, Technology, and Innovation Advisory Council (PM-STIAC) and is spearheaded by the Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India.
