India's Cumulative COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage crosses 61 Cr landmark milestone



in Nearly 68 lakh Vaccine Doses administered today till 7 pm

In a significant achievement, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has crossed **61 Crore (61,10,43,573) landmark milestone** as per the 7 pm provisional report today. Nearly **68 lakh (67,87,305) Vaccine Doses** have been administered today, as per the 7 pm provisional report. Final reports would be completed for the day by late tonight.
