### India's Cumulative COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage crosses 63 Cr landmark milestone



### in More than 65 lakh Vaccine Doses administered today till 7 pm

In a significant achievement, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has crossed **63 Crore (63,00,67,629) landmark milestone** as per the 7 pm provisional report today. More than **65 lakh (65,39,745) Vaccine Doses** have been administered today, as per the 7 pm provisional report. Final reports would be completed for the day by late tonight.
