**India achieves Highest ever Single-Day Vaccination Coverage with the administration of over 1.33 Cr doses**

**India's Cumulative COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage exceeds 65.41 Cr**

**in** In a landmark achievement, India administered more than 1 Crore COVID-19 vaccine doses yesterday. This feat has been achieved twice in last 5 days. With the administration of **1,33,18,718** vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has surpassed the cumulative figure of 65.41 Cr (**65,41,13,508**) as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 69,06,357 sessions.

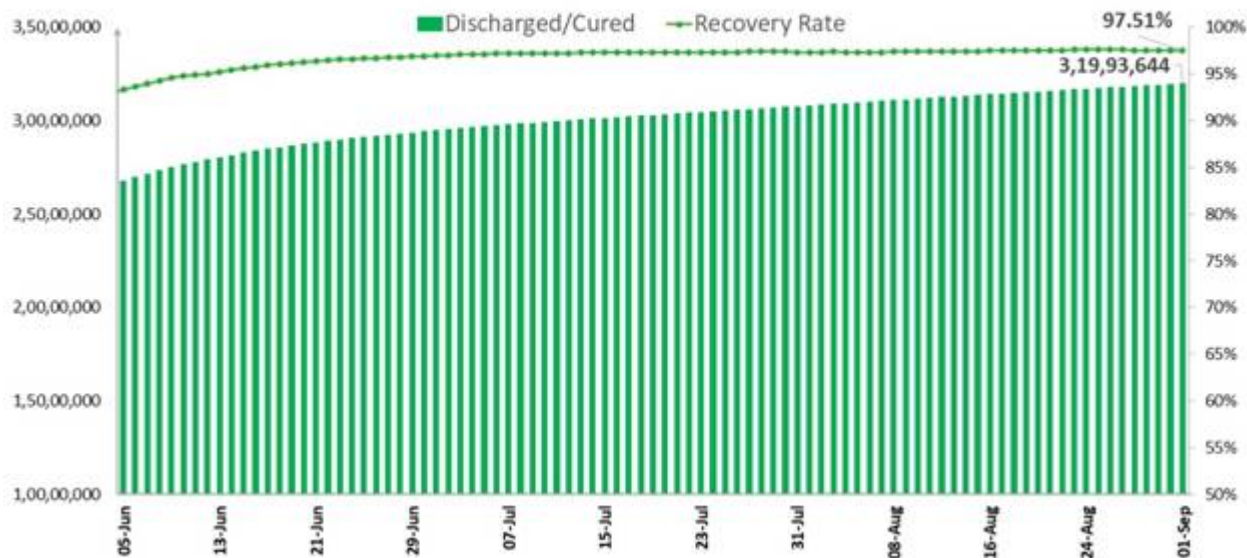

## Recovered cases over 3.19 Cr & Recovery rate at 97.51%

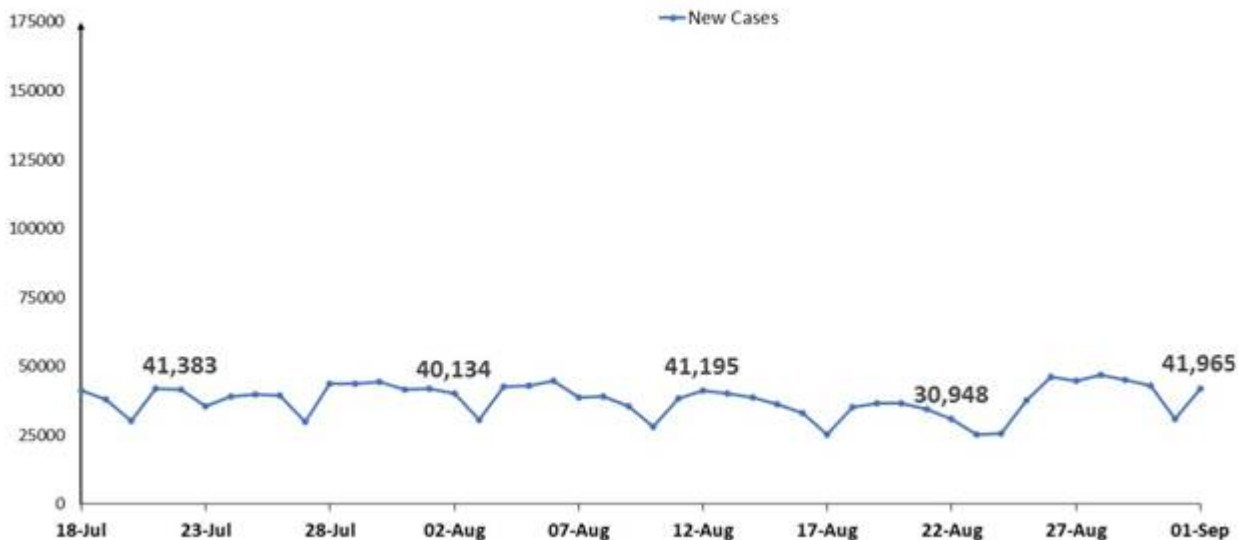

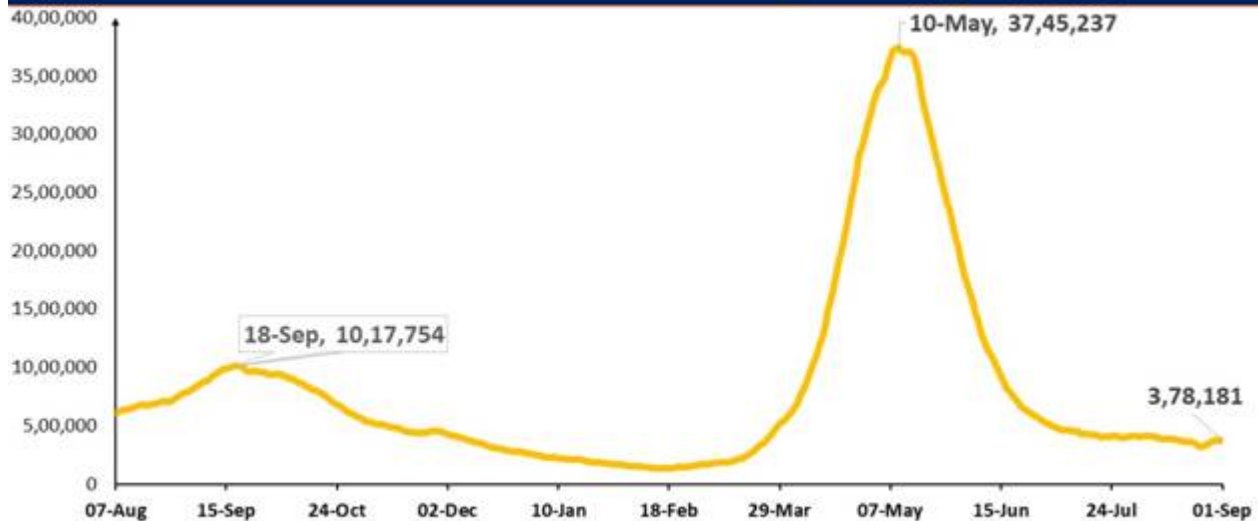
41,965 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

# India's Active cases Trajectory



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of 16,06,785 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **52.31 Cr (52,31,84,293)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 2.58% remains less than 3% for the last 68 days now.** The **Daily Positivity rate stands at 2.61%.** The daily Positivity rate has remained below 5% for 86 consecutive days now.

**in** As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccinemanufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **64.51 crore (64,51,07,160)** vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far through Govt of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category.

More than **5.21 Cr (5,21,37,660)** balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.
