f In a significant achievement, India's cumulative vaccination coverage crossed 66 Crore landmark yesterday. With the administration of **81,09,244** vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has surpassed the cumulative figure of 66.30Cr (**66,30,37,334**) as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 69,60,983 sessions.

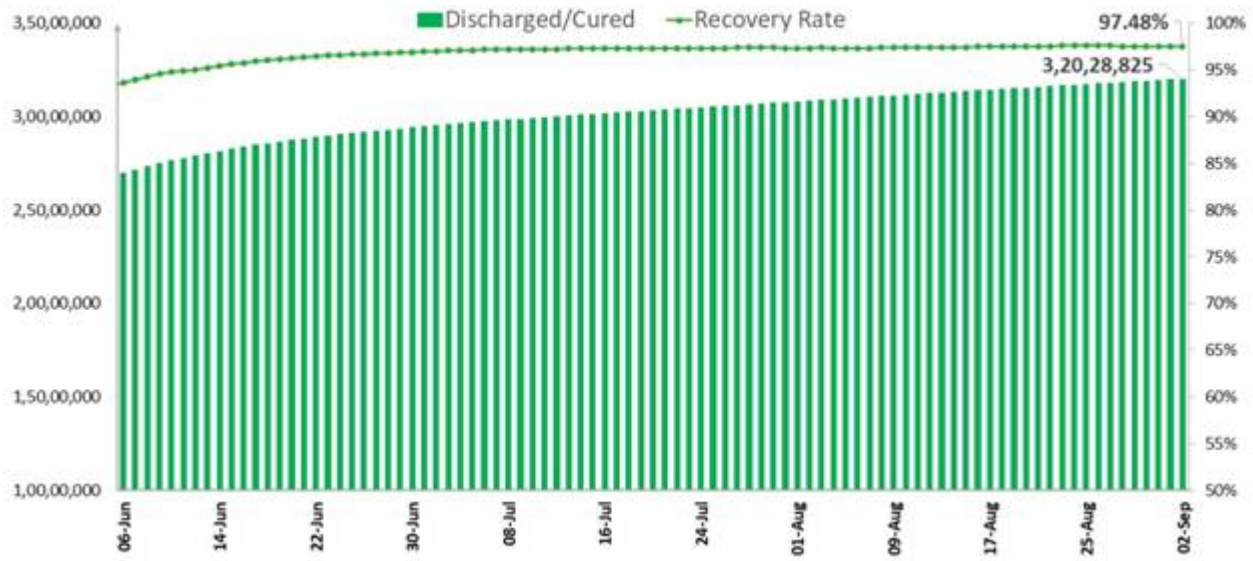
The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country.

The recovery of **35,181** patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to **3,20,28,825**.

Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **97.48%**.



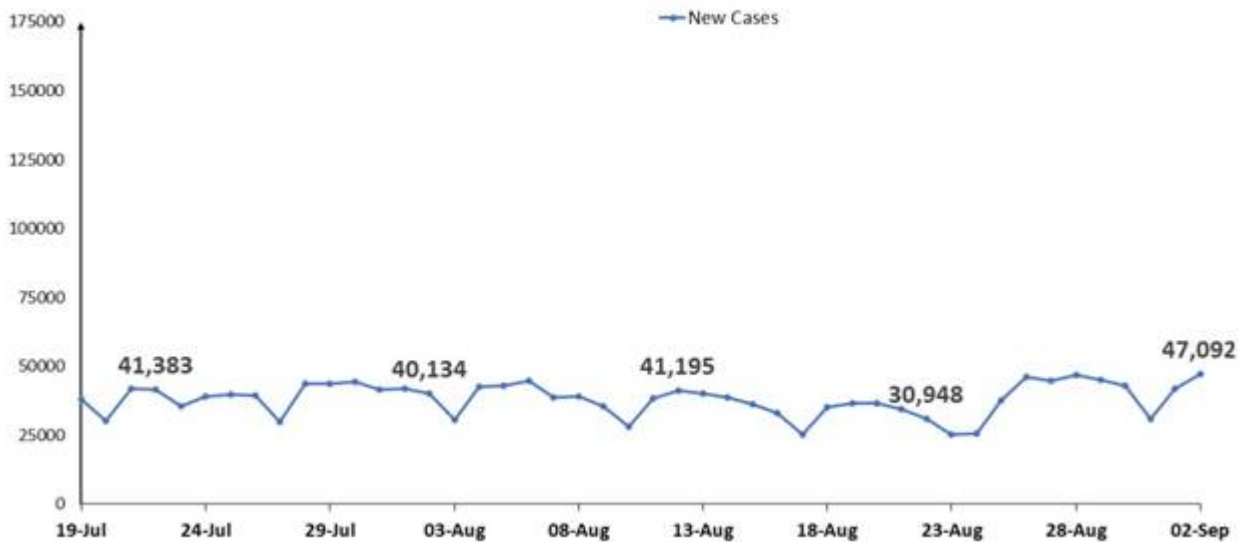
Recovered cases over 3.20 Cr & Recovery rate at 97.48%



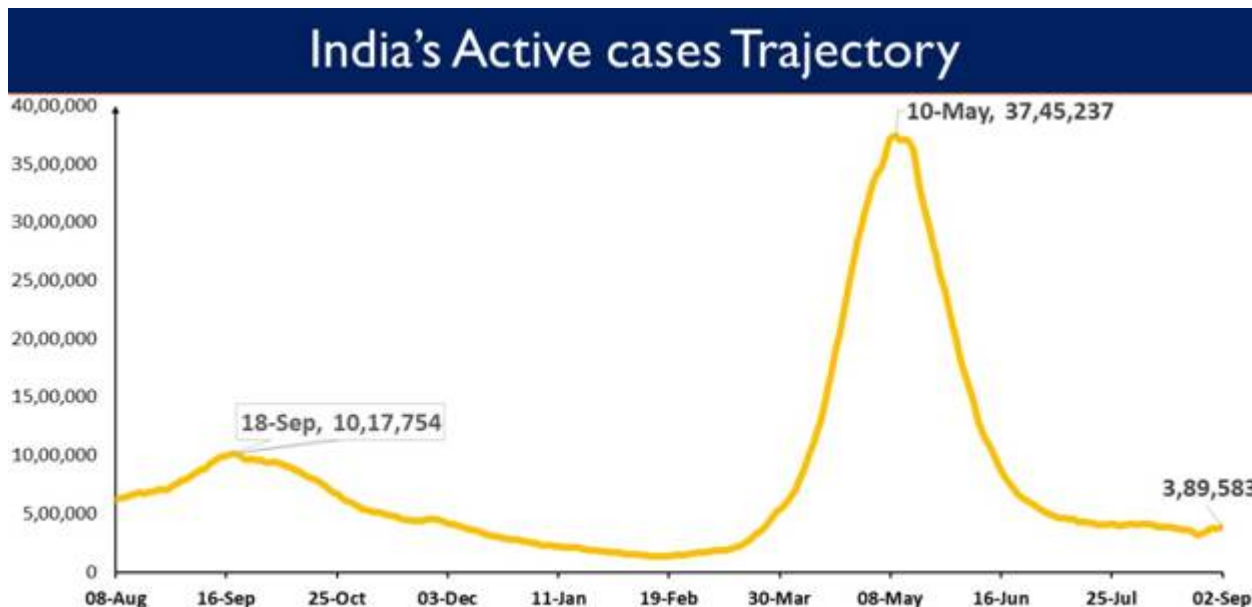
Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs continue the trend of less than 50,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for 67 consecutive days now.

47,092 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

The Active Caseload is presently **3,89,583**. Active cases presently constitute **1.19%** of the country's total Positive Cases.



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of 16,84,441 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **52.48 Cr (52,48,68,734)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 2.62% remains less than 3% for the last 69 days now.** The **Daily Positivity rate stands at 2.80%.** The daily Positivity rate has remained below 5% for 87 consecutive days now.

Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

More than 64.65 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs

More than 4.78 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.
