India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has crossed **67.65 Crore (67,65,00,301)** today. More than **51.88 lakh (51,88,894)** Vaccine Doses have been administered today.



This is as per the 7 pm provisional report. The daily vaccination tally is expected to increase with the compilation of the final reports for the day by late tonight.

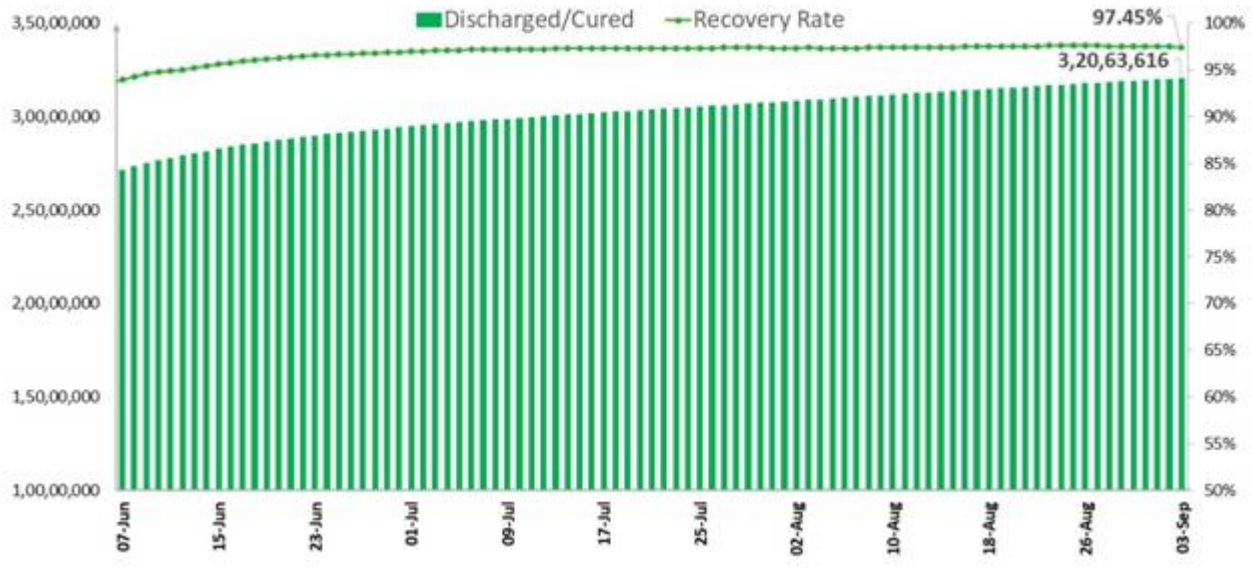
The vaccination exercise as a tool to protect the most vulnerable population groups in the country from COVID-19 continues to be regularly reviewed and monitored at the highest level.

The recovery of **34,791** patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to **3,20,63,616**.

Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **97.45%**.



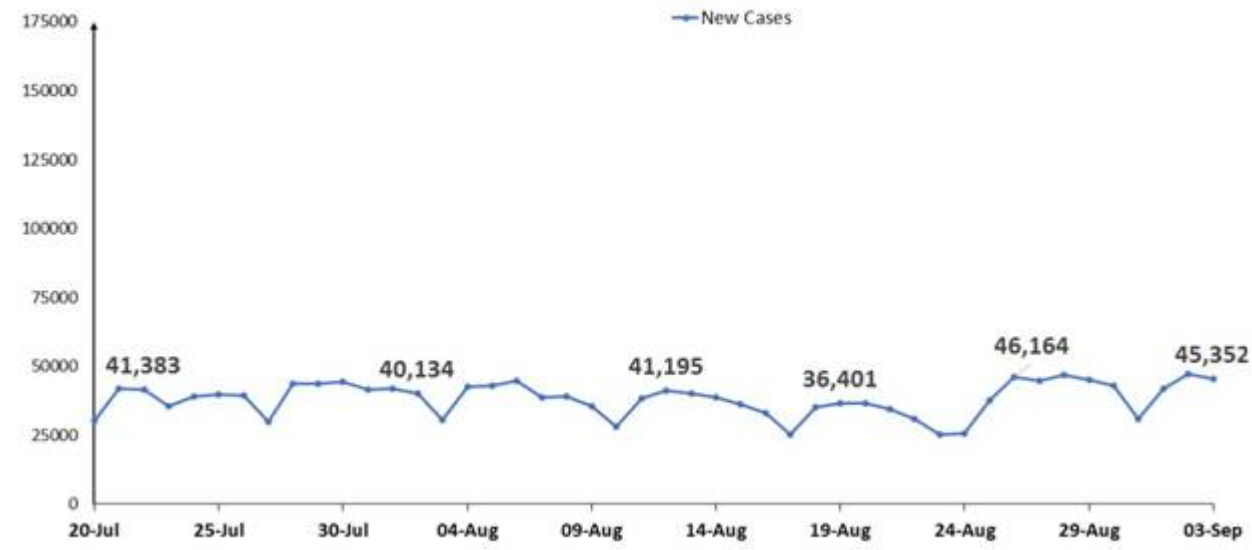
Recovered cases over 3.20 Cr & Recovery rate at 97.45%



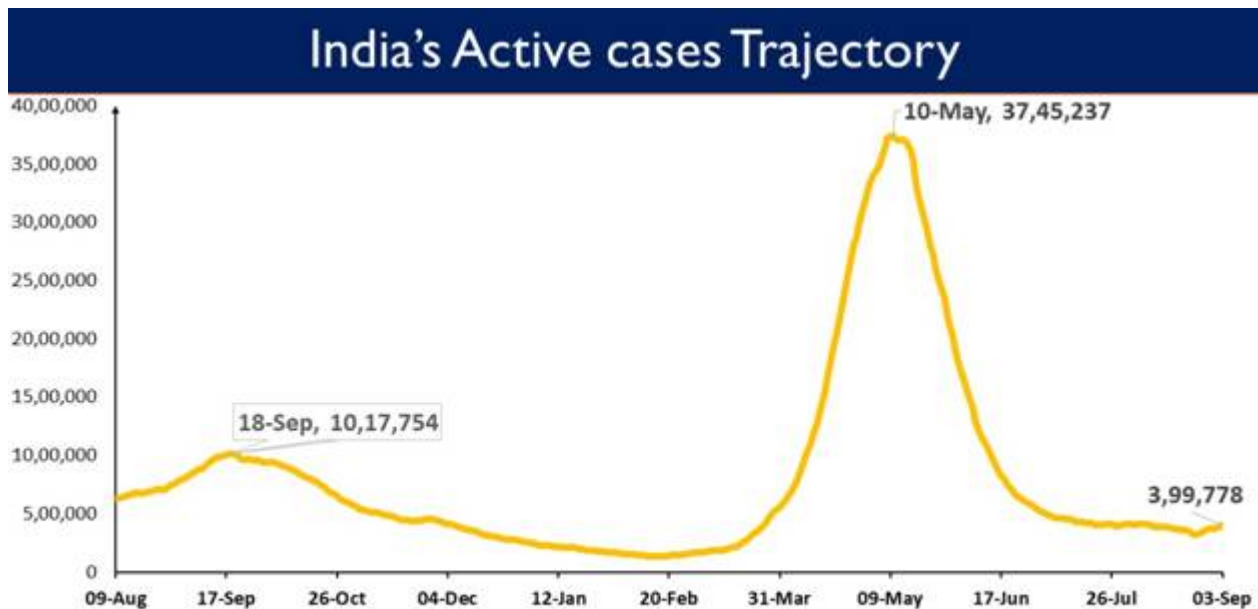
Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs continue the trend of less than 50,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for 68 consecutive days now.

45,352 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

The Active Caseload is presently **3,99,778**. Active cases presently constitute **1.22%** of the country's total Positive Cases.



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of 16,66,334 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **52.65 Cr (52,65,35,068)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 2.66% remains less than 3% for the last 70 days now.** The **Daily Positivity rate stands at 2.72%.** The daily Positivity rate has remained below 5% for 88 consecutive days now.

Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

More than 65Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs

More than 4.36 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs with 1.20 Crore doses in Pipeline

The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country. The new phase of universalization of COVID-19 vaccination commenced from 21st June 2021. The vaccination drive has been ramped up through availability of more vaccines, advance visibility of vaccine availability to States and UTs for enabling better planning by them, and streamlining the vaccine supply chain.

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **65crore(65,00,99,080)** vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far through Govt of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category. Further, more than **1.20 Crore doses (1,20,95,700)** are in the pipeline.

More than **4.36Cr (4,36,81,760)** balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.

Active controlled Phase III Clinical trial in Adult population

Phase II/III Paediatric trial in Children and Adolescents (5yrs and above)

Biological E. has received Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) approval for conducting Phase III Comparator Safety & Immunogenicity trial in adults after Subject Expert Committee’s (SEC) review of Phase I and II clinical trials data. Additionally, Biological E. also received approval on 01.09.2021 to initiate the Phase II/III Study to evaluate Safety, Reactogenicity, Tolerability and Immunogenicity of CORBEVAX™ vaccine in Children and Adolescents. The candidate is a RBD protein sub-unit vaccine.
