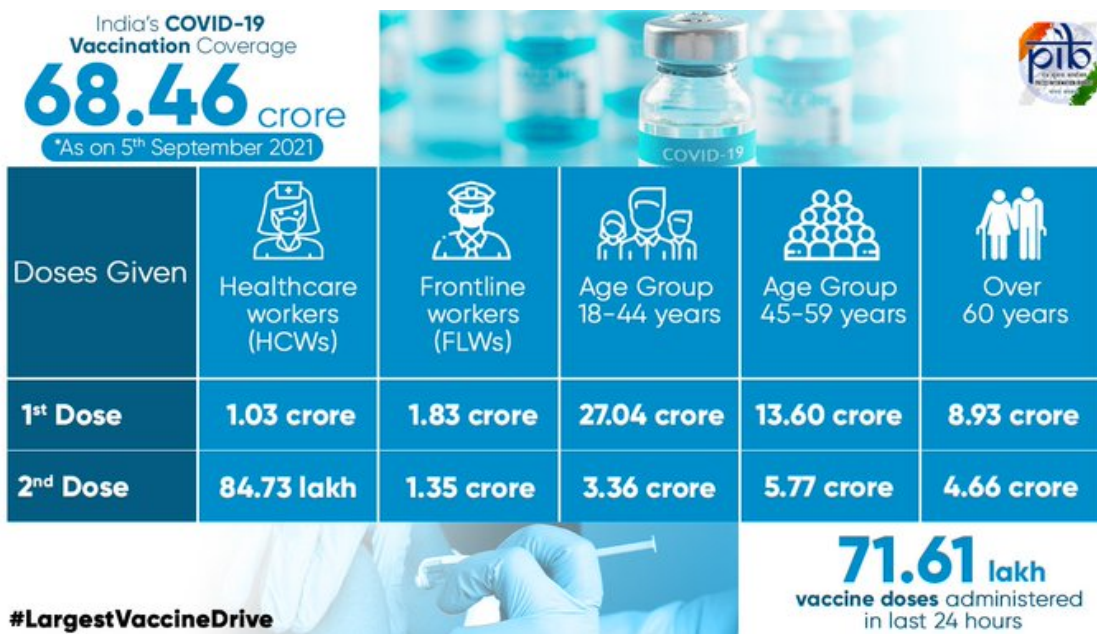
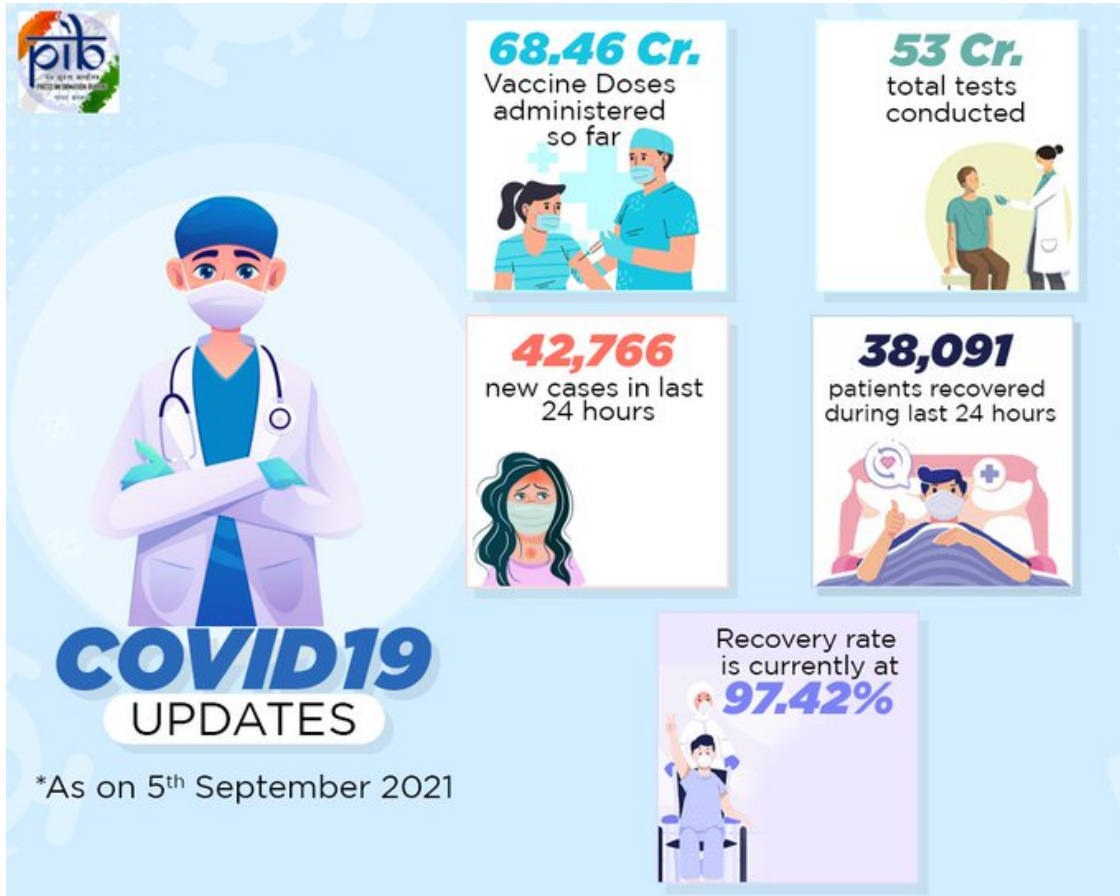

COVID-19 Update**India's Cumulative COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage exceeds 68.46 Cr****More than 71 Lakh doses administered in the last 24 hours****Recovery Rate currently at 97.42%****42,766 New Cases reported in the last 24 hours****India's Active Caseload (4,10,048) is 1.24% of Total Cases****Weekly Positivity Rate (2.62%) less than 3% for last 72 days**

In a significant achievement, India's cumulative vaccination coverage crossed 68 Crore landmark yesterday. With the administration of **71,61,760** vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has surpassed the cumulative figure of 68.46Cr (**68,46,69,521**) as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 71,39,683 sessions.

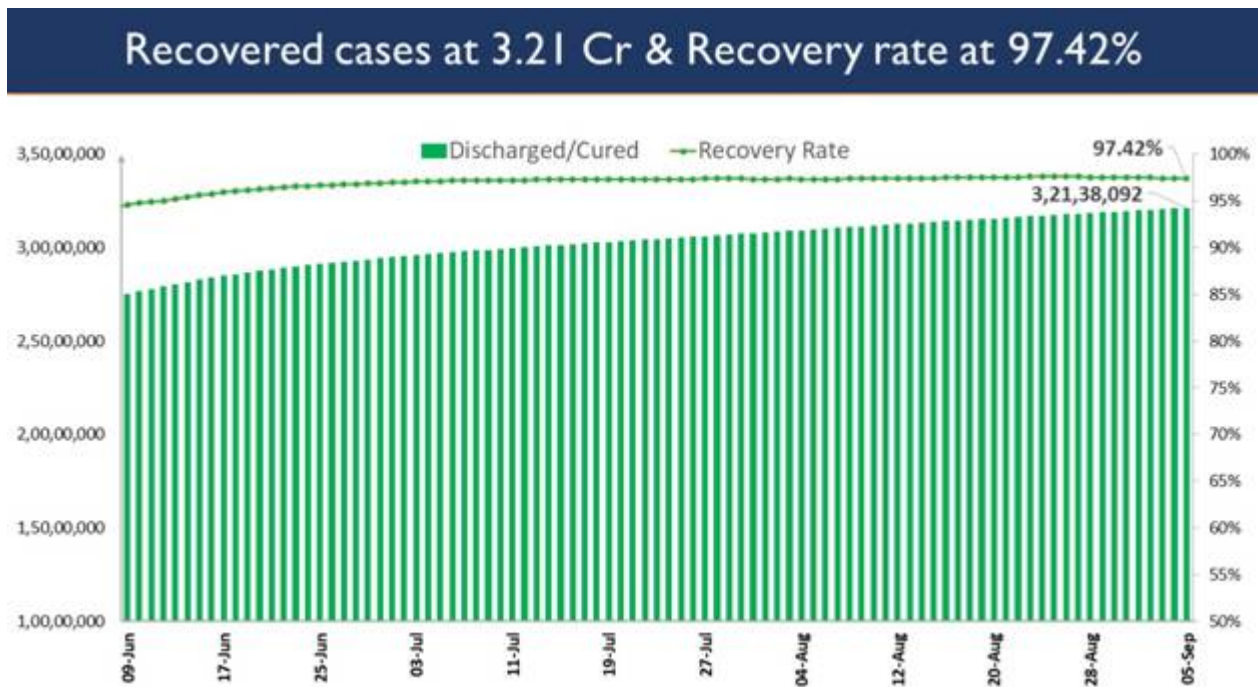

in The recovery of **38,091** patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to **3,21,38,092**.

Consequently, India’s recovery rate stands at **97.42%**.

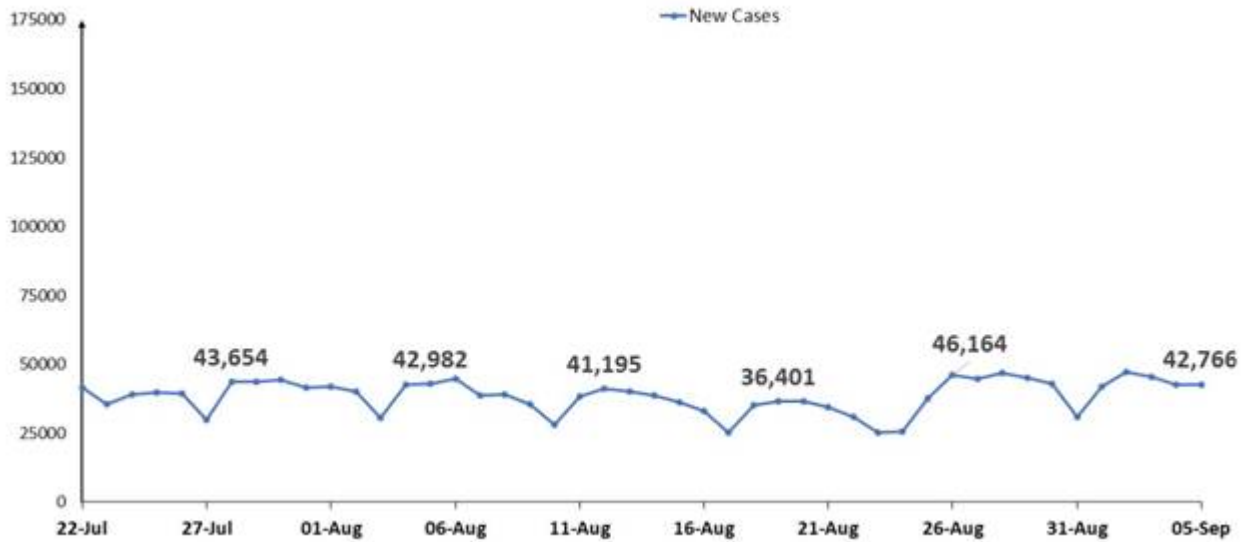


Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs continue the trend of less than 50,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for 70 consecutive days now.

42,766 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

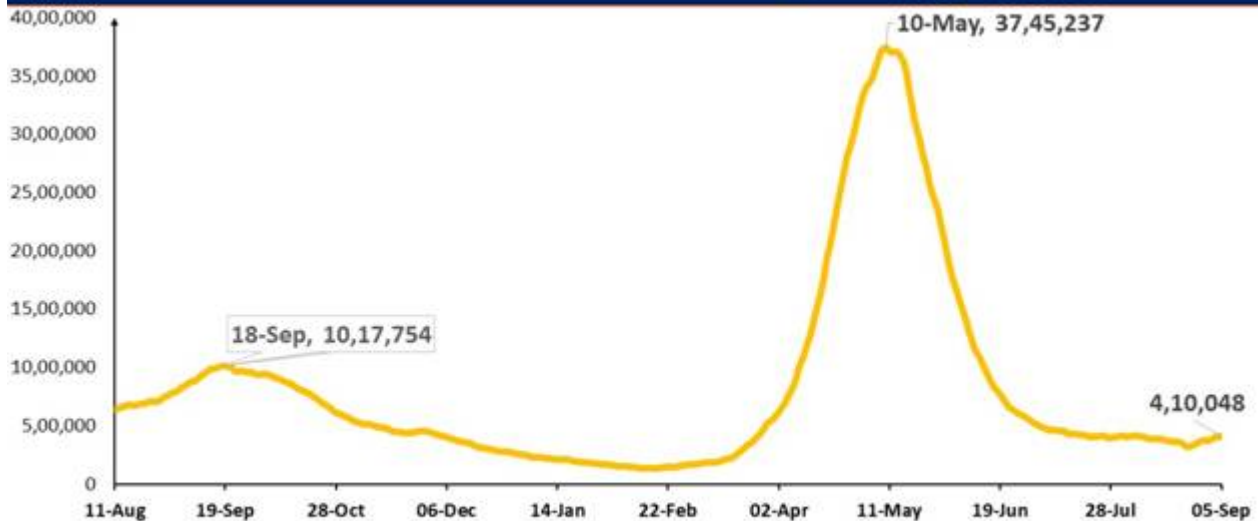


42k New Cases reported in last 24 hrs



The Active Caseload is presently **4,10,048**. Active cases presently constitute **1.24%** of the country's total Positive Cases.

India's Active cases Trajectory



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of 17,47,476 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **53 Cr (53,00,58,218)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 2.62% remains less than 3% for the last 72 days now**. The **Daily Positivity rate stands at 2.45%**. The daily Positivity rate has remained below 5% for 90 consecutive days now.

Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs



More than 66.89 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs



More than 4.37 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs with more than 1.56 Crore doses in Pipeline



As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccinemanufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **66.89 crore (66,89,80,635)** vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far through Govt of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category. Further, more than **1.56 Cr doses (1,56,96,450)** are in the pipeline.

More than **4.37 Cr (4,37,83,160)** balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.
