India sets new record, crosses 75 Cr landmark milestone

India home to more than 99% Healthcare Workers and Frontline Workers vaccinated with one shot of COVID Vaccine

India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has crossed **75 Crore landmark milestone(75,10,41,391)** today. More than **67 lakh (67,04,768)** Vaccine Doses have been administered till 5:30 pm today. The daily vaccination tally is expected to increase with the compilation of the final reports for the day by late tonight. The country has also become home to more than 99% HCWs and FLWs vaccinated with one shot of COVID Vaccine.

Union Health Minister Shri Mansukh Mandaviya lauded the entire country for the achievement of 75 Cr landmark milestone.
