**in** With the administration of **61,15,690** vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, country's COVID-19 vaccination coverage surpassed the cumulative figure of **75.89Cr (75,89,12,277)** as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 76,68,216 sessions.

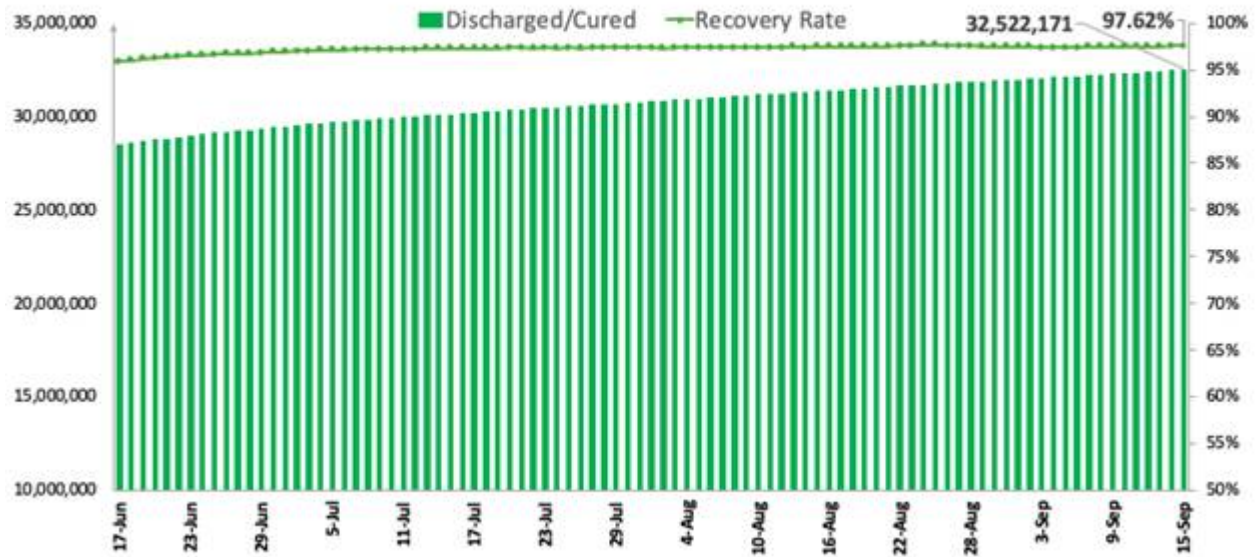

The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country.

The recovery of **38,012** patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to **3,25,22,171**.

Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **97.62%**.

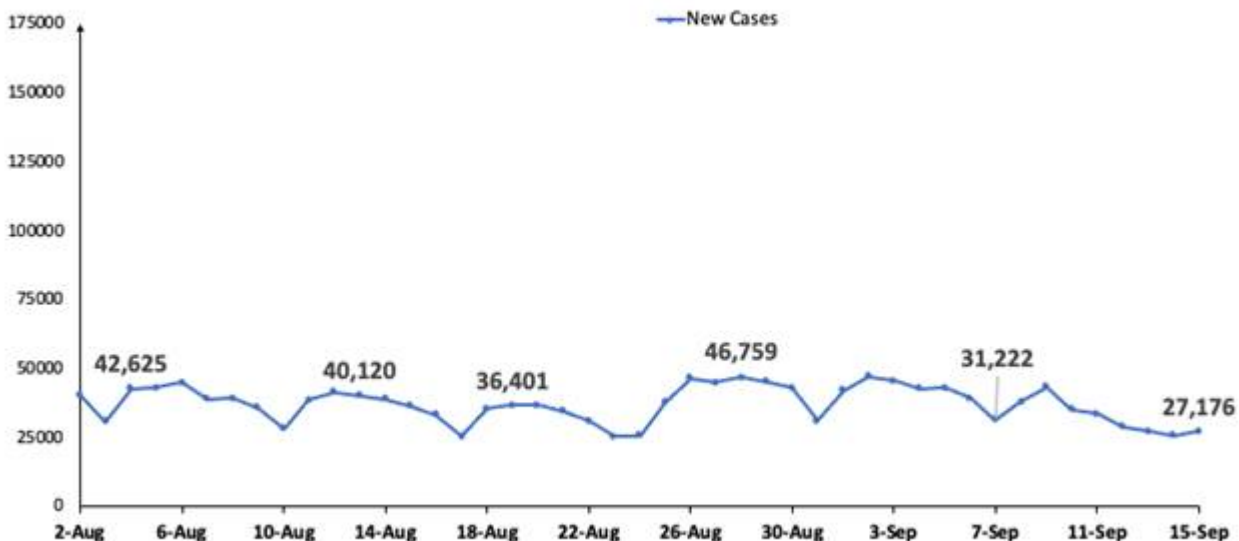
### Recovered cases over 3.25 Cr & Recovery rate at 97.62%



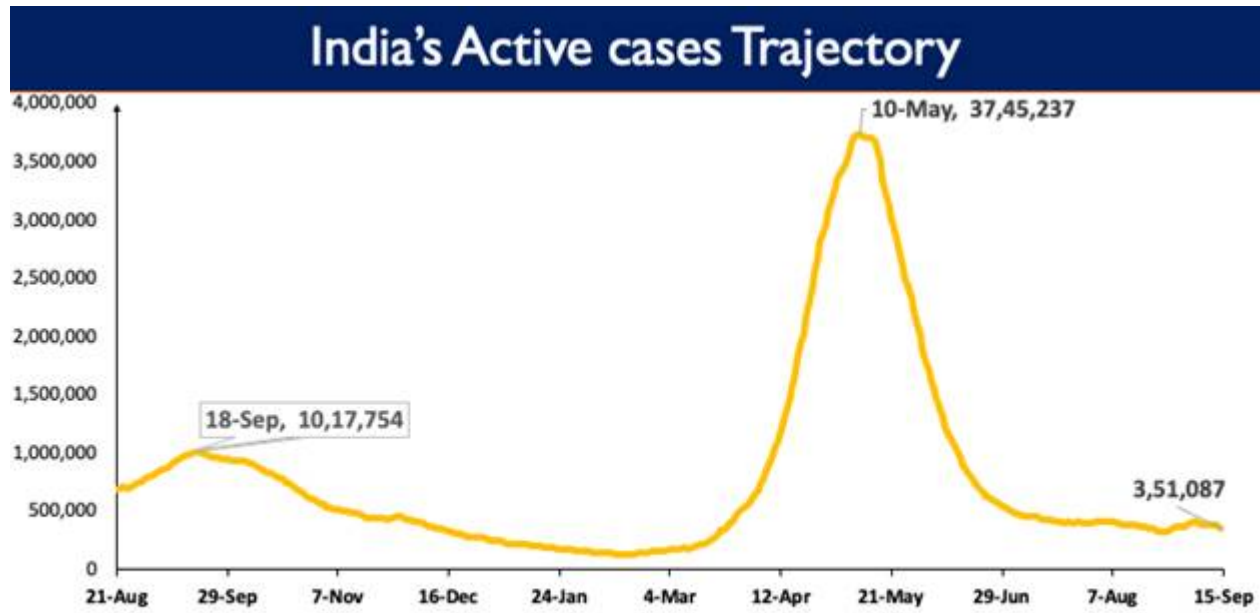
Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs continue the trend of less than 50,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for 80 consecutive days now.

**27,176 new cases** were reported in the last 24 hours.

The Active Caseload is presently **3,51,087**. Active cases presently constitute **1.05%** of the country's total Positive Cases.



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of

16,10,829 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **54.60 Cr (54,60,55,796)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 2.00% remains less than 3% for the last 82 days now.** The **Daily Positivity rate reported to be 1.69%.** The daily Positivity rate has remained below 3% for last 16 days and below 5% for 99 consecutive days now.

### Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

**More than 74.25 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs**

**More than 4.62 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs with more than 1.8 Crore doses in Pipeline**

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and

supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccinemanufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **74.25crore(74,25,94,875)** vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far through Govt. of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category. Further, more than **1.8 Crore doses (1,80,83,000)** are in the pipeline.

More than **4.62Cr (4,62,75,955)** balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.
