India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has reached nearly **89 Crore(88,96,14,483)** today. More than **58 lakh (58,80,843)** Vaccine Doses have been administered till 7 pm today. The daily vaccination tally is expected to increase with the compilation of the final reports for the day by late tonight.

The vaccination exercise as a tool to protect the most vulnerable population groups in the country from COVID-19 continues to be regularly reviewed and monitored at the highest level.



The recovery of **28,718** patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to **3,30,14,898**.

Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **97.85%**. Recovery Rate is currently at its highest peak since March 2020.

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
## Recovered cases over 3.30 Cr & Recovery rate at 97.85%




Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs continue the trend of less than 50,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for 95 consecutive days now.

**23,529 new cases** were reported in the last 24 hours.

The Active Caseload is presently **2,77,020**, which is the **lowest in 195 days**. Active cases presently constitute **0.82%** of the country's total Positive Cases.



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of

15,06,254 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **56.89 Cr (56,89,56,439)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 1.74% remains less than 3% for the last 97 days now. The Daily Positivity rate reported to be 1.56%**. The daily Positivity rate has remained below 3% for last 31 days and below 5% for 114 consecutive days now.

### Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

**More than 86.51 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs**

**More than 5 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs with over 63.69 Lakh doses in Pipeline**

The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country. The new phase of universalization of COVID-19 vaccination commenced from 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021. The vaccination drive has been ramped up through availability of more vaccines, advance visibility of vaccine availability to States and UTs for enabling better planning by them, and streamlining the vaccine supply chain.

**f** As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than 86.51crore (86,51,52,695) vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far through Govt of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category. Further, more than 63.69 Lakh doses (63,69,890) are in the pipeline.

More than 5Cr (5,00,46,000) balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.
