# PIB'S BULLETIN ON COVID-19

- **87.66 Cr. vaccine doses have been administered so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive**
- **India reports daily new cases less than 20,000; 18,870 new cases in the last 24 hours**
- **Active cases account for less than 1% of total cases, currently at 0.84%; Lowest since March 2020**
- **India's Active caseload stands at 2,82,520; lowest in 194 days**
- **Recovery Rate currently at 97.83%; Highest since March 2020**
- **28,178 recoveries in the last 24 hours increases Total Recoveries to 3,29,86,180**
- **Weekly Positivity Rate (1.82%) less than 3% for last 96 days**
- **Daily positivity rate (1.25%) less than 3% for last 30 days**
- **56.74 crore Total Tests conducted so far**

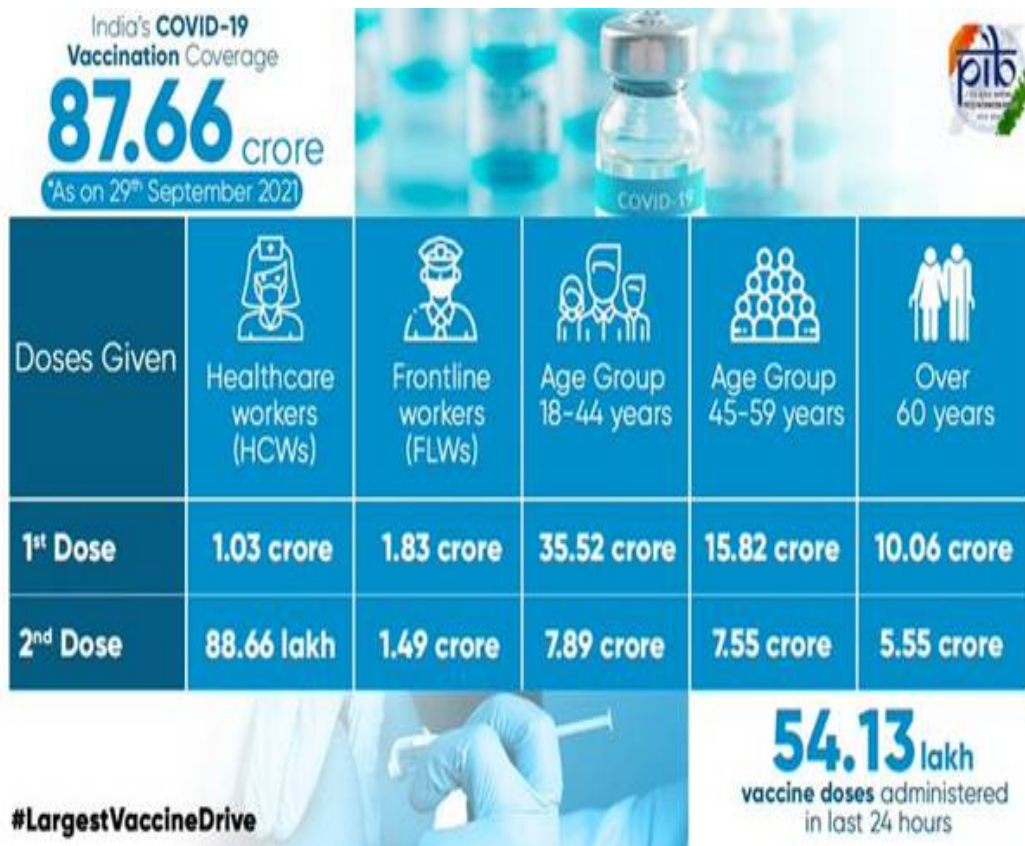

**COVID-19 Update**

**India's Cumulative COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage exceeds 87.66 Cr**

**More than 54.13 Lakh doses administered in the last 24 hours**

**Recovery Rate currently at 97.83%; Highest since March 2020**

**18,870 New Cases reported in the last 24 hours**

**India's Active Caseload (2,82,520) is 0.84% of Total Cases**

**Weekly Positivity Rate (1.82%) less than 3% for last 96 days**

With the administration of **54,13,332** vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage exceeded **87.66 Cr (87,66,63,490)** as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 85,33,076 sessions.

The break-up of the cumulative figures as per the provisional report till 7 am today include:

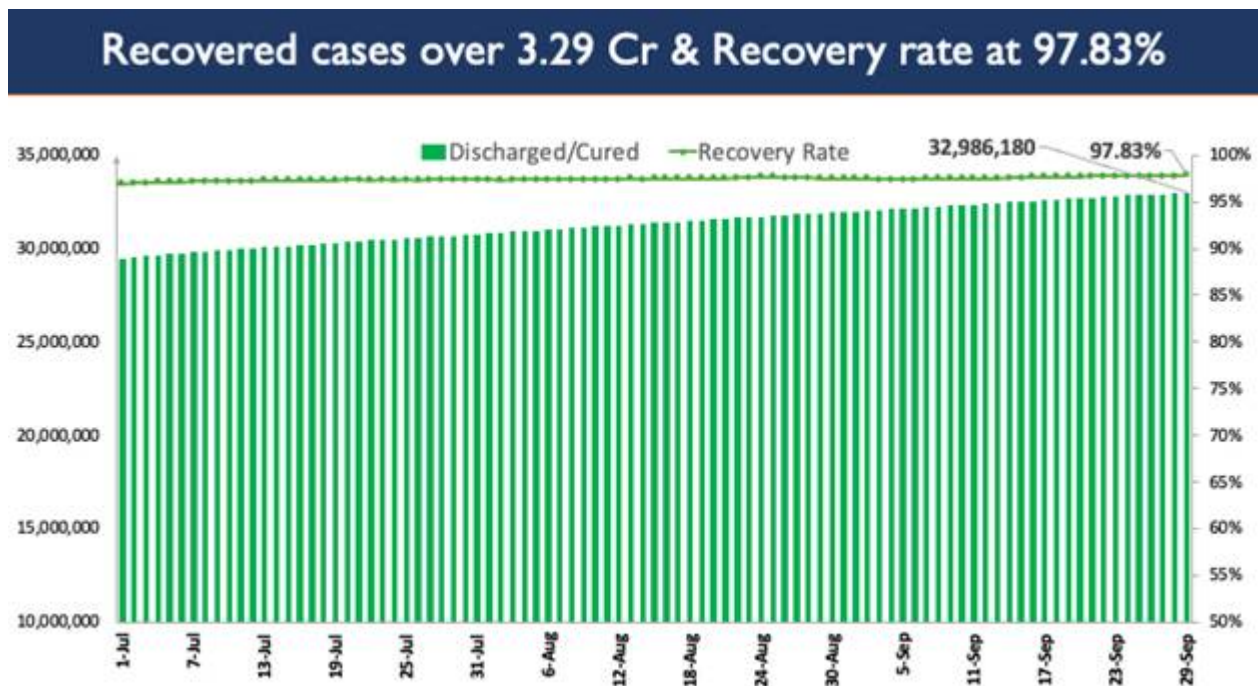

The recovery of **28,178** patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to **3,29,86,180**.

Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **97.83%**. Recovery Rate is currently at its highest peak since March 2020.

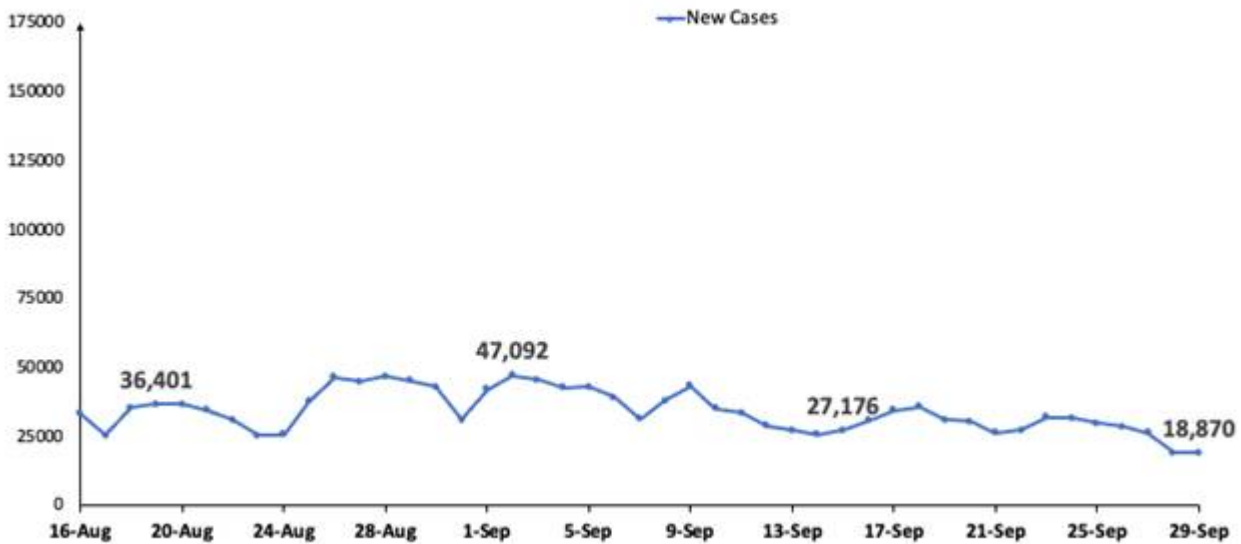


Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs continue the trend of less than 50,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for 94 consecutive days now.

India reports less than 20,000 daily new cases for the second successive day. **18,870 new cases** were reported in the last 24 hours.

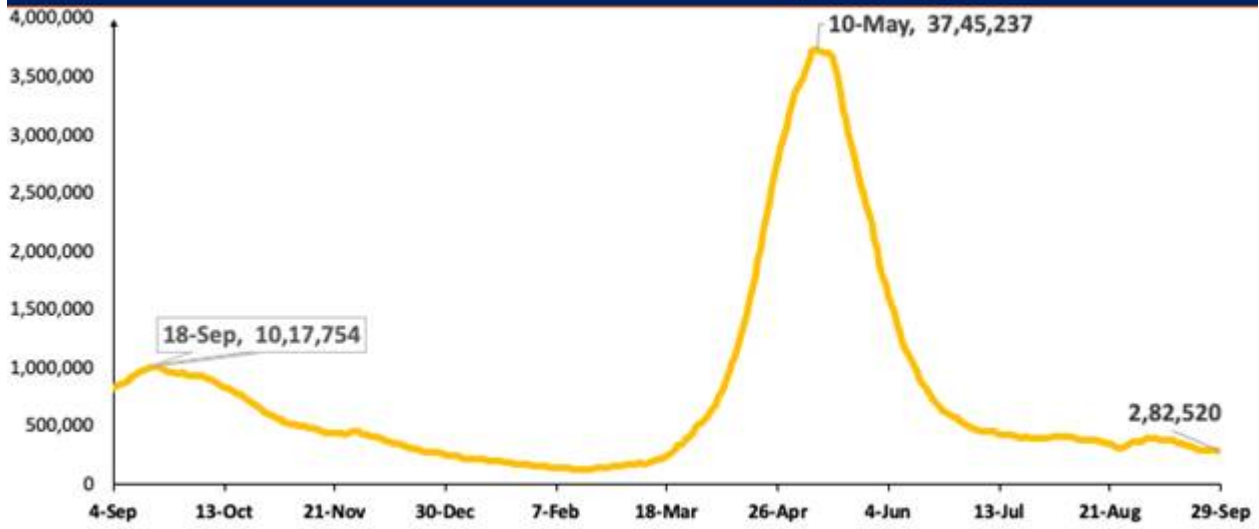


### 18k New Cases reported in last 24 hrs



The Active Caseload is presently **2,82,520**, which is the **lowest in 194 days**. Active cases presently constitute **0.84%** of the country's total Positive Cases.

### India's Active cases Trajectory



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of

15,04,713 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **56.74 Cr (56,74,50,185)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 1.82% remains less than 3% for the last 96 days now.** The **Daily Positivity rate reported to be 1.25%.** The daily Positivity rate has remained below 3% for last 30 days and below 5% for 113 consecutive days now.

### Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

#### More than 85.42 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs

**More than 4.57 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs with over 83.80 Lakh doses in Pipeline**

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccinemanufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **85.42 crore (85,42,35,155)** vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far through Govt of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category. Further, more than **83.80 Lakh doses (83,80,140)** are in the pipeline.

More than **4.57 Cr (4,57,98,120)** balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.
