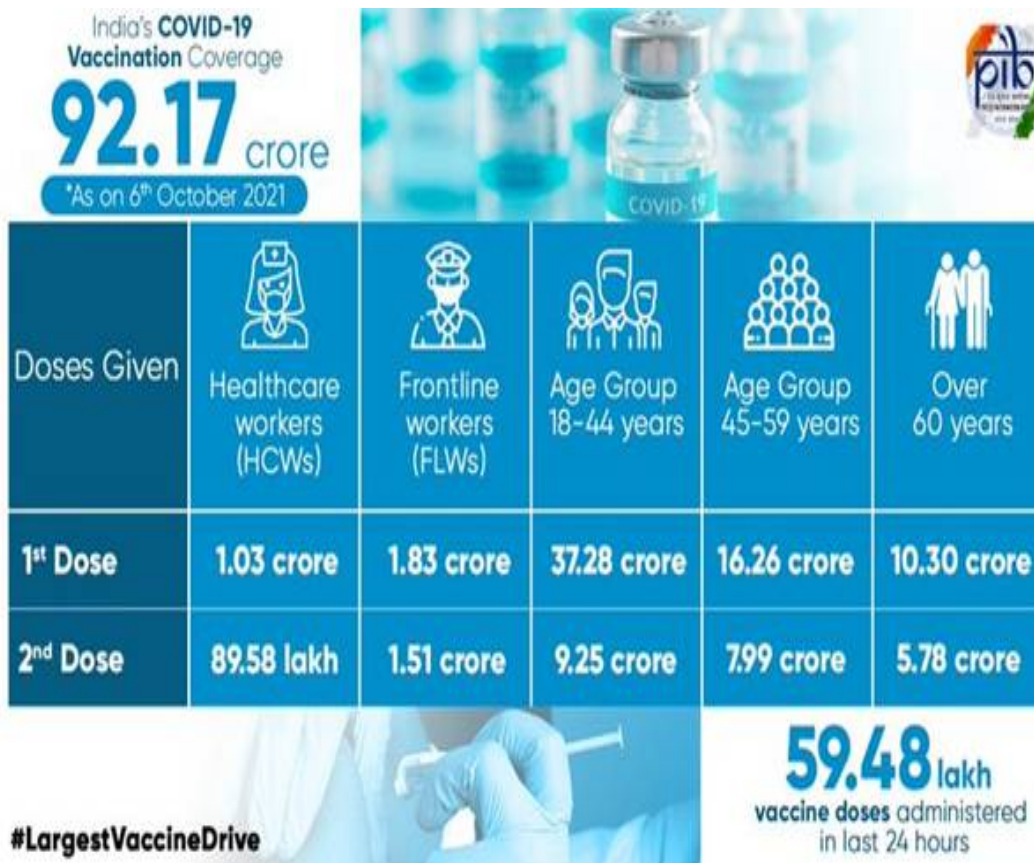

COVID-19 Update

India’s Cumulative COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage crosses the landmark of 92 Cr

More than 59.48 Lakh doses administered in the last 24 hours

Recovery Rate currently at 97.94%; Highest since March 2020

18,833 New Cases reported in the last 24 hours

India's Active Caseload (2,46,687) is 0.73% of Total Cases

Weekly Positivity Rate (1.68%) less than 3% for last 103 days

With the administration of **59,48,360** vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India’s COVID-19 vaccination coverage crossed the landmark of **92Cr(92,17,65,405)** as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through **89,35,354** sessions.

The break-up of the cumulative figures as per the provisional report till 7 am today include:

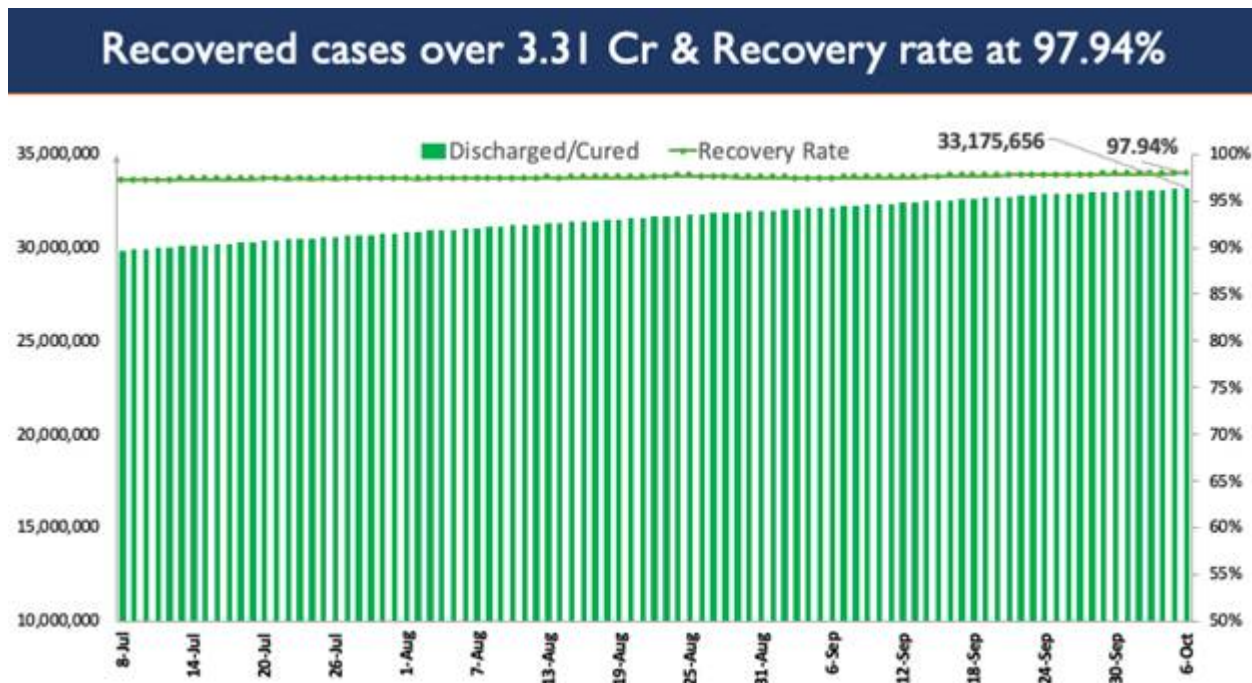

The recovery of **24,770** patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to **3,31,75,656**.

Consequently, India’s recovery rate stands at **97.94%**. Recovery Rate is currently at its highest peak since March 2020.

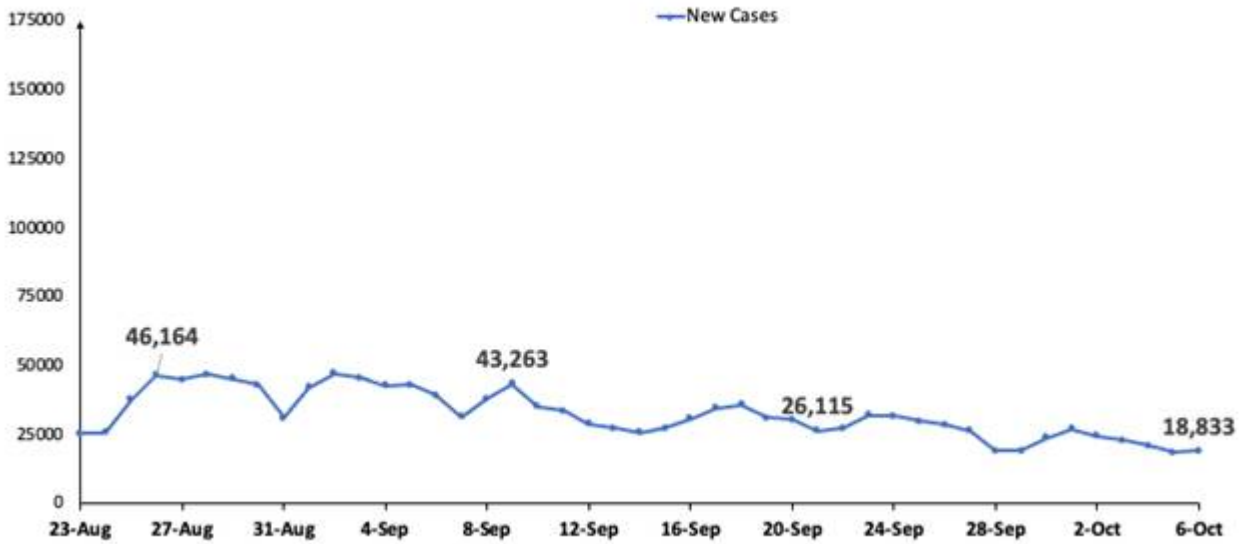


Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs continue the trend of less than 50,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for 101 consecutive days now.

18,833 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

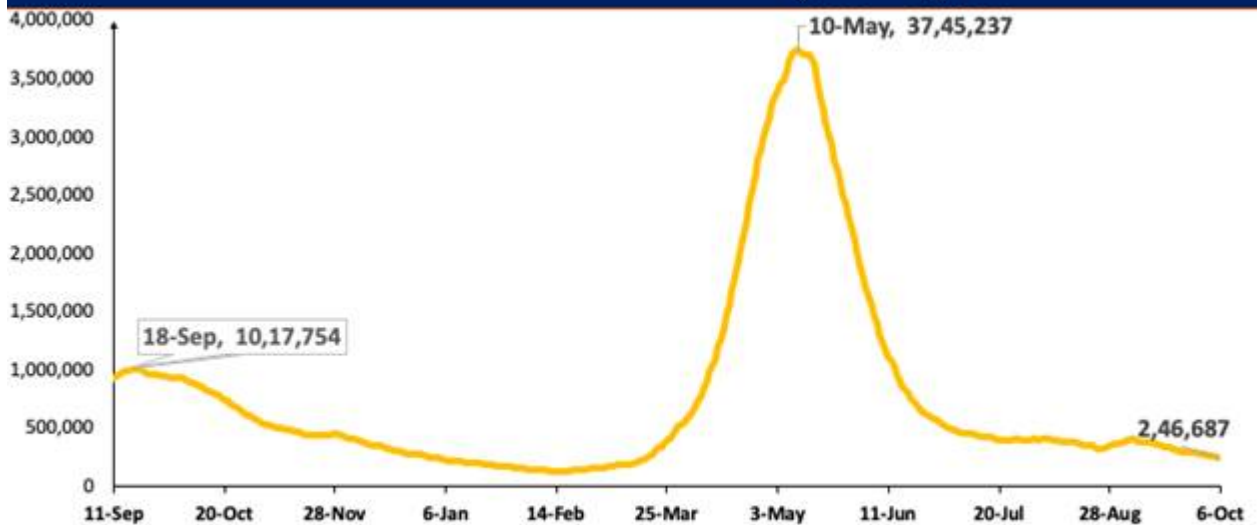


18k New Cases reported in last 24 hrs



The Active Caseload is presently **2,46,687**, which is the **lowest in 203 days**. Active cases presently constitute **0.73%** of the country's total Positive Cases.

The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of 14,09,825 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **57.68 Cr (57,68,03,867)** cumulative tests.

f While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 1.68% remains less than 3% for the last 103 days now.** The **Daily Positivity rate reported to be 1.34%.** The daily Positivity rate has remained below 3% for last 37 days and below 5% for 120 consecutive days now.

Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

More than 92.57 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs



More than 6.93 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs



As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccinemanufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **92.57 crore (92,57,51,325)** vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far through Govt of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category.

More than **6.93 Cr (6,93,46,080)** balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.

PM to dedicate to the nation PSA Oxygen Plants established under PM CARES on 7th October

PM to dedicate 35 PSA Oxygen Plants across 35 States and UTs

PSA Oxygen Plants now commissioned in all districts of the country

f Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi will dedicate to the nation 35 Pressure Swing Adsorption (PSA) Oxygen Plants established under PM CARES, across 35 States and Union Territories, in an event to be held at AIIMS Rishikesh, Uttarakhand on 7th October, 2021 at 11 AM. With this, all districts of the country will now have commissioned PSA Oxygen Plants. Prime Minister will also address the gathering on the occasion.

t Till now, a total of 1224 PSA Oxygen Plants have been funded under PM CARES all across the country, out of which more than 1100 Plants have been commissioned, providing an output of over 1750 MT oxygen per day. It is a testimony of the proactive measures taken by the Government to augment India's medical oxygen generation capacity since the advent of Covid-19 pandemic.
