With the administration of **50,17,753**vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage crossed the landmark of **93Cr(93,17,17,191**) as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 90,68,525sessions.




Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **97.96%**. Recovery Rate is currently at its highest peak since March 2020.





21,257new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.




The Active Caseload is presently 2,40,221, which is the lowest in 205 days. Active cases presently constitute 0.71% of the country's total Positive Cases.



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of 13,85,706tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **58 Cr (58,00,43,190)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, Weekly Positivity Rate at 1.64% remains less than 3% for the last 105 days now. The Daily Positivity rate reported to be1.53%. The daily Positivity rate has remained below3% for last 39 days and below 5% for 122 consecutive days now.
