India's Cumulative COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage crosses the landmark of 93 Cr

More than 50.17 Lakh doses administered in the last 24 hours


Recovery Rate currently at 97.96%; Highest since March 2020

21,257 New Cases reported in the last 24 hours

India's Active Caseload (2,40,221) is 0.71% of Total Cases

Weekly Positivity Rate (1.64%) less than 3% for last 105 days



 With the administration of **50,17,753** vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage crossed the landmark of **93Cr(93,17,17,191)** as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 90,68,525 sessions.



The break-up of the cumulative figures as per the provisional report till 7 am today include:

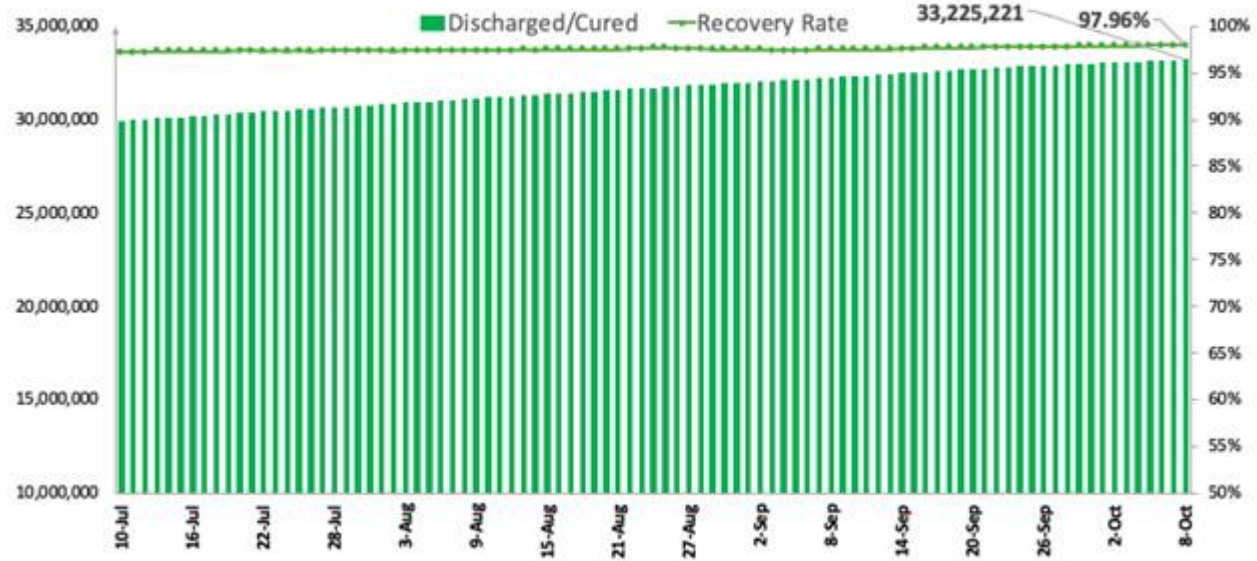

The recovery of **24,963** patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to **3,32,25,221**.

Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **97.96%**. Recovery Rate is currently at its highest peak since March 2020.



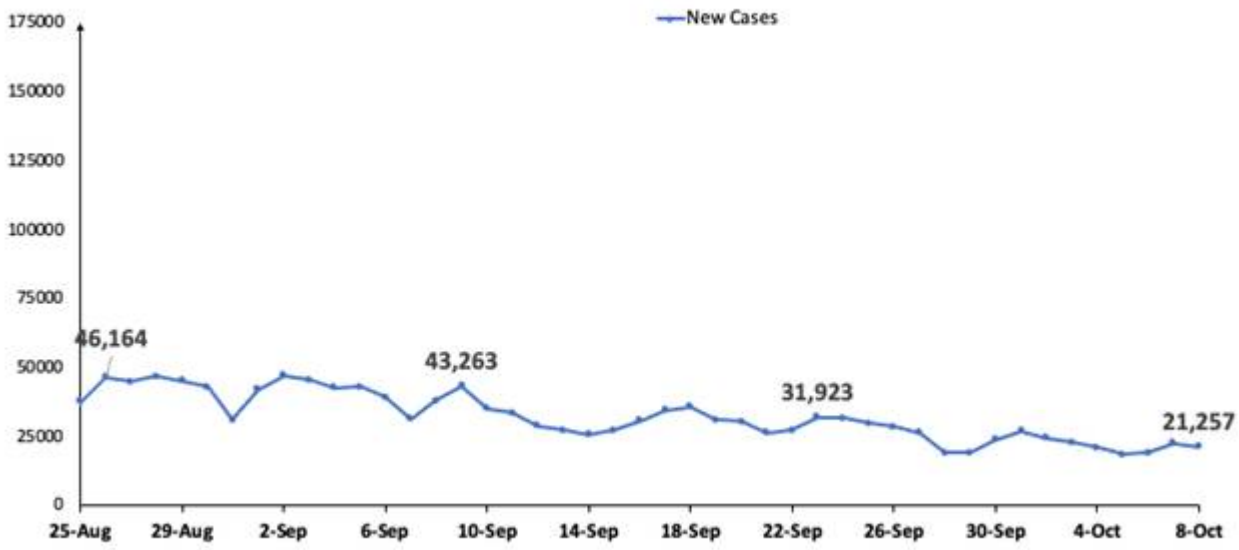
Recovered cases over 3.32 Cr & Recovery rate at 97.96%



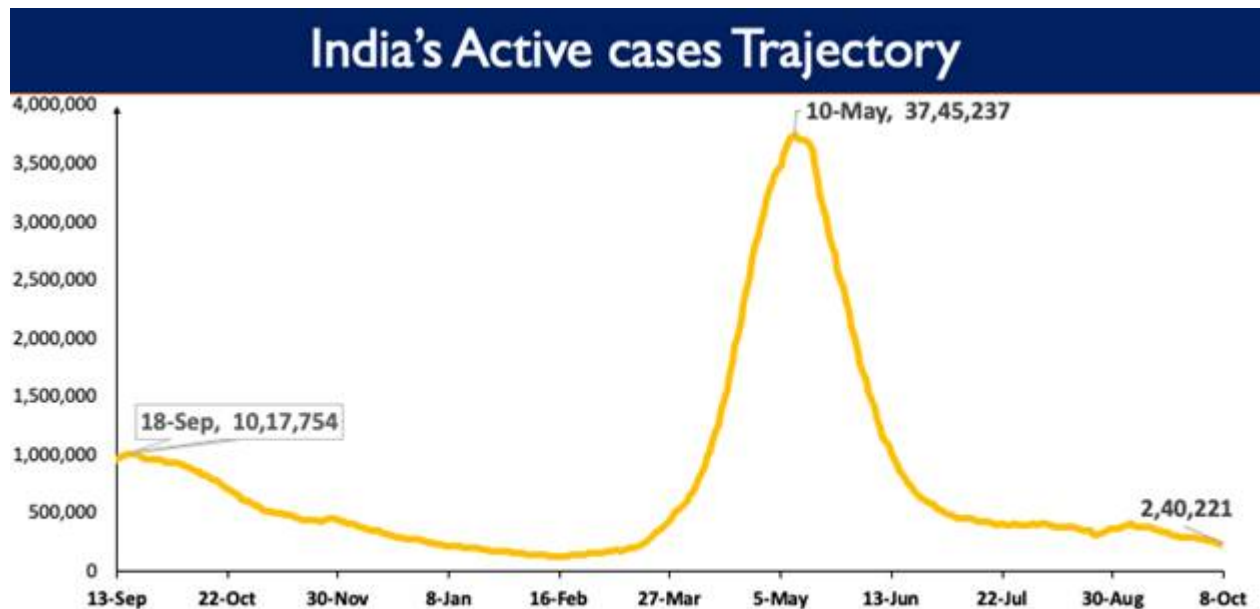
Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs continue the trend of less than 50,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for 103 consecutive days now.

21,257 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

The Active Caseload is presently **2,40,221**, which is the **lowest in 205 days**. Active cases presently constitute **0.71%** of the country's total Positive Cases.



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of 13,85,706 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **58 Cr (58,00,43,190)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 1.64% remains less than 3% for the last 105 days now.** The **Daily Positivity rate reported to be 1.53%.** The daily Positivity rate has remained below 3% for last 39 days and below 5% for 122 consecutive days now.

Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

More than 94.86 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs

More than 8.22 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **94.86 crore (94,86,52,605)** vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far through Govt of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category.
