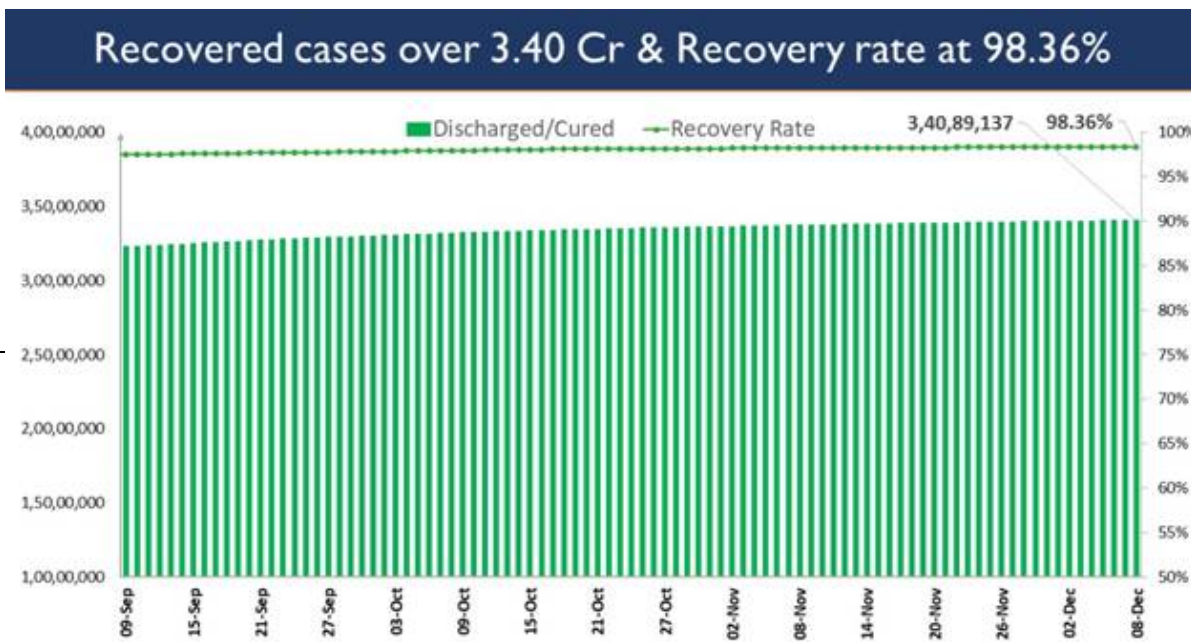
With the administration of **73,62,000** vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has exceeded **130 Cr** today. This has been achieved through 1,35,05,139 sessions.

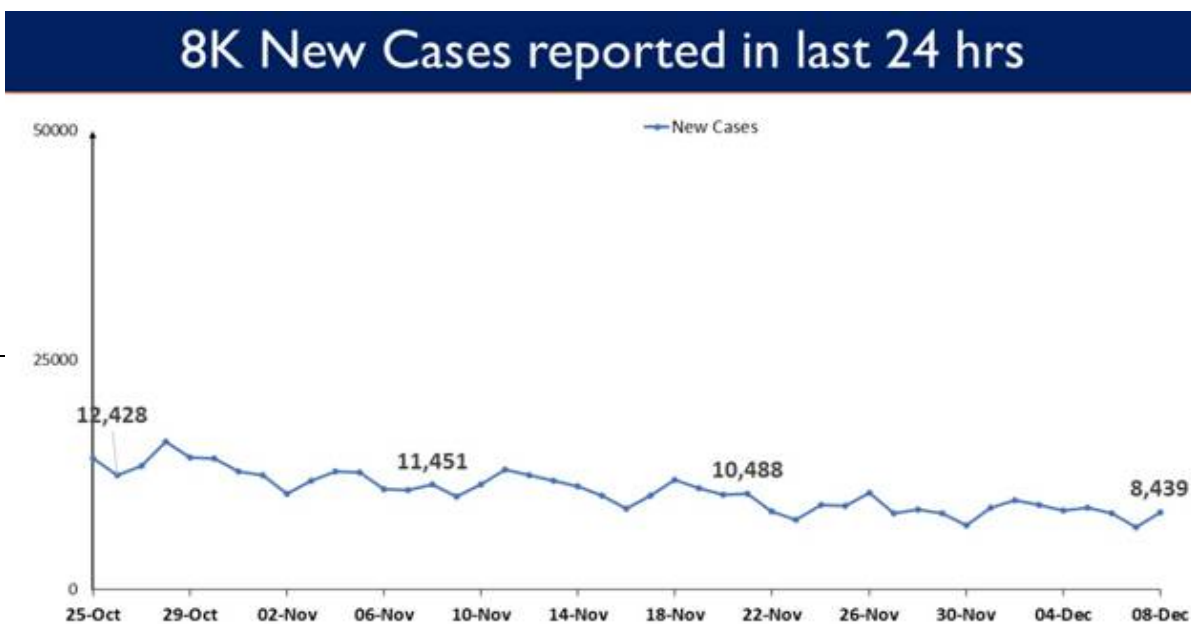
The recovery of **9,525** patients in the last 24 hours has increased the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) to **3,40,89,137**.

Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **98.36%**, highest since March 2020.

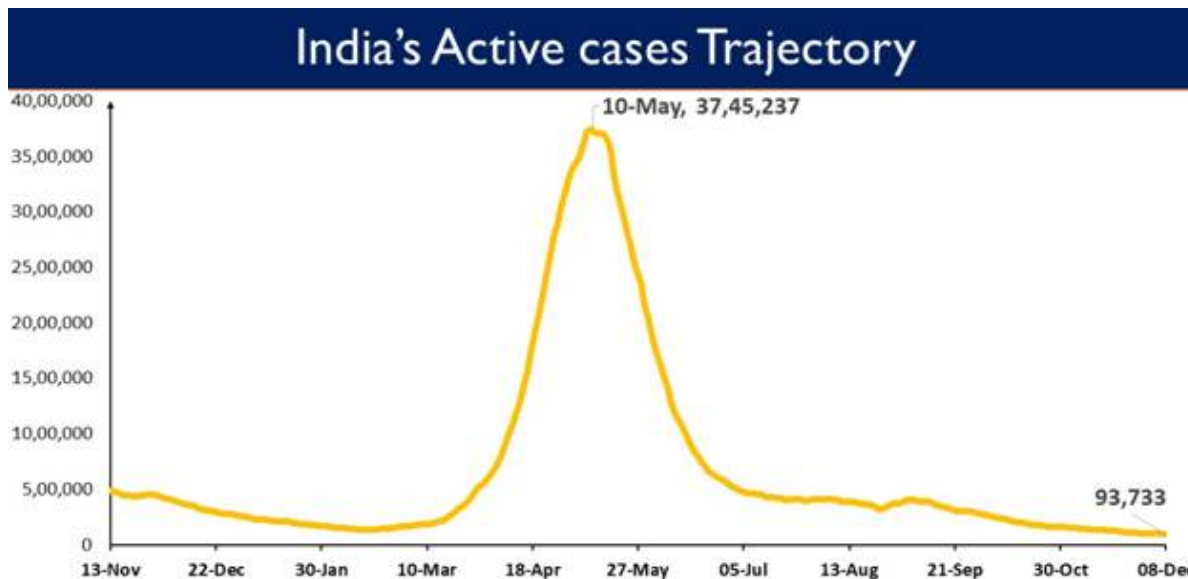


Sustained and collaborative efforts by the Centre and the States/UTs continue the trend of less than 15,000 Daily New Cases that is being reported for last 41 days now.

**8,439 new cases** were reported in the last 24 hours.

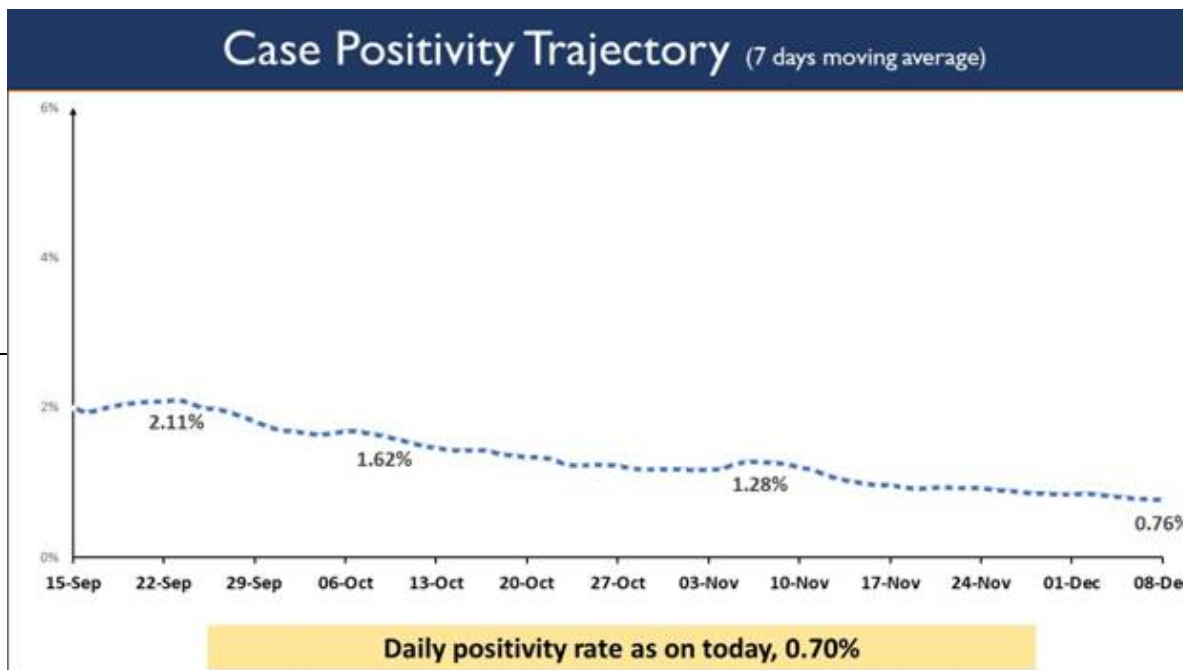


India's Active Caseload presently at **93,733** is **lowest in 555 days**. Active cases constitute **0.27%** of the country's total Positive Cases, which is **lowest since March 2020**.



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of 12,13,130 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **65.06 Cr (65,06,60,144)** cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate at 0.76% remains less than 1% for the last 24 days now.** The **Daily Positivity rate reported to be 0.70%.** The daily Positivity rate has remained below 2% for last 65 days and below 3% for 100 consecutive days now.

**Twitter** The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country. The nationwide COVID 19 vaccination started on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

The vaccination drive has been ramped up through availability of more vaccines, advance visibility of vaccine availability to States and UTs for enabling better planning by them, and streamlining the vaccine

**in** As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccinemanufacturers in the country to States and UTs.
