

India's Active Caseload currently stands at 69,897

Weekly Positivity Rate is presently at 0.90%

With the administration of **more than 24.84 lakh Doses (24,84,412)** vaccine doses in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has exceeded **178.29 Cr (1,78,29,13,060)** as per provisional reports till 7 am today.

This has been achieved through 2,06,05,684 sessions. The break-up of the cumulative figure as per the provisional report till 7 am today include:



13,450 patients have recovered in the last 24 hours and the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) is now at **4,23,67,070**.




Recovered cases over 4.23 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.64%



6,396 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.


Over 6K New Cases reported in last 24 hrs


India's Active cases Trajectory



The testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded. The last 24 hours saw a total of **9,23,351** tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **77.09 Cr** (**77,09,73,356**) cumulative tests.

While testing capacity has been enhanced across the country, **Weekly Positivity Rate** in the country currently stands at **0.90%** and the **Daily Positivity rate** is reported to be **0.69%**.

Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs



More than 179.14 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs



More than 15.49 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs



The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country. The nationwide COVID 19 vaccination started on 16th January 2021.

The new phase of universalization of COVID-19 vaccination commenced from 21st June 2021. The vaccination drive has been ramped up through availability of more vaccines, advance visibility of vaccine availability to States and UTs for enabling better planning by them, and streamlining the vaccine supply chain.

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **179.14 crore (1,79,14,49,670)** vaccine doses have been provided to States/UTs so far through Govt. of India (free of cost channel) and through direct state procurement category.

More than **15.49 Cr (15,49,34,846)** balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.
