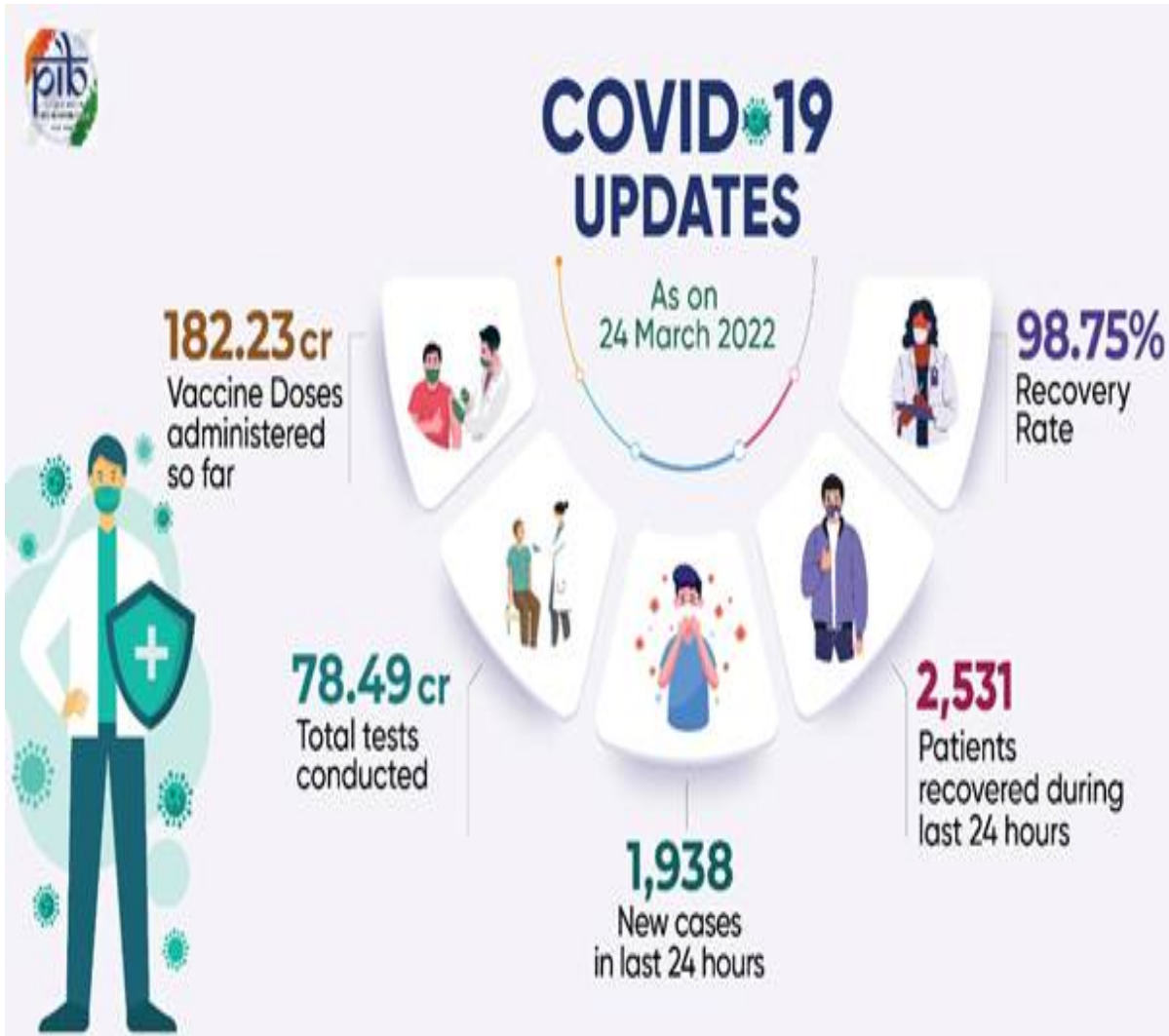

India's Active caseload declines to 22,427 today; stands at 0.05% of India's total Positive Cases

1,938 new cases reported in the last 24 hours






Recovery Rate currently stands at 98.75%

Weekly Positivity Rate is presently at 0.35%

India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has exceeded **182.23 Cr (1,82,23,30,356)** as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 2,15,72,370 sessions.

COVID-19 vaccination for the age group 12-14 years was started on 16 March, 2022. So far, more than 72 lakh (**72,17,166**) adolescents have been administered with the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

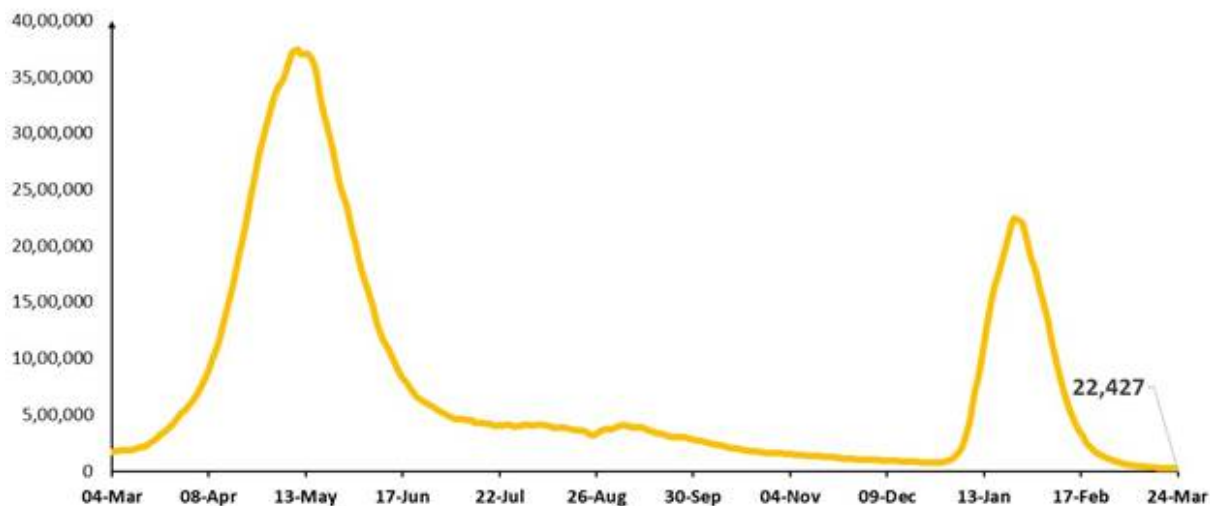

Following a continuous downward trend, India's Active Caseload has declined to **22,427** today, constituting **0.05%** of the country's total Positive Cases.



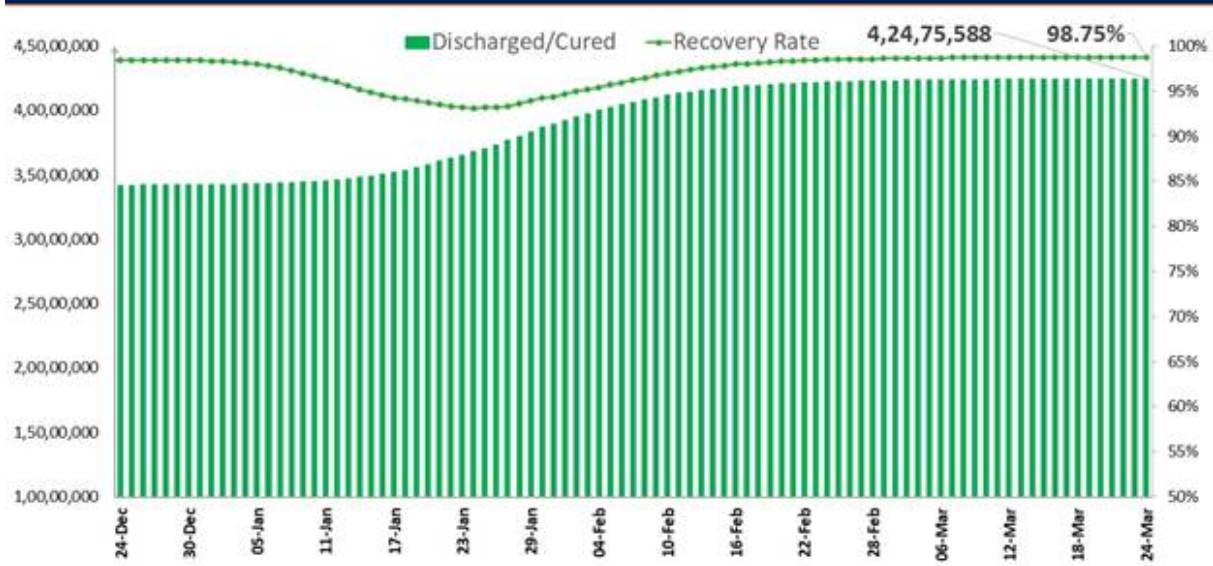
India's Active Cases Trajectory



Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **98.75%**. **2,531** patients have recovered in the last 24 hours and the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) is now at **4,24,75,588**.

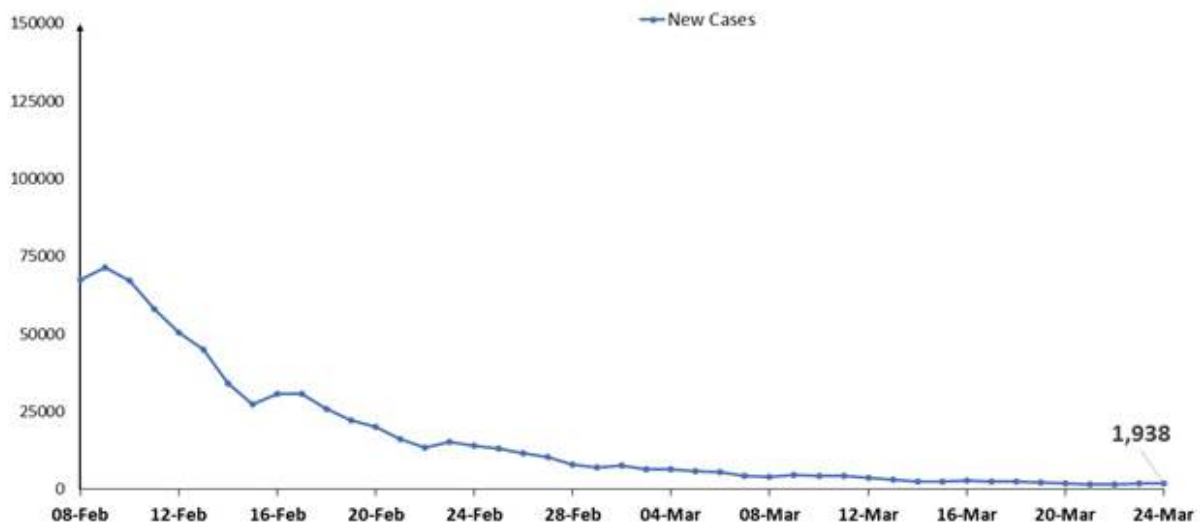


Recovered cases over 4.24 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.75%



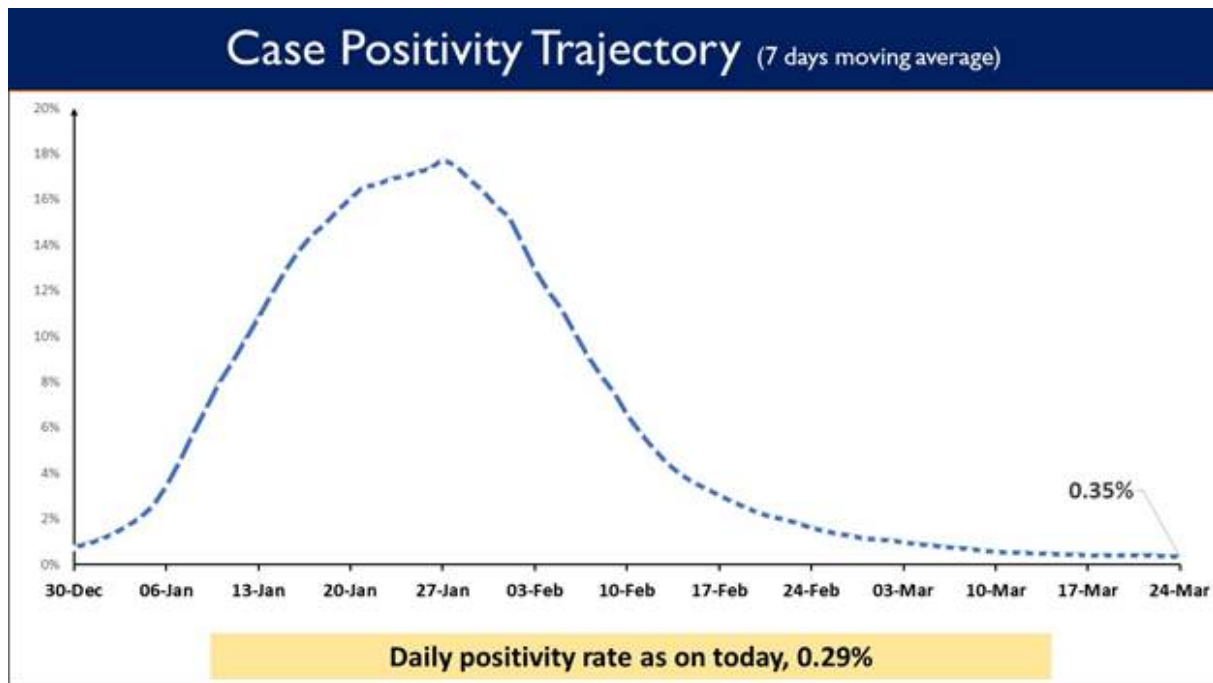
1,938 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

The last 24 hours saw a total of **6,61,954** COVID-19 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **78.49 Cr (78,49,52,800)** cumulative tests.

There has been a sustained fall in the weekly and daily Positivity Rates too. **Weekly Positivity Rate** in the country currently **stands at 0.35%** and the **Daily Positivity rate** is also reported to be **0.29%**.

Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

More than 184.07 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs

More than 16.68 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs

The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country. The nationwide COVID 19 vaccination started on 16th January 2021. The new phase of universalization of COVID-19 vaccination commenced from 21st June 2021. The vaccination drive has been ramped up through availability of more vaccines, advance visibility of vaccine availability to States and UTs for enabling better planning by them, and streamlining the vaccine supply chain.

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.
