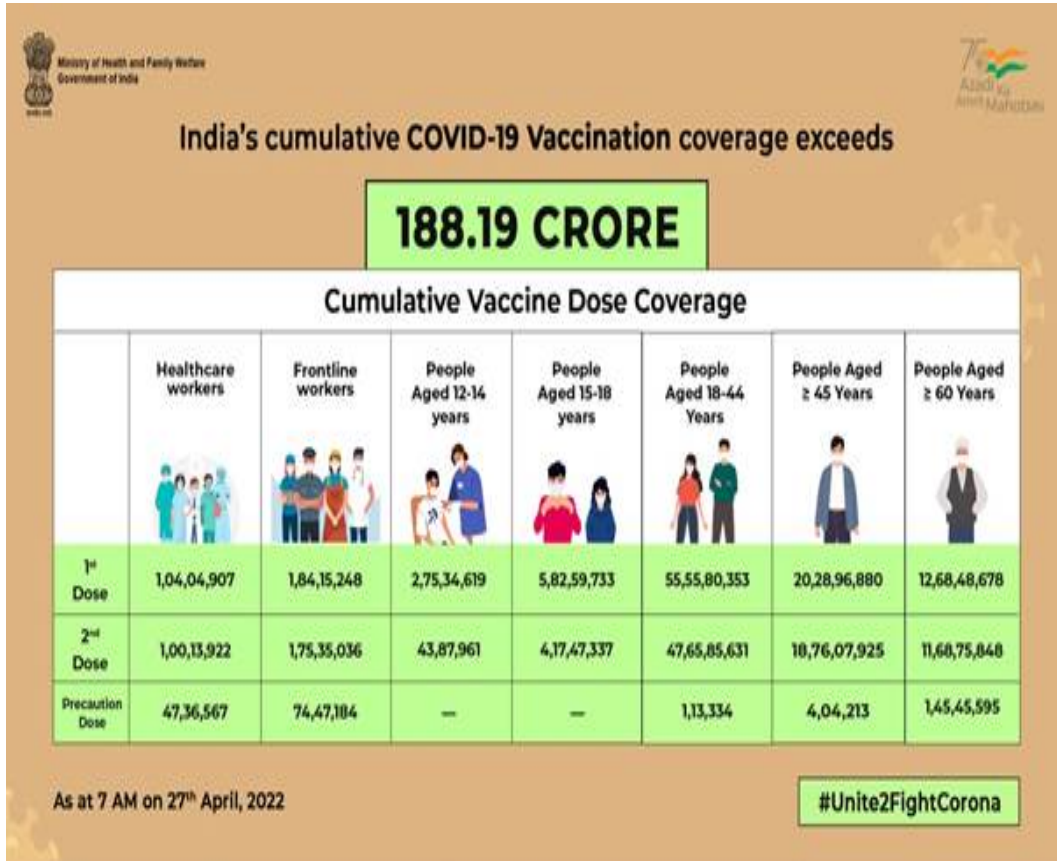

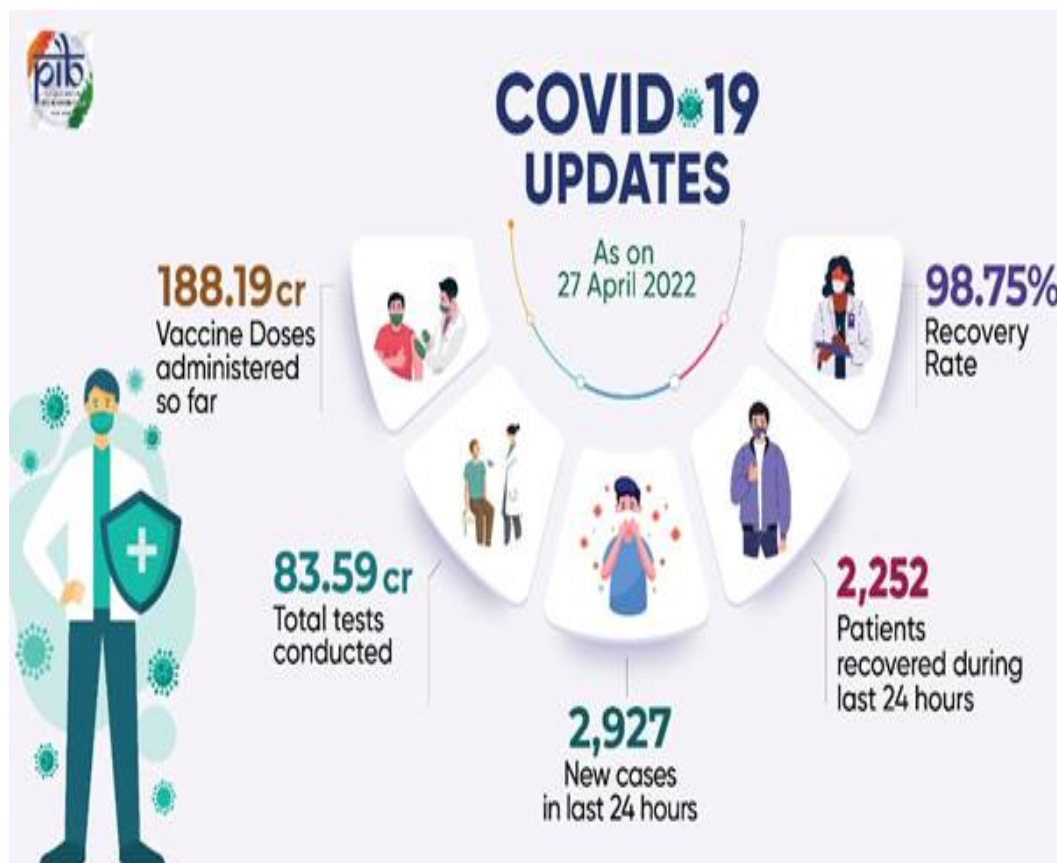

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**India's Cumulative COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage exceeds 188.19 Cr**

**Over 2.75 Cr 1st dose vaccines administered for age group 12-14 years**

**India's Active caseload currently stands at 16,279**

**2,927 new cases reported in the last 24 hours**

**Recovery Rate currently stands at 98.75%**

**Weekly Positivity Rate is presently at 0.59%**

India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has exceeded **188.19 Cr (1,88,19,40,971)** as per provisional reports till 7 am today. This has been achieved through 2,31,48,146 sessions.

COVID-19 vaccination for the age group 12-14 years was started on 16 March, 2022. So far, more than 2.75 Cr (**2,75,34,619**) adolescents have been administered with the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine. Similarly, the COVID-19 precaution dose administration for age group 18-59 years also started from 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 onwards. **5,17,547** precaution doses have been administered in age group 18-59 years so far.

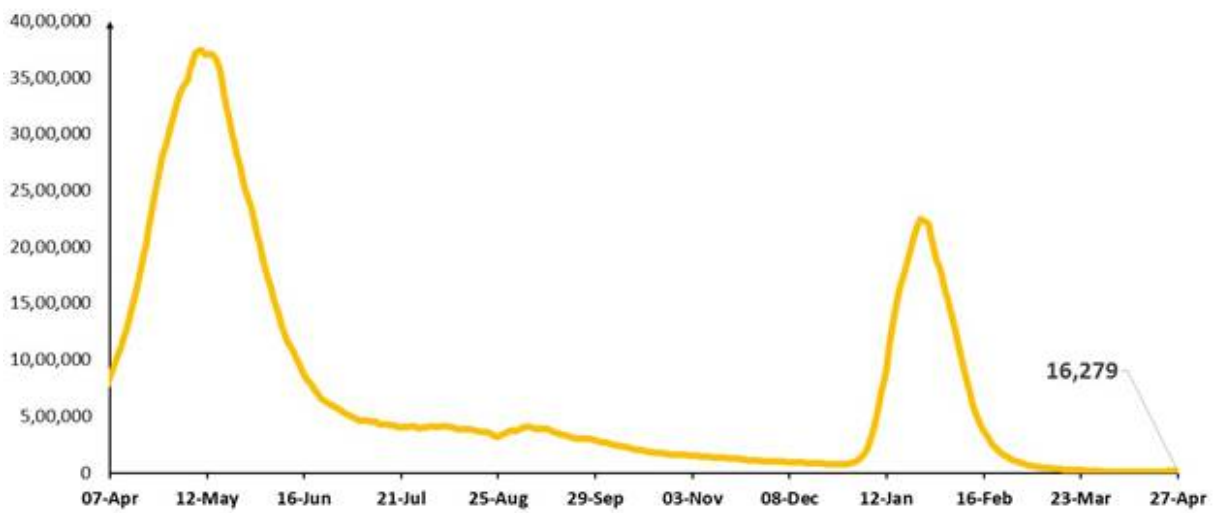

India's Active Caseload currently stands at **16,279**. Active cases now constitute **0.04%** of the country's total Positive Cases.

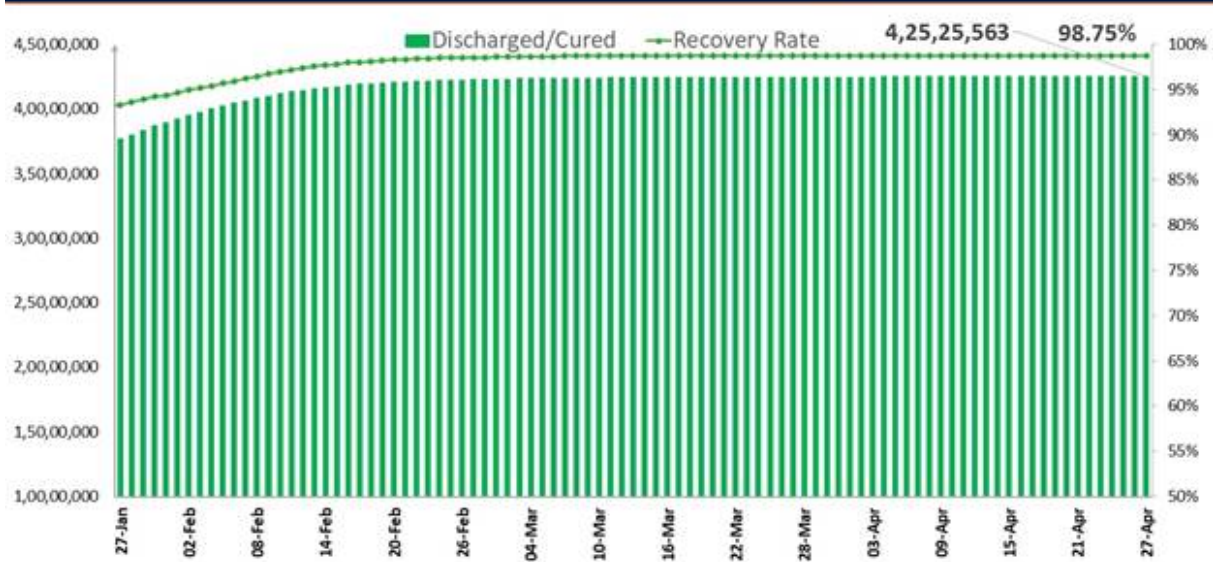
### India's Active Cases Trajectory



Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at **98.75%**. **2,252** patients have recovered in the last 24 hours and the cumulative tally of recovered patients (since the beginning of the pandemic) is now at **4,25,25,563**.

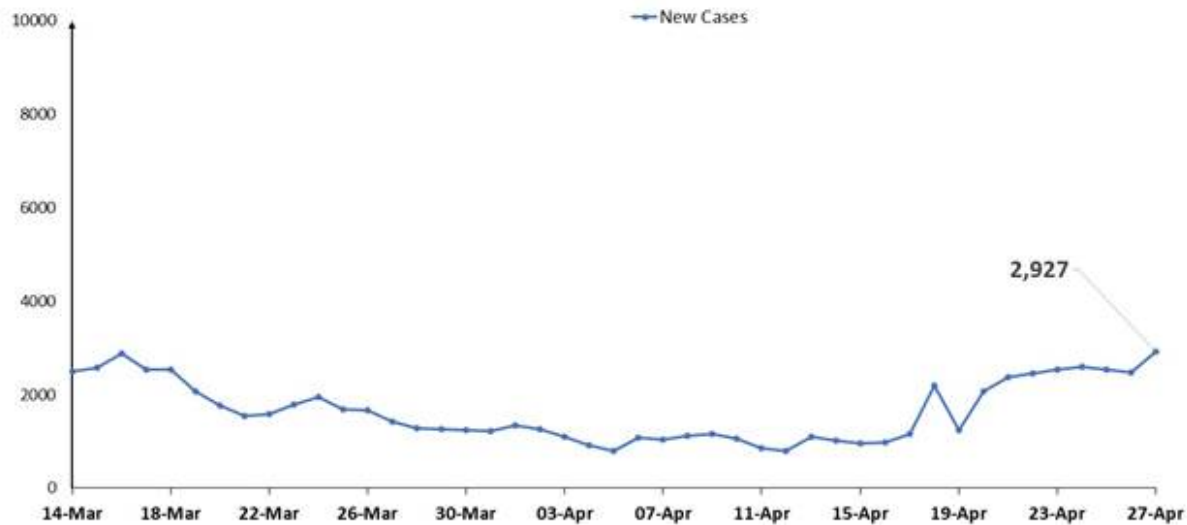


## Recovered cases over 4.25 Cr & Recovery rate at 98.75%



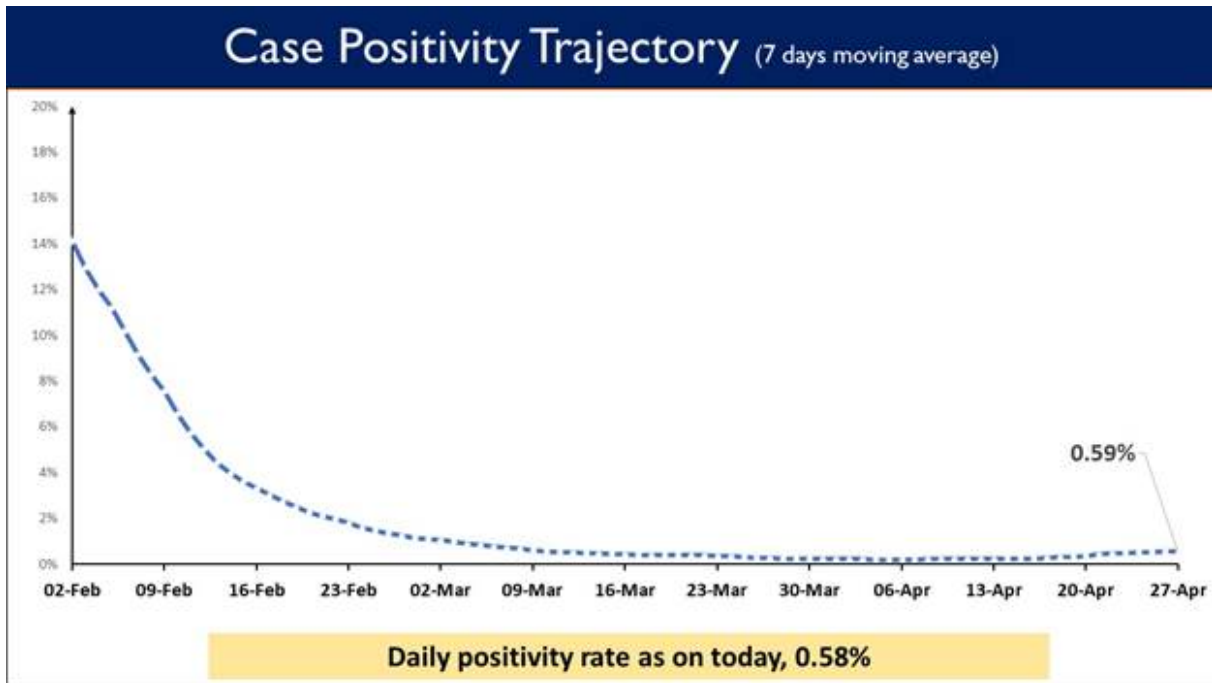
2,927 new cases were reported in the last 24 hours.

## Nearly 3K New Cases reported in last 24 hrs



The last 24 hours saw a total of **5,05,065** COVID-19 tests being conducted. India has so far conducted over **83.59 Cr (83,59,74,079)** cumulative tests.

**Weekly Positivity Rate** in the country currently stands at **0.59%** and the **Daily Positivity rate** is also reported to be **0.58%**.

### Update on COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in States/UTs

**More than 192.88 Crore vaccine doses provided to States/UTs**

**More than 19.70 Crore balance and unutilized vaccine doses still available with States/UTs**

The Union Government is committed to accelerating the pace and expanding the scope of COVID-19 vaccination throughout the country. The nationwide COVID 19 vaccination started on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2021. The new phase of universalization of COVID-19 vaccination commenced from 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021. The vaccination drive has been ramped up through availability of more vaccines, advance visibility of vaccine availability to States and UTs for enabling better planning by them, and streamlining the vaccine supply chain.

As part of the nationwide vaccination drive, Government of India has been supporting the States and UTs by providing them COVID Vaccines free of cost. In the new phase of the universalization of the COVID19 vaccination drive, the Union Government will procure and supply (free of cost) 75% of the vaccines being produced by the vaccine manufacturers in the country to States and UTs.

More than **19.70 Cr (19,70,98,585)** balance and unutilized COVID Vaccine doses are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.
