Subject:- Non-releasing of payments for engineering works.

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

2. It has been observed that Departments and Government agencies are using Haryana Engineering Works (HEW) portal to prepare estimates and to accord administrative approval for engineering works, but allotment and post allotment activities are being carried out through an offline mode. CM has directed that allotment of all engineering works and post-allotment action including filling of MB, processing of bills, pre-audit of bills in case of Panchayati Raj Institutions and Urban Local Bodies and payments should also be undertaken on the HEW portal only and not through the offline mode.


3. In view of this, it has been decided that no payments will be released for engineering works to be allotted on or after 26.12.2022, where allotment of works or post allotment actions are carried out through the offline mode. The Administrative Secretaries concerned will have to certify the same for release of payment.
