



**Subject: - Regarding ex-post facto sanction for journey performed by air.**

Will all the Administrative Secretaries to Government Haryana, kindly refer on the subject cited above?

It is observed that the matter regarding ex-post facto sanction and relaxation in Rule-21 of Haryana Civil Services (TA) Rules, 2016 are being received from various Departments without giving full justification for consideration of Finance Department.

In view of the above, it is advised that all Administrative Departments shall obtain such relaxation in rules prior to commencement of visit with full justification thereof. Ex-post facto shall not be considered by the Finance Department in future to avoid additional financial burden on the State Exchequer, until and unless there are exceptional circumstances to place on record.
