

12. Name of the Scheme:- Providing basic/infrastructural facilities in minority dominated rural areas.

1 Whose scheme is it:- Maharashtra Government scheme

2 Brief information about the scheme:- Guidelines and work to be undertaken under the scheme as per Government Decision No. Grakshevi/2015/Pr.Kr.77/Ka-9 dated 22.09.2015 from the Minority Development Department.

Work to be undertaken under the scheme:-

1.Construction of a protective wall (4 feet high and 1 foot wide) for the graveyard/cemetery/funeral site, water supply, electricity supply, and an internal road of 3 feet wide.

2.Construction of a public hall/wedding hall.

3.Drinking water facilities/electricity supply/Idgah/sewerage system/internal roads/streetlights/public toilets.

5) Scheme Criteria and Terms and Conditions

1. A Gram Panchayat with a population of at least 100 minorities is eligible.

2. Gram Panchayats are selected in descending order from the Z.P. level under the chairmanship of the Hon'ble District Collector.

3. The Chairman of the Minority Committee is the Hon'ble District Collector.

4. The Gram Sabha has the power to select the work and accordingly a resolution is required.

5. An extract of the land owned by the Gram Panchayat is required.

6. If the selected work is a road, then an extract of the Gram Panchayat Form No. 26 stating its name

7. Understanding Map

8. A certificate stating that the work selected by the Gram Sabha has not been taken from any other scheme is required.

9. The proposal is sent to the government for final approval on the recommendation of a committee appointed under the chairmanship of the Hon'ble District Collector.

6) Benefits of the scheme

- It helps in improving the standard of living in rural areas where there is a significant minority population. The scheme has been implemented since 2013-14.

- It is possible to provide comfort facilities in areas with a large minority population. Also, the citizens of these areas get the necessary comforts.
- A socially conducive environment is created in the village as well as in minority-dominated areas. The essential and urgent needs of the minority population will be fulfilled.
