1	Awareness of education system: from ancient Gyan Parampara to present education system, prominent higher education institutions and regulatory bodies, Committees, constitutional provisions.
2.	Diversity in learners: creativity, personality, intelligence, interest, learning preferences, disabilities, etc.

8.	Subject Knowledge: knowledge of core subjects: languages, science, mathematics, social science, humanities, contribution of Indian and other famous personalities in growth of disciplines, core concepts and their pedagogy
9.	ICT in education: recent developments and future technologies, government ICT initiatives like DIKSHA, NISHTHA, SWAYAM, PM eVIDYA, PRASHAST, SWAYAM, Assistive technology, Digital safety & cyber ethics etc.
10	Narratives: based on ideas of personalities like Gandhi, Vivekananda, Krishnamurti, Aurobindo, Savitribai Phule, Giju Bhai Badheka, Tagore etc. Some narratives may be taken from guiding documents, like NEP-2020, NCFs, etc.
