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CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 ABOUT NATIONAL TESTING AGENCY (NTA)

The Ministry of Education (MOE), Government of India (GOI) has established National Testing Agency (NTA) as an independent autonomous and self-sustained premier examining organization under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 for conducting efficient, transparent and international standards exams in order to assess the competency of candidates for admissions to premier higher educational institutions.

The objectives of NTA, inter-alia, include:

- i. To conduct efficient, transparent and international standard exams in order to assess the competency of candidates for admission.
- ii. To undertake research on educational, professional and examining system to identify gaps in the knowledge systems and take steps for bridging them.
- iii. To produce and disseminate information and research on education and professional development standards.

1.2 ABOUT NAVAYUG SCHOOL EDUCATION SOCIETY

The Navayug School Educational Society (NSES) is registered with Registrar of Societies, GNCTD under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 and is funded through support from the New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) in the form of 100% grant-in aid. NSES runs 12 Navayug Schools (07 Senior Secondary, 01 Secondary and 04 Primary Schools) in NDMC area. NSES is marking significant impact in the field of education by catering to quality education to about 9000 students through its schools.

1.3 NAVAYUG SCHOOL, SAROJINI NAGAR

Navayug school was set up on 16th February 1973 “as a gift for the gifted children of all castes and class on the 25th anniversary of our country with a vision to prepare the students to serve the country with their highly developed skills and a noble attitude of mind tuned to the ways of the new era ushering in an egalitarian society” by the then Prime Minister.

Navayug School, Sarojini Nagar has nurtured several generations of students, who have gone on to make remarkable contributions in various fields. Over the past five decades, the school has produced incredible alumni who have excelled in various fields such as Civil Services, defense, medicine, engineering, art, music, sports, accounts, journalism, media, law and other high-ranking professions. The school's legacy is built on a strong foundation of holistic education, blending academic rigor, value education, character development, good sportsmanship, leadership, music, and art.

Navayug School, Sarojini Nagar is a Co-educational English medium school. It offers CBSE curriculum-based education from classes VI to XII. It has an excellent infrastructure where various sports like Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Cricket, Table Tennis, Swimming, Badminton, Athletics and Chess are available under the close supervision and guidance of qualified staff. Full-fledged Department of Music and Department of Arts is also available in the school with dedicated and experienced teachers. The school has well equipped Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and Computer Laboratory. It has well organized digital Library and an ATL (Atal Tinkering Laboratory) which is a government initiative to encourage innovation among school students. Our school follows this program, providing students with a laboratory to ideate, create and innovate. The school has an active NCC wing

for girl cadets. To equip students with digital literacy as per NEP 2020 and NCF 2023, an advanced AR-VR (Augmented Reality-Virtual Reality) lab is being set up for immersive, experiential learning.

Uniform subsidy is provided to the students whose family income is less than Rs. 2 Lakh per annum. Free text books are provided to all students for classes VI to VIII. For classes IX to XII free text books are provided to the students whose family income is less than Rs. 2 Lakh per annum. It is a "Day school" located in District - New Delhi. The school does not have the Hostel as well as transport facility. Parents are responsible for providing safe transport facility for their ward.

1.4 ADMISSION TO NAVAYUG SCHOOL, SAROJINI NAGAR

Admission to the Navayug School Sarojini Nagar will be at Class VI and VII level only. It will be done purely on the basis of merit, i.e. marks obtained in a written test called **NSSNET-2026**. NSES has entrusted the responsibility of conducting the above test to NTA.

However, applicant should have passed in Class V / VI Annual examinations as on 31.03.2026 for admission in class VI and VII respectively from a recognized School.

1. NSSNET-2026 is a test for admission to Class-VI and VII in Navayug School, Sarojini Nagar, New Delhi for the academic year 2026-27.
2. Candidates can apply for NSSNET-2026 “Online” only on the website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/nssnet/> . The Application Form other than online mode will not be accepted.
3. There is no Fee for online registration and for appearing in the entrance Test - NSSNET-2026.
4. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. If a candidate submits more than one Application Form for admission at the same level, his/her Application Forms shall summarily be rejected.
5. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Information Bulletin and on NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/nssnet/>, <https://www.nta.ac.in>. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
6. Candidates must ensure that e-mail address and mobile number provided in the online application form are their own or that of their parents, as all information/communication will be sent by NTA through e-mail on the given e-mail address or SMS on given mobile number only.
7. Instructions for filling Online Application Form:
 - Download and read the Information Bulletin carefully to ensure your eligibility.
 - Follow the steps given below to Apply Online:

Step 1: Register online using unique Email ID and Mobile No.

Step 2: Fill in the Online Application Form and note down the system generated Application No. Upload the following documents:

- Scanned image of Candidate's Photograph - (file size: 10kb-200 kb) in JPG format
- Candidate's Signature - (file size: 10kb-50kb) in JPG format
- Candidate's left-hand thumb impression - (file size: 10kb to 50 kb) in JPG format
- PwD Certificate, if applicable - (file size: 50 kb to 300 kb) in PDF format
- Category Certificate, if applicable- (file size: 50 kb to 300 kb) in PDF format
- ID Proof (Aadhaar Card / any other Photo ID Card issued by any Govt. Authority or a Bonafide certificate (stating date of birth, parent's name, class & address of the candidate) with Photograph and Signature of the Candidate attested by the Principal of the School where the candidate is studying.
(file size: 10 kb to 200 kb) in JPG format.

(If the information given or documents uploaded are not correct or incomplete or cannot be corroborated with the required original certificates at the time of admission, the candidate is liable to be rejected and admission denied to him or her).

Both the above steps can be done together in one go or at different times.

8. The final submission of Online Application Form will remain incomplete if Step-2 is not complete. Such forms will stand rejected and no correspondence on this account will be entertained.
9. Candidates are advised to keep the application number and password generated during registration confidential and use them to view registration data and download admit card, results etc.
10. Any request to change the exam center, date and time provided on the admit cards shall not be considered under any circumstances.
11. The entire application process of NSSNET-2026 is online, including uploading of scanned images, certificates, and Printing of Confirmation Page. Therefore, candidates are not required to end/submit any document(s) including Confirmation Page to NTA through Post / Fax by Hand.
12. Candidates are advised to keep visiting the NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/nssnet/>, <https://www.nta.ac.in> regularly for all examination related updates and to check their emails. However, candidates are advised to visit the respective school website for information about the school.
13. Candidates must carry two transparent black ink ball point pens, admit card, passport size photograph, original school ID Card (latest), Aadhar card as photo ID proof and drinking water in a transparent water bottle at the examination centre. Candidates who do not bring these will not be allowed to sit in the examination.
14. PROCEDURE FOR FILLING THE ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

3.1 HOW TO APPLY FOR NSSNET-2026

A candidate can apply for NSSNET-2026, online only at <https://exams.nta.nic.in/nssnet/>.

Candidates are advised to:

- Read the Information Bulletin carefully and ensure that they fulfill the eligibility requirements before applying.
- Keep all required information such as scanned documents of photographs, signature, ID proof, Candidate's left-hand thumb impression reserved category/ PWD certificate (if applicable), mobile phones for getting OTPs, etc. before applying online so that the relevant document can be promptly uploaded.

Step I: Registration Page

- i. Candidate's Name/Mother's Name/Father's Name as in the school records. Date of Birth in dd/mm/yyyy format as recorded in date of birth certificate/school records.
- ii. Identification Type: Candidates need to provide any one of the following identity details:
 - Aadhaar Card / any other Photo ID Card issued by any Govt. Authority or a Bonafide certificate (stating date of birth, parent's name, class & address of the candidate) with Photograph and Signature of the Candidate attested by the Principal of the School where the candidate is studying.
- iii. Mobile Number and e-mail Address: Candidates must provide Mobile Number or email address (their own or that of their parents).
- iv. Provide complete postal address with PIN Code (Correspondence and Permanent address) for further correspondence.

Step II: Fill in the complete Application Form

The application particulars entered in Step-I can be edited before final submission of the Application Form except Mobile No. and Email address, which will not be changed after final submit of Application form.

Note:

- Candidates are advised to verify the correctness of the information provided by them by pre-viewing the online application form before final submission. If required candidates may edit their application form before submission.
- Only one application should be submitted by a candidate.
- Once finally submitted, details filled in certain specific fields may be changed only during correction window. After that no communication in this regard will be entertained.
- Candidates are not required to send / submit hard copy of Confirmation Page to NTA office. However, the candidates are advised to retain the hard copy of the Confirmation Page for future need.

Uploading of scanned images

Candidate's Photograph: to be uploaded

- Passport size Photograph (size: 10kb to 200kb) in JPG format.
- The photographs must be taken on or after **1st February 2026** preferably indicating clearly the name of candidate along with the date of taking the photograph. Photograph should not be with cap or goggles. The focus needs to be on face (80% face coverage, ears clearly visible, on white background)
- Spectacles are allowed only if being used regularly.
- Polaroid and Computer-generated photos are not acceptable.
- Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected.
- Application without photographs shall be rejected.
- The photographs need not be attested. Candidates are advised to keep 6 to 8 passport size and colour photographs with white background.
- Candidates may note that if the photographs uploaded are found to be fabricated or defaced or seem to be hand-made or computer made etc., the application of the Candidate will be rejected and the same will be considered as using Unfair Means (UFM) and the candidate would be dealt with accordingly.
- In case someone else's or unrelated photographs have been uploaded, the candidature shall be cancelled and the case will be considered as using UFM. Criminal action as per laws of the country shall also be initiated

Candidate's Signature: to be uploaded

- The candidate should put his/her full signature in running hand writing not in capital letter on white paper with Black Ink pen and scan for uploading.
- File size must be between 10kb to 50kb in JPG format.
- Online Application Forms without uploaded signatures will be rejected.
- In case someone else's signature has been uploaded, the candidature shall be cancelled and the case will be considered as using UFM. Criminal action as per laws of the country shall also be initiated.

Candidate's left-hand Thumb impression: to be uploaded

- Candidate's left-hand Thumb impression - (file size: 10kb to 50 kb) in JPG format

Uploading of other certificates:

- ID Proof (Aadhaar Card / any other Photo ID Card issued by any Govt. Authority or Bonafide certificate (stating date of birth, parent's name, class & address of the candidate) with Photograph and Signature of the Candidate attested by the Principal of the School where the candidate is studying) - (file size: 10 kb to 200 kb) in JPG format.
- Category certificate is to be uploaded, if applicable
- PwD certificate is to be uploaded, if applicable
- File size must be between 50 kb to 300 kb in PDF format.

3.2 CHECK LIST FOR FILLING THE ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

The candidates are advised to ensure the following points before submitting the Online Application Forms:

- Whether they fulfill the prescribed eligibility conditions for the exam.
- That they have furnished the correct name, address and date of birth.
- That they have selected their gender viz. Male/Female correctly.
- Whether they have kept a Printout of Application Form (Confirmation Page) for their own record.

Notes:

- The requisite documents (including original) and candidature will be verified at various stages of the exam process against the details provided by the candidates during the online registration/application. The candidature is liable to be rejected if the candidate fails to produce the requisite documents or if the candidate is not able to furnish the requisite documents which corroborates with the details given in the online application form.
- Candidates are advised to maintain secrecy regarding their application number and password so as to prevent change of profile or data filled by them by other unauthorized persons.

CHAPTER-4

ADMISSION GUIDELINES TO NAVAYUG SCHOOL, I – AVENUE, SAROJINI NAGAR

4.1 ADMISSION CRITERIA

Admission to Class VI and VII of the Navayug School, I – Avenue, Sarojini Nagar for the academic year 2026-27, is through a written examination called NSSNET-2026.

All admissions will be on merit basis. Reservation will be followed as per Government Norms.

Admission in Navayug School, I – Avenue, Sarojini Nagar in Class-VI and VII will be strictly on the merit basis by holding an Entrance Test. The class wise available seats are as under:

- However, the applicant should have passed in Class V / VI Annual examinations as on 31.03.2026 for admission in class VI and VII respectively from a recognized School.

4.2 ROLE OF NTA

NSSNET-2026 will be conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA).

The responsibility of NTA is limited to inviting online applications for NSSNET-2026, conduct of the NSSNET-2026, processing and declaration of result and providing the merit list to the NSES.

4.3 DATE OF NSSNET-2026

NSSNET-2026 covers admission to Class VI and VII for the session 2026-27 in the Navayug School, I – Avenue, Sarojini Nagar and will be held on **10.04.2026 (Friday)**.

4.4 IMPORTANT WEBSITES

The official website of NTA is <https://exams.nta.nic.in/nssnet/>, <https://www.nta.ac.in>. All the exam related information as amended from time-to-time, if any, will be available on this website only. Candidates must regularly view this website for exam updates.

Candidates are also advised to be in touch with the website of NDMC www.ndmc.gov.in for admission to Navayug School, I – Avenue, Sarojini Nagar, in Class VI and VII.

4.5 ELIGIBILITY TO APPEAR IN NSSNET-2026

- A candidate should be between 10 and 12 years as on 31st March 2026 for admission to Class VI, i.e. he/she should have been born between 01st April, 2014 and 31st March, 2016 (both days inclusive) for admission to the academic year 2026-27 and
- For Class VII, a candidate should be between 11 and 13 years as on 31st March 2026 for admission to Class VII, i.e. he/she should have been born between 01st April, 2013 and 31st March, 2015 (both days inclusive) for admission to the academic year 2026-27.
- Applicant should have passed/ appearing in Class V / VI Annual examinations as on 31.03.2026 for admission in class VI and VII respectively from a recognized School.

4.6 PASSING MARKS FOR ADMISSION

- **A candidate is eligible for admission to the Navayug School, Sarojini Nagar, if he/ she secures a minimum of 65% i.e. 78 marks in the aggregate with the condition that candidate should obtain at least 50% marks in each subject in NSSNET-2026 for admission in class VI or VII.**
- **However, the condition of minimum marks can be reviewed by NSES if a need so arises.**
- Admission will be based on the merit prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in NSSNET 2026, medical fitness and verification of requisite documents.

CHAPTER-5

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

5.1 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

NSSNET-2026 will be conducted as per the guidelines prescribed by the Navayug School Education Society (NSES).

- i. Merely appearing and passing in NSSNET-2026 does not confer any right to the candidate for admission to the Navayug School, Sarojini Nagar.
- ii. The selection and admission to Navayug School, Sarojini Nagar is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, rank in merit list, verification of original documents and such other criteria as may be prescribed by the Navayug School Education Society.
- iii. Applications of candidates submitting false and fabricated information will be rejected and such candidates will be further debarred from appearing in examinations conducted by NTA.
- iv. Incomplete application and applications not in accordance with instructions are liable to be rejected without any further intimation.
- v. Instructions in the Information Bulletin may change /be updated based on decisions taken by the NTA and other authorities from time to time. Candidates are advised to regularly check the website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/nssnet/> for any further updates or information.
- vi. NTA reserves the right to withdraw permission, granted inadvertently if any, to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the NSSNET-2026 even though the Admit Card had been issued by the NTA.

CHAPTER-6

FACILITY FOR PWD CANDIDATES

6.1 Provisions relating to Persons with Disability (PwD)/ Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD):

6.1.1 The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016:

The Gazette of India, Extraordinary Part-II Section 1, Ministry of Law And Justice (Legislative Department) New Delhi dated 28 December 2016 on “The Rights of Persons With Disabilities Act, 2016. The relevant paragraphs of the above Gazette Notification for consideration are as under: -

Para 2(r), “**persons with benchmark disabilities**” means **a person with not less than forty percent (40%) of a specified disability** where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority.

Para 2 (s) “**Persons with Disability (PwD)**” means a person with long term physical, mental, intellectual, or sensory impairment which, in interaction with barriers, hinders his full and effective participation in society equally with others.

Para 2 (zc) “specified disability” means the disabilities as specified in the schedule (Annexure-III).

6.1.2 Office Memorandum dated 29 August 2018:

Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, Office Memorandum No. F. No. 34- 02/2015-DD-III dated 29 August 2018 for conducting written examination for persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of Section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016. The relevant paragraphs of the above Office Memorandum for consideration are as under:-

Para IV. The facility of Scribe/Reader/Lab Assistant should be allowed to any person with benchmark disability as defined under section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016 and has limitation in writing including that of speed if so desired by him/her.

In case of persons with benchmark disabilities in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arm affected-BA) and cerebral palsy, the facility of scribe/reader/lab assistant shall be given, if so desired by the person.

In case of other category of persons with benchmark disabilities, the provision of scribe/reader/lab assistant can be allowed on production of a certificate to the effect that person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government health care institution as per proforma at **Annexure-IV**

In case the candidate is allowed to bring his own scribe, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking examination. The person opting for own scribe should submit details of the own scribe as per proforma at **Annexure-V**.

6.1.3 Office Memorandum dated 10 August 2022:

Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, Office Memorandum No F. No. 29- 6/2019-DD-III dated 10 August 2022 for conducting written examination for persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of Section 2(s) of the RPwD Act, 2016 but not covered under the definition of Section 2(r) of the said Act, i.e. person having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing. The relevant paragraphs of the above Office Memorandum for consideration are as under: -

Para 3 (b) The facility of scribe and/or compensatory time shall be granted solely to those having difficulty in writing subject to production of a certificate to the effect that person concerned has limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf from the competent medical authority of a Government healthcare institution as per proforma at **Annexure-VI**.

Para 3 (c) The medical authority for the purpose of certification as mentioned above should be a multi-member authority comprising the following: -

- i. Chief Medical officer/Civil Surgeon /Chief District Medical Officer, Chairperson
- ii. Orthopaedic/PMR specialist
- iii. Neurologist, if available*
- iv. Clinical Psychologist/Rehabilitation Psychologist/
Psychiatrist/Special Educator Occupational therapist, if available*
- v. Any other expert based on the condition of the candidate as may be nominated by the Chairperson.

(* the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Chief District Medical Officer may make full efforts for inclusion of neurologists, occupational therapist from the nearest District or the Medical College/Institute, if the same is not available in the District)”

The candidate should fill up the details of scribe as per undertaking proforma at **Annexure-VII**.

6.1.4 Scribe and Compensatory Time

1. The candidate should have the discretion of opting for his own scribe / reader / lab assistant or request the Examination Body for the same. The examining body may also identify the scribe / reader / lab assistant to make panels at the District / Division / State level as per the requirements of the examination. In such instances the candidates should be allowed to meet the scribe two days before the examinations so that the candidates get a chance to check and verify whether the scribe is suitable or not.
2. The word “extra time or additional time” that is being currently used should be changed to “compensatory time” and the same should not be less than 20 minutes per hour of examination for persons who are allowed use of scribe / reader / lab assistant. All the candidates with benchmark disabilities who are eligible for availing the facility of scribe in terms of guidelines vide para IV of Para 4.2.2 above may be allowed additional time of minimum of one hour for examination of 3 hours duration whether they use the facility of scribe or not. In case the duration of the examination is less than an hour, then the duration of additional time should be allowed on pro-rata basis. Additional time should not be less than 5 minutes and should be in the multiple of 5”.

Note:

- ❖ Both the guidelines i.e. dated 29 August 2018 (for PwBDs) and dated 10 August 2022 (for PwDs) have other important aspects such as allowing use of assistive devices, proper seating arrangement, accessibility of examination centres etc. which will be followed. The scribe will help the Candidate in reading the questions and / or keying in the answers as per the directions of the Candidate. A scribe will NEITHER explain the questions NOR suggest any solution to the Candidate.
- ❖ It is to be noted that the Scribe will be provided by the National Testing Agency (NTA), if requested by the Candidate. If it is found at any stage that a candidate has availed the services of a scribe and/or availed the compensatory time but does not possess the extent of disability that warrants the use of a scribe and/or grant of compensatory time, the candidate will be excluded from the process of evaluation, ranking, counselling and admission. In case such a candidate has already been admitted to any Institution, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled.
- ❖ Physical Disability certificate/Unique Disability Identification (UDID)) issued by the notified medical authority needs to be uploaded in the Online Application Form of NSSNET-2026.
- ❖ The NTA does not guarantee any change in the category or sub-category (PwD/PwBD status) after the submission of the Online Application Form, and in any case, no change will be entertained by NTA after the declaration of NTA Score for NSSNET- 2026. The category/subcategory (PwD/PwBD status) entered in the NSSNET-2026 Database by the candidate will be used as final. Therefore, the candidates are advised to fill in the category/sub-category column very carefully.
- ❖ The extent of “specified disability” in a person shall be assessed in accordance with the “Guidelines for the purpose of assessing the extent of specified disability in a person included under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

BARRED ITEMS

7.1 BARRED ITEMS

Candidates are not allowed to carry the following items inside the examination centre under any circumstances. Candidates will be subjected to extensive and compulsory frisking before entering the exam centre with the help of hand-held metal detectors.

- Any stationery item like textual material (printed or written) bits of papers, geometry/pencil box, plastic pouch, calculator, docu-pen, scale, writing pad, pen drives, eraser, electronic pen or scanner etc
- Any communication device like mobile phone, blue tooth, earphones, micro phone, pager, health band etc.
- Other items like wallet, goggles, handbags, belt, cap etc
- Any watch or wristwatch, bracelet, camera etc
- Any ornaments/metallic item
- Any food item opened or packed
- Any other item which could be used for unfair means, by hiding communication device like microchip, camera, Bluetooth device etc.

No arrangement will be made at the centres for keeping any articles / items belonging to the candidates.

In case any candidate is found in possession of any of the barred items inside the centre it will be considered as use of Unfair Means and action will be taken against the candidate in accordance with the relevant provisions.

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

8.1 INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- It is expected that parents/guardians will guide their wards appropriately on the following issues before leaving home for appearing in NSSNET-2026.
- Candidates should avoid coming with more than one escort (parent/ guardian). Escorts shall remain outside the gate during the conduct of the examination.
- Candidate will not be allowed to enter the exam centre after 10.30 AM. Therefore, the candidate shall leave home well in advance, taking into consideration various factors such as traffic, location of the centre and weather conditions etc. It would be appropriate to visit the centre a day before the examination to confirm the location, distance etc. to avoid any problem of reaching late at the centre and then not being allowed to appear in the examination.
- Candidate shall follow all the instructions and maintain discipline in the examination hall.
- Candidate shall not breach any examination rule.
- Candidate shall not use or promote any unfair means activity during the examination.
- Candidate will not be allowed to leave the exam hall till the conclusion of the exam.
- Candidate is advised not to attend examination on an empty stomach.
- In case the candidate finds another candidate using unfair means in the examination, the same shall be immediately informed to the invigilators on duty.
- Candidate are permitted to bring only the following items, to the examination centre:
- Admit card (with Self Declaration on it downloaded from NTA website) with passport size photograph and left hand thumb impression affixed on it.
- Valid and original Photo ID proof. (School ID Card (with Photo)/Passport/ Aadhar Card (With photograph/Bonafide certificate with photo and sign attested by Principal/H.M. of the school).
- Passport size photograph for affixing on the attendance sheet
- Two simple transparent black ink ball point pens
- Drinking water in a personal transparent water bottle
- A candidate shall not bring any barred items to the centre.
- Candidate shall co-operate in frisking with the staff at Examination Centre.
- Candidate will report at the centre at the time indicated on his/her admit card to make themselves available for compulsory frisking and completing other registration procedures.
- Candidates are advised to regularly visit website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/nssnet/>, <https://www.nta.ac.in> and also check registered email /SMS for any update regarding examination.
- In case your ward is found breaching any of the above-mentioned rules, your ward will not be permitted to enter the examination centre and will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- If your ward indulges in any unwanted activities, he/ she shall be debarred from taking this examination as per rules and shall also be liable for criminal action and or any action as may be deemed fit by NTA.

CHAPTER-9

ADMIT CARD

9.1 ADMIT CARD

The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility conditions.

Admit card will be uploaded on the NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/nssnet/>, <https://www.nta.ac.in> 04 – 6 days prior to the date of the exam.

The candidate has to download the Admit Card from the NTA website using their application number and date of birth and appear for the Examination at the given Centre on Date and Timing as indicated in his/her Admit Card.

Admit card is not transferable to any other person. Impersonation is a legally punishable offence.

No candidate will be allowed to appear at the examination centre, on Date and Timing other than that allotted to him/her in his/her Admit card.

In case candidate is unable to download Admit Card from the website, the candidate should approach the NTA Help Line between 10:00 am and 05:00 pm.

The candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Information Bulletin as well as on the Admit Card carefully and follow them during the conduct of the examination.

In case of any discrepancy in the details filled by the candidate or his/her photograph and signatures shown in the Admit Card and Confirmation Page, the candidate may immediately approach the Help Line between 10.00 am and 5.00 pm (Monday to Saturday). In such cases, candidates would appear in the examination with the already downloaded Admit Card. However, NTA will take necessary action to make correction in the records later.

Note:

- a. Candidate must be in possession of the Admit Card to appear in the examination.
- b. Candidate may please note that Admit Card will not be sent by post.
- c. In no case, the duplicate Admit Card for NSSNET-2026 would be issued at the Examination Centres.
- d. Candidate must not mutilate / disfigure the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- e. Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
- f. No Admit Card shall be issued to the candidates whose Applications are found to be incomplete for any reason (including indistinct/ doubtful photographs / without uploaded signatures) or who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria for the examination.
- g. Issue of Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of admission process.

CHAPTER-10

INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED IN THE EXAMINATION HALL

10.1 INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED IN THE EXAMINATION HALL

The Examination Centre will be opened two (02) hours before the commencement of the exam. Candidates must ensure that they leave home well in advance considering all factors like location of the centre, traffic, weather conditions, etc. Candidates are expected to report for the exam at the time indicated on their admit card.

- a) However candidates are advised to arrive early to avoid last minute rush and crowding at the Verification Point and the consequent delay in entering the Examination Hall/Room for important activities like Scanning for temperature, Frisking, Checking of Admit Cards, Identification and Document Verification, Instructions, Writing particulars on Exam Booklet etc.
- b) The candidate must show, on demand, the Admit Card for admission in the Examination Hall. A candidate who does not possess a valid Admit Card shall not be allowed to enter the Examination Hall by the Centre Superintendent.
- c) Candidate is to appear in the Examination only from the Examination Centre allotted to him/ her and as reflected in the Admit Card. Under no circumstances, will he/ she be permitted to appear in the Examination at a different Examination Centre.
- d) A seat with the roll number written on it, will be allotted to each candidate. Candidates must find out and occupy their allotted seats. If a candidate is found appearing in the Examination from a seat or room other than the allotted one, his/her candidature shall be cancelled.
- e) During the examination time, the Invigilator will check Admit Card of the candidates to ascertain the identity of each candidate. The Invigilators will also put their own signature in the place provided in the Answer Sheet and on the Attendance Sheet.
- f) A candidate who comes after 10.30 AM shall not be permitted to enter the Examination Centre under any circumstances.

- g) Candidates must bring ONLY the following items on the day of examination at the exam centre. Candidates who do not bring these will not be allowed to sit in the examination.
- Printed copy of Admit Card downloaded from NTA website with passport size photograph (same as the photograph uploaded on the Application form) and left-hand thumb impression affixed on it.
 - Any one of the authorized photo IDs (must be original and valid-like School ID card / Aadhaar / Passport/ Bonafide certificate with photo and sign attested by Principal/H.M. of the school/any other valid photo ID issued by the Government).
 - Passport size photograph for affixing on the attendance sheet
 - Two simple transparent black ink ball point pens
 - Drinking water in a personal transparent water bottle
- h) Candidates are not allowed to bring any barred item or any item which could be used for Unfair practices. Possession of any such article with the candidates inside the Centre premises will attract penalty of unfair practice.
- i) Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the barred items to the venue of the examination as arrangement for safe keeping will not be made and candidates found in possession of these items will not be allowed to enter the Examination Centre.
- j) Smoking in the examination centre is strictly prohibited.
- k) The Exam will start exactly at the time mentioned in the Admit Card and an announcement to this effect will be made by the Invigilator.
- l) Before the start of Examination, important instructions will be communicated to the candidates by the Invigilator for strict compliance by the candidates.
- m) A signal will be given at the beginning of the examination and at half-time. A signal will also be given before the closing time when the candidates must stop marking the responses.
- n) The candidates must sign on the Attendance Sheet at the specified place. The candidates are also required to put their left-hand thumb Impression and affix photograph in the space provided on the Attendance Sheet.
- o) The candidate will check and ensure that the Exam Booklet contains as many numbers of pages as are written on the top of the cover page.
- p) No candidate will leave his/her seat or the Examination Room/Hall until the Exam concludes as per the schedule. Candidates should not leave the Room/Hall without handing over their OMR Sheets to the invigilator on duty.
- q) For those who are unable to appear on the scheduled date of exam for any reason, re-exam shall not be held by the NTA under any circumstances.

USE OF UNFAIR MEANS / MALPRACTICE**11.1 USE OF UNFAIR MEANS/MALPRACTICE**

Use of unfair means or malpractice allows a candidate to gain an undue advantage over other candidates. It includes, but is not limited to:

- a) Being in possession of any item or article which has been prohibited or can be used unfairly, including any stationery item, communication device, accessories, eatable items, ornaments or any other material or information relevant or not relevant to the examination in the paper concerned;
- b) Using someone to write examination (impersonation) or preparing material for copying;
- c) Breaching examination rules or any direction issued by NTA from time to time in connection with the conduct of NSSNET-2026 examination.
- d) Assisting other candidates to engage in malpractices, giving or receiving assistance of any kind, directly or indirectly or attempting to do so;
- e) Writing questions or answers on any material other than on the OMR answer sheet given by the Centre Superintendent for writing answers;
- f) Tearing of answer sheet, any page of the exam booklet etc.;
- g) Contacting or communicating or trying to do so with any person, other than the Examination Staff, during the examination time in the Examination Centre;
- h) Taking away the answer sheet out of the examination hall/room;
- i) Smuggling out answer sheet or part thereof;
- j) Threatening any of the officials connected with the conduct of the examination or threatening any of the candidates or using violence against anyone;
- k) Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the examination;
- l) Manipulation and fabrication of online documents viz. admit card, rank letter, self-declaration, etc;
- m) Forceful entry/exit in/from Examination Centre/Hall;
- n) Use or attempted use of any electronic device after entering the Examination Centre;
- o) Affixing/uploading of wrong/morphed photographs on the application form/admit card / proforma;
- p) Erasing or obliterating any information printed on the OMR answer sheet;
- q) Providing incorrect information on the answer sheet;
- r) Creating obstacles in smooth and fair conduct of examination or creating disturbance to others inside the examination hall / room / centre.
- s) Making an approach or attempting to influence the outcome of the result after the examination.
- t) Any other malpractice declared as unfair means by the NTA.

11.2 PUNISHMENT FOR USING UNFAIR MEANS/MALPRACTICE

During the course of, before or after the examination if a candidate indulges in any of the above or similar incident, he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair practices and booked under UNFAIRMEANS (UFM) case. The candidate would be debarred for 3 years in future and shall also be liable for criminal action and/or any other action as deemed fit.

11.3 CANCELLATION OF RESULT

- a) The result of NSSNET-2026 of the candidates who indulge in Unfair Means/ Malpractice will be cancelled and will not be declared.
- b) Similarly, the result of those candidates who appear from the Centre other than the one allotted to them, write on the Exam booklet / OMR Sheet of other candidates or allow other candidates to write on their Exam Booklet / OMR Sheet will be cancelled (and will not be declared).

CHAPTER 12

DECLARATION OF RESULT

12.1 PROCEDURE FOR DECLARATION OF RESULT:

The National Testing Agency will evaluate the Answer Sheets using standard procedure and declare the results. The respective mark-sheet can be downloaded by individual candidates through their login on the website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/nssnet>, <https://www.nta.ac.in>. Date of declaration of result will be hosted on NTA website.

12.2 MARKING SCHEME

- (a) Each question carries 01 (One) mark.
- b) There is no negative marking.
- (c) Un-answered/Un-attempted question will be given no marks.
- (d) To answer a question, the candidate needs to choose one option as the correct option.
- € If it is found that more than one option is correct, then 01(One) mark will be awarded to all those candidates who have attempted anyone of the correct options.
- (f) If all options are found to be correct 01 (One) mark to be awarded to all those candidates, who have attempted the question.
- (g) If none of the options is correct/Question is found to be wrong–All students who appeared in the exam would be awarded 01 (One) mark.

12.3 INTER-SE MERIT OF CANDIDATES IN CASE OF A TIE

In case the total marks scored by two or more candidates in NSSNET-2026 are equal, the inter-se merit shall be determined as follows:

12.5 RESULTS & MERIT LIST

NTA will prepare the result sheet in the format/s required by Navayug School Educational Society. Result will be prepared by NTA and hosted on NTA website.

Scoring / passing marks does not assure candidate's admission, which is based on vacancies, merit and subject to verification of documents / Certificates.

12.6 VALIDITY OF RESULT

The validity of the result of NSSNET-2026 for class VI and VII shall be only for the current admission year i.e., 2026-27 academic year and cannot be carried forwarded for the next session.

12.7 RE-CHECKING / RE-EVALUATION OF ANSWER SHEETS

- The machine-gradable Answer Sheets are evaluated with extreme care and are repeatedly scrutinized.
- There is no provision for re-checking/re-evaluation of the answer sheets. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

12.8 LEGAL JURISDICTION:

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of NSSNET - 2026 Examination including Results shall fall within the jurisdiction of Delhi only. Further, any legal question arising out of the Examination shall be entertained only when raised within 30 days from the declaration of result.

The Director (Administration) of the NTA shall be the official by whose designation the NTA may sue or be sued in any matter concerning the conduct and Result of the Examination.

12.9 RETENTION POLICY:

The record of NSSNET-2026 would be preserved up to 60 days from the date of declaration of result.

SPECIFIED DISABILITY

I. Physical disability.—

A. Locomotor disability (a person's inability to execute distinctive activities associated with movement of self and objects resulting from affliction of musculoskeletal or nervous system or both), including—

(a) "leprosy cured person" means a person who has been cured of leprosy but is suffering from—

(i) loss of sensation in hands or feet as well as loss of sensation and paresis in the eye and eye-lid but with no manifest deformity;

(ii) manifest deformity and paresis but having sufficient mobility in their hands and feet to enable them to engage in normal economic activity;

(iii) extreme physical deformity as well as advanced age which prevents him/her from undertaking any gainful occupation, and the expression "leprosy cured" shall construed accordingly;

(b) "cerebral palsy" means a Group of non-progressive neurological condition affecting body movements and muscle coordination, caused by damage to one or more specific areas of the brain, usually occurring before, during or shortly after birth;

(c) "dwarfism" means a medical or genetic condition resulting in an adult height of 4 feet 10 inches (147 centimeters) or less;

(d) "muscular dystrophy" means a group of hereditary genetic muscle disease that weakens the muscles that move the human body and persons with multiple dystrophy have incorrect and missing information in their genes, which prevents them from making the proteins they need for healthy muscles. It is characterised by progressive skeletal muscle weakness, defects in muscle proteins, and the death of muscle cells and tissue;

(e) "acid attack victims" means a person disfigured due to violent assaults by throwing of acid or similar corrosive substance.

B. Visual impairment—

(a) "blindness" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, after best correction—

(i) total absence of sight; or

(ii) visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible correction; or

(iii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degree.

(b) "low-vision" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, namely:—

(i) visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 or less than 20/60 upto 3/60 or upto 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible corrections; or

(ii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 40 degree up to 10 degree.

C. Hearing impairment—

(a) "deaf" means persons having 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;

(b) "hard of hearing" means person having 60 DB to 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;

D. "speech and language disability" means a permanent disability arising out of conditions such as laryngectomy or aphasia affecting one or more components of speech and language due to organic or neurological causes.

2. Intellectual disability, a condition characterised by significant limitation both in intellectual functioning (reasoning, learning, problem solving) and in adaptive behaviour which covers a range of every day, social and practical skills, including—

(a) "specific learning disabilities" means a heterogeneous group of conditions wherein there is a deficit in processing language, spoken or written, that may manifest itself as a difficulty to comprehend, speak, read, write, spell, or to do mathematical calculations and includes such conditions as perceptual disabilities, dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, dyspraxia and developmental aphasia;

(b) "autism spectrum disorder" means a neuro-developmental condition typically appearing in the first three years of life that significantly affects a person's ability to communicate, understand relationships and relate to others, and is frequently associated with unusual or stereotypical rituals or behaviours.

3. Mental behaviour,—

"mental illness" means a substantial disorder of thinking, mood, perception, orientation or memory that grossly impairs judgment, behaviour, capacity to recognise reality or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life, but does not include retardation which is a condition of arrested or incomplete development of mind of a person, specially characterised by subnormality of intelligence.

4. Disability caused due to—

(a) chronic neurological conditions, such as—

(i) "multiple sclerosis" means an inflammatory, nervous system disease in which the myelin sheaths around the axons of nerve cells of the brain and spinal cord are damaged, leading to demyelination and affecting the ability of nerve cells in the brain and spinal cord to communicate with each other;

(ii) "parkinson's disease" means a progressive disease of the nervous system marked by tremor, muscular rigidity, and slow, imprecise movement, chiefly affecting middle-aged and elderly people associated with degeneration of the basal ganglia of the brain and a deficiency of the neurotransmitter dopamine.

(b) Blood disorder—

(i) "haemophilia" means an inheritable disease, usually affecting only male but transmitted by women to their male children, characterised by loss or impairment of the normal clotting ability of blood so that a minor wound may result in fatal bleeding;

(ii) "thalassemia" means a group of inherited disorders characterised by reduced or absent amounts of haemoglobin.

(iii) "sickle cell disease" means a hemolytic disorder characterised by chronic anemia, painful events, and various complications due to associated

tissue and organ damage; "hemolytic" refers to the destruction of the cell membrane of red blood cells resulting in the release of hemoglobin.

5. Multiple Disabilities (more than one of the above specified disabilities) including deaf blindness which means a condition in which a person may have combination of hearing and visual impairments causing severe communication, developmental, and educational problems.

6. Any other category as may be notified by the Central Government.


