Following steps may be followed to Apply Online:

1. Apply For Online Registration
2. Fill Online Application Form
3. Pay Examination Fee
4. Download Confirmation Page

Procedure for Online Registration and Application Process

1. Candidates must apply for SWAYAM- 2026 (January Semester) "Online" ONLY by accessing the website <https://www.nta.ac.in//swayam/> The Application Form other than online mode would not be accepted in any case. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. More than one application i.e., multiple Application Forms submitted by a candidate will be rejected.
2. Please download and read carefully the Information Bulletin and instructions/ procedure given therein before filling the Online Application Form.
3. You can apply for SWAYAM January 2026 Semester 'ON-LINE' only through the official website of SWAYAM (<https://www.nta.ac.in/>).
4. **Candidates must use the same email ID throughout the course duration** – for enrolling in course(s) and registering for exam(s). Assignments submitted through any other email ID will not be considered for the final consolidated score and certification. (Email ID should be same as used for enrollment of SWAYAM courses. (<https://swayam.gov.in/>).
5. If you are providing the APAAR ID in the application, please ensure that the Name, Date of Birth, and Gender entered in the form are consistent with the details available in the APAAR system. In case of any mismatch, SWAYAM will not be able to transfer the credits to the ABC system.
6. **Application Procedure: 3 simple Steps to be followed to apply online:-**

Step 1: Register for Online Application Form and note down system generated Application Number. The candidate should supply the required details while filling up the Online Application Form and is also required to create PASSWORD and choose Security Question and enter his/her Answer. After successful submission of the personal details, Application number will be generated, and it will be used to complete the remaining Steps of the Application Form and will also be required for all future reference/ correspondence. For subsequent logins, candidate will be able to login directly with the respective system generated Application Number and created Password.

Step 2: Complete the Application Form. Candidate can login with the system generated Application Number and created Password for completing the Application Form.

- Upload Scanned Images (Clearly legible) of Candidate's Photograph, Signature and Documents (as applicable).

- The recent passport size photograph should be either in colour or black & white with 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against white background. Photograph should be JPG/JPEG format (clearly legible) between 10 kb to 200 kb.
- Signature file JPG/JPEG format between 10 kb to 50 kb.
- Scanned copy of PwD/PwBD/UDID certificate (if applicable) should be in pdf format between 50 kb to 300 kb.
- Select the course in which student wants to register for the examination.
- You must select the Exam Date followed by course name, the exam centre by first selecting the State and then the city within the State.
- You must give four choices for your exam centres. Giving four choices is mandatory.
- Please note that in case there are less students opting for an exam centre (city) no exam will be held in that centre. So, you are advised to give all four choices in their order of preference.
- Check all details on the preview page. If you wish to edit the exam city choices, then you must delete the selected course(s) and again add the course(s) with desired exam city choices

Note: Upload the correct photograph, signature as the facility for correction will not be given.

Step 3: The candidate has to select Debit card/Credit card/UPI/Net banking option to pay the application fee and follow the online instruction to complete the payment of fee. After successful payment, candidate will be able to print the Confirmation Page. In case the Confirmation Page is not generated after payment of fee then the transaction is cancelled and the candidates have to approach the concerned bank for refund of amount. However the candidate has to make another payment/transaction, in case the Confirmation Page is not generated. (details are at **Annexure-I**).

7. The Application Number printed on the computer generated Confirmation Page must be mentioned in all such correspondences. It is therefore essential to note down the application number printed on the Confirmation Page.
8. Step by step screenshots of procedure for exam registration are available in [Annexure-IV](#).

Check List for filling in the Online Application Form:

The candidates are advised to ensure the following points before filling in the Online Application Forms:

- i. Whether they fulfill the eligibility conditions for the Test as prescribed under the heading '**Conditions of Eligibility**'.
- ii. That they have filled their gender and category viz General/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/Gen-EWS/SC/ ST/ Male/Female/Transgender, in the relevant column correctly.
- iii. That they have filled their **Subject and City of Examination** in the relevant column correctly.
- iv. That the PwD/PwBD candidate may fill the relevant column in the Online Application Form. Only PwD/PwBD candidates must fill this column, and the others have to leave it blank.
- v. Whether they have kept a printout of Application Form (confirmation page) for their own record.

Important Points to Note:

- i. The Candidates should fill their complete postal address with PIN Code for further correspondence.
- ii. The Candidate must ensure that the e-mail address and Mobile Number provided in **the Online Application Form are their own (as it cannot be changed later)** as communication may be sent by NTA through e-mail or SMS.
- iii. The Candidate should not give the postal address, Mobile Number, or e-mail ID of Coaching Centre in the Online Application Form.
- iv. To appear in SWAYAM-2026 (January Semester), the candidates are required to apply 'online'. **The Application Form other than online mode shall not be accepted. No change will be accepted through offline mode, i.e., through fax/application including e-mail etc.**
- v. **Online Application Form cannot be withdrawn once it is submitted successfully.**
- vi. NTA does not scrutinize the eligibility criteria during the filling up of application Form. In case any candidate is found ineligible the candidature would be cancelled at any later stage wherever found.
- vii. A candidate is allowed to submit only one Application Form. If a candidate submits more than one Application Form, the candidature is likely to be cancelled.
- viii. **Request for change in any particular in the Application Form shall not be entertained after closing of the correction window.**
Note: However, a chance may be given to the candidates to correct/modify/edit some of the particular(s) of the Application Form online only, during the correction period
- ix. The City of Examination Centres where the test shall be conducted are given in the Information Bulletin. The Cities indicated for the examination should be carefully chosen by the candidate, as no change will be allowed once the correction period is over.
- x. Selection of a candidate in the test is provisional, subject to being found otherwise eligible for admission.
- xi. In case a candidate is found providing incorrect information or the identity is proved to be false at any time in the future, the candidate shall face penal action as per the law.
- xii. The Candidates are not required to send/ submit the confirmation page of Online Application Form to the NTA. However, he/she is advised to retain the following documents with them as reference for future correspondence:
 - ❖ **At least four printouts of the Confirmation Page of Online Application Form.**
 - ❖ **Proof of fee paid.**
 - ❖ **Photographs (same as uploaded on the Online Application Form) -6 to 8 passport size photographs need to be kept aside.**
 - ❖ **The name on the photo identification must match with the name as shown on the Admit Card. If the name has been changed due to events such as marriage, candidate must show the relevant document at the time of exam i.e., Marriage Certificate / Divorce / Decree / Legal Name Change Document**

General Instructions:

- i. Candidates must carefully read the Instructions (including how to fill up Application Form online) given in the Information Bulletin available on the NTA Website. Candidates not complying with the Instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- ii. Candidates can apply for **SWAYAM- 2026 (January Semester) through "Online" mode only. The Application Form in any other mode will not be accepted.**
- iii. **Candidates can apply for a maximum of 10 courses as per schedule and shifts available.**
- iv. In case the Confirmation Page is not generated after payment of prescribed Fee, then the candidate should approach the concerned Bank/Payment Gateway integrator (the helpline number and email given in **Annexure-I** of the Information Bulletin), for ensuring the successful payment.
- v. In spite of the above, if successful transaction is not reflected on the Portal, the candidate may contact NTA Helpdesk. If the payment issue is still not resolved, the candidate may pay the fee second time.
- vi. However, any duplicate payment received from the candidate by NTA in the course of said transactions will be refunded through the same payment mode through which the duplicate payment is received, after fee reconciliation by NTA.
- vii. Candidates must ensure that their email address and mobile number to be registered in their online Application Form are their own, as relevant/important information/ communication will be sent by NTA through e-mail on the registered e-mail address and / or through SMS on registered mobile number only. NTA shall not be responsible for any non-communication / miscommunication with a candidate in the email address or mobile number given by him/her other than his/her own.
- viii. Candidates are advised to visit the NTA website and check their e-mails regularly for latest updates.
- ix. Candidates shall appear in the exam at their own cost at the Examination Centre on the Date/ Shift and time indicated on their respective Admit Cards which would be issued by the NTA in due course through its website.
- x. **Usage of Data and Information:** NTA/Government of India can use the data provided by the End Users (test taker in this case) for internal purpose(s) including training, research and development, analysis, and other permissible purpose(s). However, this information is not for use by any third party or private agency for any other use.
- xi. Candidate shall ensure that the information (like, his/her name, mother's name, father's name, gender, date of birth, category, PwD/PwBD status, mobile number, email address, photograph and signature, choice of cities for exam Centre, etc.) provided by them in their online Application Form are correct and of their own. Candidates are advised to exercise utmost care for filling up correct details in the Application Form. Any request for change in particular after the closure of correction period will not be considered by NTA under any circumstances. Corrections sent by the candidate through Post/ Fax/WhatsApp/Email/by Hand will not be entertained by NTA.
- xii. In case it is found at any time in future that the Candidate has used / uploaded the photograph and signature of someone else in his/ her Application Form / Admit Card or he/she has tampered his/her Admit Card / result, these acts of the candidate shall be treated as Unfair Means (UFM) Practices on his/her part and he/she shall be proceeded with the actions as contemplated under the provisions of the Information Bulletin relating to Unfair Means Practices.

Chapter – 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 About National Testing Agency (NTA)

The Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India (GoI) established the National Testing Agency (NTA) as an independent, autonomous, and self-sustained premier testing organization under the Societies Registration Act (1860) for conducting efficient, transparent and international standardized tests in order to assess the competency of candidates for admission to premier higher education institutions with a mission to improve equity and quality in education by developing and administering research-based valid, reliable, efficient, transparent, fair and international level assessments.

1.2 About Study Webs of Active–Learning for Young Aspiring Minds (SWAYAM)

SWAYAM is a programme initiated by Government of India and designed to achieve the three cardinal principles of Education Policy viz., access, equity, and quality. The objective of this effort is to take the best teaching learning resources to all, including the most disadvantaged. SWAYAM seeks to bridge the digital divide for students who have hitherto remained untouched by the digital revolution and have not been able to join the mainstream of the knowledge economy.

1.3 Role of NTA

The Role of NTA is confined to the registration of candidates, issuance of Admit Card, the conduct of the Examination , preparing and declaring results, and hosting Score Card.

The letters/e-mails/grievances/queries/RTI applications/Court cases pertaining to admission related matters/procedures will not be entertained by NTA. The same may be addressed to the concerned Institution/Organization.

Chapter – 2

SWAYAM- 2026 (JANUARY SEMESTER) EXAMINATION SCHEME

2.1. Mode of Exam

SWAYAM will be held for 900 course(s) in Hybrid Mode (Computer-Based Test and Pen & Paper Test). Course(s) wise schedule is at [Annexure-II](#).

2.2. Pattern of Examination

2.3 Subject Details

There are total 900 courses registered in SWAYAM 2026 January semester for which Exam will be conducted by NTA in CBT and Hybrid Mode. Details of courses are available at [\(https://swayam.gov.in/\)](https://swayam.gov.in/)

2.4. Medium of Question Paper

The medium of question paper will be English only, except for the language papers which will be held in the respective language only.

2.5. Marking Scheme:

- There will be no negative marking for any wrong answer in the MCQ sections.
- Un-answered/un-attempted question will be given no mark/marks.
- If a question is found to be incorrect/ambiguous or has multiple correct answers, only those candidates who have attempted the question and chosen one of the correct answers would be given the mark.
- If a question is found to be incorrect and the Question is dropped, then mark/marks will be awarded to only those candidates who have attempted the question. The reason could be due to human error or technical error.

Chapter – 3

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

3.1 Eligibility Criteria for SWAYAM- 2026 (January Semester)

3.1.1 The student/learner who has enrolled in any of the 900 courses in the January 2026 semester is eligible for appearing in the examination of that course. Shift-wise and course-wise examination schedule is given at [Annexure-II](#).

3.1.2 The students, who obtained 40% marks in term end written test conducted by NTA and 40% marks in internal assessment separately, will be eligible for certificate and credit transfer.

3.2 For Students Who Want to Appear in Multiple Exams:

Please note that student would be able to choose only one course in each shift i.e., student can appear for a maximum of Ten papers spread across Ten shifts. **Those students who are doing multiple courses should ensure that the courses that they are choosing for examination are in different shifts. Shift-wise and course-wise examination schedule is given at [Annexure-II](#).**

Chapter - 4

RESERVATIONS

4.1 Reservations

Indian nationals belonging to certain categories (**OBC-NCL, Gen-EWS, SC, ST**) are admitted under the seats reserved for them in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government of India/State Governments.

4.2 Provisions relating to Persons with Disability (PwD)/ Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD):

4.2.1 The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016:

The Gazette of India, Extraordinary Part-II Section 1, Ministry of Law and Justice (Legislative Department) New Delhi dated 28 December 2016 on "The Rights of Persons With Disabilities Act, 2016. The relevant paragraphs of the above Gazette Notification for consideration are as under: -

Chapter -1.

Para 2(r), "persons with benchmark disabilities" means a person with not less than forty percent (40%) of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority.

Para 2 (s) "Persons with Disability (PwD)" means a person with long term physical, mental, intellectual, or sensory impairment which, in interaction with barriers, hinders his full and effective participation in society equally with others.

Para 2 (zc) "specified disability" means the disabilities as specified in the schedule (**Annexure -V**)

4.2.2 Office Memorandum dated 29 August 2018:

Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, Office Memorandum No. F. No. 34-02/2015-DD-III dated 29 August 2018 for conducting written examination for persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of Section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016. The relevant paragraphs of the above Office Memorandum for consideration are as under : -

Para IV. The facility of Scribe/Reader/Lab Assistant should be allowed to any person with benchmark disability as defined under section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016 and has limitation in writing including that of speed if so desired by him/her.

In case of persons with benchmark disabilities in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arm affected-BA) and cerebral palsy, the facility of scribe/reader/lab assistant shall be given, if so desired by the person.

In case of other category of persons with benchmark disabilities, the provision of scribe/reader/lab assistant can be allowed on production of a certificate to the effect that person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government health care institution as per proforma at **Annexure -VI**.

In case the candidate is allowed to bring his own scribe, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking examination. The person opting for own scribe, should submit details of the own scribe as per proforma at [Annexure -VIII](#).

4.2.3 Office Memorandum dated 10 August 2022:

Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, Office Memorandum No F. No. 29-6/2019-DD-III dated 10 August 2022 for conducting written examination for persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of Section 2(s) of the RPwD Act, 2016 but not covered under the definition of Section 2(r) of the said Act, i.e. person having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing. The relevant paragraphs of the above Office Memorandum for consideration are as under: -

Para 3 (b). The facility of scribe and/or compensatory time shall be granted solely to those having difficulty in writing subject to production of a certificate to the effect that person concerned has limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf from the competent medical authority of a Government healthcare institution as per proforma at [Annexure -VII](#).

Para 3 (c). The medical authority for the purpose of certification as mentioned above should be a multi-member authority comprising the following: -

- i. Chief Medical officer/Civil Surgeon /Chief District Medical Officer, Chairperson
- ii. Orthopaedic/PMR specialist
- iii. Neurologist, if available*
- iv. Clinical Psychologist/Rehabilitation Psychologist/ Psychiatrist/Special Educator
Occupational therapist, if available*
- v. Any other expert based on the condition of the candidate as may be nominated by the Chairperson.

The candidate should fill up the details of the **scribe** as per the **undertaking proforma** at [Annexure VIII](#).

(* the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Chief District Medical Officer may make full efforts for inclusion of neurologists, occupational therapist from the nearest District or the Medical College/Institute, if the same is not available in the District)"

4.3 Scribe and Compensatory Time

1. The candidate should have the discretion of opting for his/her own scribe / reader / lab assistant or request the Examination Body for the same. The examining body may also identify the scribe / reader / lab assistant to make panels at the District / Division / State level as per the requirements of the examination.

2. The word "extra time or additional time" that is being currently used should be changed to "**compensatory time**" and the same should not be less than **20 minutes per hour** of examination for persons who are allowed use of scribe / reader / lab assistant. All the candidates with benchmark disabilities who are eligible for availing the facility of scribe in terms of guidelines vide para IV of Para 4.2.2 and Para 3 (b) of para 4.2.3 above may be allowed additional time of minimum of one hour for examination of 3 hours duration whether they use the facility of scribe or not. In case the duration of the examination is less than an hour, then the duration of additional time should be allowed on pro-rata basis. Additional time should not be less than 5 minutes and should be in the multiple of 5".

Note – Both the guidelines i.e. dated 29 August 2018 (for PwBDs) and dated 10 August 2022 (for PwDs) have other important aspects such as allowing use of assistive devices, proper seating arrangement, accessibility of examination centres etc. which will be followed.

The scribe will help the Candidate in reading the questions and / or keying in the answers as per the directions of the Candidate. A scribe will NEITHER explain the questions NOR suggest any solution to the Candidate.

It is to be noted that the Scribe will be provided by the National Testing Agency (NTA), if requested by the Candidate.

If it is found at any stage that a candidate has availed the services of a scribe and/or availed the compensatory time but does not possess the extent of disability that warrants the use of a scribe and/or grant of compensatory time, the candidate will be excluded from the process of evaluation, ranking, counselling and admission. In case such a candidate has already been admitted to any Institution, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled.

Disability certificate/Unique Disability Identification (UDID)) issued by the notified medical authority needs to be uploaded in the Online Application Form of SWAYAM- 2026 January Semester.

Note: The NTA does not guarantee any change in the category or sub-category (PwD/PwBD status) after the submission of the Online Application Form, and in any case, no change will be entertained by NTA after the declaration of NTA Score for SWAYAM- 2026. The category/sub-category (PwD/PwBD status) entered in the SWAYAM- 2026 Database by the candidate will be used as final. Therefore, the candidates are advised to fill in the category/sub-category column very carefully.

Note: The extent of “specified disability” in a person shall be assessed in accordance with the “Guidelines for the purpose of assessing the extent of specified disability in a person included under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

Note: Candidates must note that the benefit of reservation will be given to them subject to verification of documents. If it is discovered at any stage that a candidate has used a false/fake/incorrect document or has furnished false, incorrect or incomplete information, in order to avail the benefit of reservation, then such a candidate shall be excluded from all admission processes. In case such a candidate has already been given admission, the admission shall stand cancelled.

In the case of the Institutes run/aided/recognized by State Governments, the reservation policy of the respective State Governments shall be applicable.

Chapter – 5

CHOICE OF CITIES FOR EXAM CENTRE

The City of Examination Centres where the test shall be conducted are given at *Annexure-III*. **It is mandatory for candidates to select four cities of their choice while filling up Online Application Form of SWAYAM- 2026 (January Semester)**. An effort will be made to allot Centre of Examination to the candidates in order of the City Choice opted by them in their Application Form. However, due to logistics & administrative reasons, a different city of nearby area may be allotted.

The City of Examination, once chosen and allotted, cannot be changed (after the closing of the correction window) and any request in this regard will not be entertained.

Chapter - 6

EXAMINATION SCHEDULE

Please read this Information Bulletin carefully before registering for SWAYAM-2026 (January Semester).

Note: Please ensure that you do not select more than one paper per session.

Exam will be held in two sessions per day, as per following schedule:

Shift- I	9:30 AM to 12:30 PM
Shift -II	3:00 PM to 6:00 PM

The 900 SWAYAM courses for which the exams are going to be held have been divided among Ten shifts.

The shift-wise examination schedule (list of courses) is available in [Annexure II](#).

In case candidate has enrolled for more than one course falling in the same shift, he/she must make a choice carefully as to which course, he/she would like to appear for exam. Please note that the candidate will be able to appear in exam for only one course in one shift. Once you select the course for exam and pay the fees it cannot be changed.

The examination will be held in 209 cities across the country. The State wise list of Exam Cities is available in [Annexure III](#).

Chapter - 7

ADMIT CARD FOR SWAYAM 2026 JANUARY SEMESTER

The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to their satisfying the eligibility conditions.

The candidate must download the Admit Card from the NTA website and appear for the Examination at the given Centre on date, timing and discipline as indicated in their Admit Card.

No candidate will be allowed to appear at the Examination Centre, on date and timing other than that allotted to them in their Admit Card.

In case candidates are unable to download Admit Cards from the website, they may approach the Help Line (011-40759000) between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm or write to NTA at swayam@nta.ac.in

The candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Admit Card carefully and follow them during the conduct of the examination.

In case of any discrepancy in the particulars of the candidate or his/her photograph and signatures shown in the Admit Card and Confirmation Page, the candidate may immediately approach the Help Line (011-40759000) between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm or write to NTA at swayam@nta.ac.in. In such cases, candidates may appear in the Examination with the already downloaded Admit Card. However, NTA will take necessary action to make corrections in the record later.

Note:

- a. Candidate may please note that Admit Cards will not be sent by post.
- b. In no case, the duplicate Admit Card for SWAYAM- 2026 (January Semester) would be issued at the Examination Centres.
- c. Candidate must not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- d. Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Cards in good condition for future reference.
- e. No Admit Card shall be issued to the candidates whose Applications are found to be incomplete for any reasons (including indistinct/ doubtful photographs/unsigned Applications) or who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria for the examination.
- f. Issue of Admit Cards, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of admission process.

Chapter – 8

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

8.1 Procedure for appearing in Computer Based Test (CBT)

The detailed procedure for appearing in a CBT exam is given in *Annexure -X*.

8.2 Important Instructions for Candidates

- a. The candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Admit Card carefully and follow them strictly.
- b. Candidates **MUST** bring the following documents on the day of Examination at the test Centre. Candidates who will not bring these will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
 - i. Print copy of Admit Card downloaded from NTA website
 - ii. One passport size photograph (same as uploaded on the Online Application Form) for pasting on the specific space in the attendance sheet at the Centre during the Examination.
 - iii. Any one of the authorized Govt. photo IDs (original, valid and non-expired), viz. PAN card/ Driving Licence/ Voter ID/ Passport/ Aadhar Card (With photograph)/ Aadhar Enrolment No/ Ration Card
 - iv. PwD/PwBD certificate issued by the Competent Authority, if claiming the relaxation under PwD/PwBD category.
 - v. If the name has been changed due to events such as marriage, candidate must show the relevant document at the time of exam i.e Marriage Certificate/Divorce / Decree / Legal Name Change Document.
- c. The candidates shall report at the Examination Centre **two hours before the commencement of the Examination** to complete the registration formalities well before the time of exam.
- d. The registration desk will close 30 minutes prior to the examination. Candidates shall not be permitted to enter the Examination Centre after that.
- e. Candidates should take their seat immediately after opening of the Examination Hall on their allotted seat. If not, they are likely to miss some of the general instructions to be announced in the Examination Rooms/Halls. The NTA shall not be responsible for any delay.
- f. Any candidate found to have changed room/hall or the seat on his/her own other than allotted would be considered as a case of unfair means and the candidature shall be cancelled and no plea would be accepted.
- g. The candidate must show, on demand, the Admit Card for entry in the Examination room/hall. A candidate who does not possess the valid Admit Card shall not be allowed to enter the Examination Centre.
- h. The candidate should ensure that the question paper available on the computer is as per the opted Subject Code/ Discipline indicated in the Admit Card. In case, the subject of question paper is other than the opted paper, the same may be brought to the notice of the Invigilator concerned.
- i. Candidates are not allowed to carry any baggage inside the Examination Centre. NTA will not be responsible for any belongings stolen or lost at the premises.**
- j. Candidate shall appear at their own cost at the Centre on date and time as indicated in their Admit Card issued by the NTA.
- k. No candidate, without the special permission of the Centre Superintendent or the Invigilator

concerned, will leave his/her seat or Examination Room/Hall until the full duration of the paper is over. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as instructed by the Centre Superintendent/Invigilators.

- l. Candidates should not be in possession of any material listed in the list of prohibited material.
- m. *All calculations/writing work are to be done only in the rough sheet provided at the Centre in the Examination Room/Hall and on completion of the test candidates must hand over the rough sheets to the invigilator on duty in the Room/Hall.*
- n. The candidate must sign and paste the photograph on the Attendance Sheet at the appropriate place.
- o. The candidates are governed by all Rules and Regulations of the NTA regarding their conduct in the Examination Hall. All cases of unfair means will be dealt with as per rules.

Chapter – 9

UNFAIR MEANS PRACTICES AND BREACH OF EXAMINATION RULES

9.1 Definition

Unfair Means practice is an activity that allows a candidate to gain an unfair advantage over other candidates. It includes, but is not limited to:

- a) Being in possession of any item or article which has been prohibited or can be used for unfair practices including any stationery item, communication device, accessories, eatable items, ornaments or any other material or information relevant or not relevant to the examination in the paper concerned;
- b) Using someone to write an examination (impersonation) or preparing material for copying;
- c) Breaching examination rules or any direction issued by NTA in connection with the SWAYAM-2026 (January Semester) Examination from time to time.
- d) Assisting other candidates to engage in malpractices, giving or receiving assistance of any kind directly or indirectly or attempting to do so;
- e) Contacting or communicating or trying to do so with any person, other than the Examination Staff, during the examination time in the Examination Centre;
- f) Threatening any of the officials connected with the conduct of the examination or threatening any of the candidates;
- g) Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the examination;
- h) Manipulation and fabrication of online documents viz. Admit Card, Self- Declaration, score card, certificates issued by any Government authority etc.;
- i) Forceful entry in /exit from Examination Centre/Hall;
- j) Use or attempted use of any electronic device after entering the Examination Centre;
- k) Affixing/uploading of wrong/morphed photographs/signatures on the Application Form/ Admit Card/ Proforma;
- l) Creating obstacles in the smooth and fair conduct of the examination;
- m) Not attempting the question paper for long time intervals;
- n) Fidgeting and looking here and there;
- o) In possession of bits of paper;
- p) Any other malpractices declared as Unfair Means by the NTA;
- q) Any candidate with more than one Application Number (more than one SCORE CARDS) will be treated as UFM, even if found at a later stage, and strict action will be taken against that Candidate.
- r) **An offence punishable under the Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act, 2024.**

9.2 Punishment for using unfair means practices

During the course, before, or after the examination if a candidate indulges in any of the above or similar practices, he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair practices and booked under the UNFAIR MEANS (U.F.M.) case.

9.3 Cancellation of Result

The result of the candidate(s) for SWAYAM (January-2026 Semester), who indulge in Unfair means Practices will be cancelled and will not be declared. Similarly, the result of those candidates who appear from the Centre other than the one allotted to them or allow another candidate/person to write the examination on his behalf will be cancelled. No plea will be entertained in this regard.

Chapter – 10

DECLARATION OF RESULTS

The result will be hosted on <https://www.nta.ac.in//swayam/>. No grievance about Answer Key(s) after Declaration of Result of SWAYAM 2026 (January Semester) will be entertained. The raw (actual) marks obtained by a candidate will be considered further for computation of the Result of SWAYAM 2026 (January Semester). No Score Card will be dispatched to the candidates and the candidates are advised to download their Score Cards from the website: <https://exams.nta.ac.in/swayam/> only.

There is no provision for rechecking/re-evaluation/re-totaling of the result/score and no query in this regard will be entertained.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) is the Examination conducting body and will provide SWAYAM 2026 (January Semester) Scores.

Final scores & certificates will be given by respective National Coordinators.

Chapter - 11

MISCELLANEOUS

11.1 Correspondence With NTA

All the correspondence should preferably be addressed by e-mail. The email query shall be addressed only if it is not anonymous and contains the name, postal address, and contact number of the sender. An email containing vague or general queries and other queries as contained in the Information Bulletin shall not be entertained. Queries shall not be entertained from a person claiming to be representatives, associates, or officiates of the applicant candidate. The following information shall not be revealed by NTA:

- a. Internal documentation/status.
- b. The internal decision-making process of NTA. Any claim/counterclaim thereof.
- c. Dates and venue of internal meetings or name of the staff/officers dealing with it.
- d. Any information which cannot be revealed in the opinion of NTA.

11.2 Weeding Out Rules

The record of the **STUDY WEBS OF ACTIVE-LEARNING FOR YOUNG ASPIRING MINDS (SWAYAM)** January 2026 Semester Exam would be preserved up to 90 days from the date of declaration of result.

11.3 Legal Jurisdiction

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of SWAYAM 2026 (January Semester) Examination including Results shall fall within the **jurisdiction of Delhi/New Delhi** only. Further, any legal question arising out of the Examination shall be entertained only when raised within 30 days from the declaration of result.

The Director (Administration) of the NTA shall be the official by whose designation the NTA may sue or be sued.

11.4 RTI

RTI Information uploaded on the website shall not be provided to the candidate or any other person under R.T.I. Act, 2005. The information uploaded on the website shall remain for a specific period only. Therefore, the candidates are advised to download the uploaded information and keep with them for future. In due course of examination or in midway of process, neither any application under Right to Information Act, 2005 shall be entertained nor will information be provided. Factual information under R.T.I., Act shall be provided only after declaration of final result. Inferential questions or Speculative questions shall not be answered in RTI

THE SCHEDULE

[See clause (zc) of section 2]

SPECIFIED DISABILITY

1. Physical disability.—

A. Locomotor disability (a person's inability to execute distinctive activities associated with movement of self and objects resulting from affliction of musculoskeletal or nervous system or both), including—

(a) "leprosy cured person" means a person who has been cured of leprosy but is suffering from—

(i) loss of sensation in hands or feet as well as loss of sensation and paresis in the eye and eye-lid but with no manifest deformity;

(ii) manifest deformity and paresis but having sufficient mobility in their hands and feet to enable them to engage in normal economic activity;

(iii) extreme physical deformity as well as advanced age which prevents him/her from undertaking any gainful occupation, and the expression "leprosy cured" shall construed accordingly;

(b) "cerebral palsy" means a Group of non-progressive neurological condition affecting body movements and muscle coordination, caused by damage to one or more specific areas of the brain, usually occurring before, during or shortly after birth;

(c) "dwarfism" means a medical or genetic condition resulting in an adult height of 4 feet 10 inches (147 centimeters) or less;

(d) "muscular dystrophy" means a group of hereditary genetic muscle disease that weakens the muscles that move the human body and persons with multiple dystrophy have incorrect and missing information in their genes, which prevents them from making the proteins they need for healthy muscles. It is characterised by progressive skeletal muscle weakness, defects in muscle proteins, and the death of muscle cells and tissue;

(e) "acid attack victims" means a person disfigured due to violent assaults by throwing of acid or similar corrosive substance.

B. Visual impairment—

(a) "blindness" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, after best correction—

(i) total absence of sight; or

(ii) visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible correction; or

(iii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degree.

(b) "low-vision" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, namely:—

(i) visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 or less than 20/60 upto 3/60 or upto 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible corrections; or

(ii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 40 degree up to 10 degree.

C. Hearing impairment—

(a) "deaf" means persons having 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;

(b) "hard of hearing" means person having 60 DB to 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;

D. "speech and language disability" means a permanent disability arising out of conditions such as laryngectomy or aphasia affecting one or more components of speech and language due to organic or neurological causes.

2. Intellectual disability, a condition characterised by significant limitation both in intellectual functioning (reasoning, learning, problem solving) and in adaptive behaviour which covers a range of every day, social and practical skills, including—

(a) "specific learning disabilities" means a heterogeneous group of conditions wherein there is a deficit in processing language, spoken or written, that may manifest itself as a difficulty to comprehend, speak, read, write, spell, or to do mathematical calculations and includes such conditions as perceptual disabilities, dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, dyspraxia and developmental aphasia;

(b) "autism spectrum disorder" means a neuro-developmental condition typically appearing in the first three years of life that significantly affects a person's ability to communicate, understand relationships and relate to others, and is frequently associated with unusual or stereotypical rituals or behaviours.

3. Mental behaviour,—

"mental illness" means a substantial disorder of thinking, mood, perception, orientation or memory that grossly impairs judgment, behaviour, capacity to recognise reality or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life, but does not include retardation which is a condition of arrested or incomplete development of mind of a person, specially characterised by subnormality of intelligence.

4. Disability caused due to—

(a) chronic neurological conditions, such as—

(i) "multiple sclerosis" means an inflammatory, nervous system disease in which the myelin sheaths around the axons of nerve cells of the brain and spinal cord are damaged, leading to demyelination and affecting the ability of nerve cells in the brain and spinal cord to communicate with each other;

(ii) "parkinson's disease" means a progressive disease of the nervous system marked by tremor, muscular rigidity, and slow, imprecise movement, chiefly affecting middle-aged and elderly people associated with degeneration of the basal ganglia of the brain and a deficiency of the neurotransmitter dopamine.

(b) Blood disorder—

(i) "haemophilia" means an inheritable disease, usually affecting only male but transmitted by women to their male children, characterised by loss or impairment of the normal clotting ability of blood so that a minor would may result in fatal bleeding;

(ii) "thalassemia" means a group of inherited disorders characterised by reduced or absent amounts of haemoglobin.

(iii) "sickle cell disease" means a hemolytic disorder characterised by chronic anemia, painful events, and various complications due to associated

tissue and organ damage; "hemolytic" refers to the destruction of the cell membrane of red blood cells resulting in the release of hemoglobin.

5. Multiple Disabilities (more than one of the above specified disabilities) including deaf blindness which means a condition in which a person may have combination of hearing and visual impairments causing severe communication, developmental, and educational problems.

6. Any other category as may be notified by the Central Government.







3. The Question Palette displayed on the left side of the screen will show the status of each question using one of the following symbols:
4. The Marked for Review status for a question simply indicates that you would like to look at that question again. Questions that are answered and “Marked for Review” will be automatically saved and evaluated even if the flag is not removed.
5. The questions and answer options will be displayed in **English and the chosen language**. For any doubt or clarification, you are requested to refer to the English version as the final.

Navigating to a Question:

6. **To navigate between questions within a Paper, the candidate needs to do the following:**
 - Click on the question number in the Question Palette at the left of your screen to go to that question directly in the corresponding section. Note that using this option does NOT save your answer to the current question.

7. Procedure for answering a Multiple-Choice Type question:

- To select your answer, click on the  button of one of the options.
 - To de-select your chosen answer,  click on the button of the chosen option again.
 - To change your chosen  answer, click on the button of another option.
 - You  can click on the top left-hand side of the question window when you want to come back to that question later on, whether you have answered it or not, and proceed to other questions.
 - When you answer any question "Marked for review", the status of the question changes automatically to "Answered".
 - You can click on  when you want to change the status and freeze the answer already given or answer the question.
8. To change your answer to a question that has already been answered, first select that question for answering and then follow the procedure for answering that type of question.

Navigating through sections:

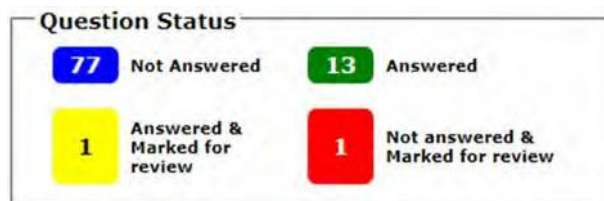
Instruction for Question:

- The keyboard attached to the computer, if any, will be disabled during the entire duration of the examination. Candidates will have the option to change/modify answers already entered anytime during the entire duration of the examination.

In case the computer/mouse allotted to any candidate malfunctions anytime during the test, he/she will be immediately allotted another computer system and the time lost due to this will be adjusted in the server so as to give the candidate the full allotted time.

The on-screen computer clock counter of every candidate will be set at the server. The countdown timer on the top right side of the computer screen will display the time remaining (in minutes) available for the candidate to complete the examination. 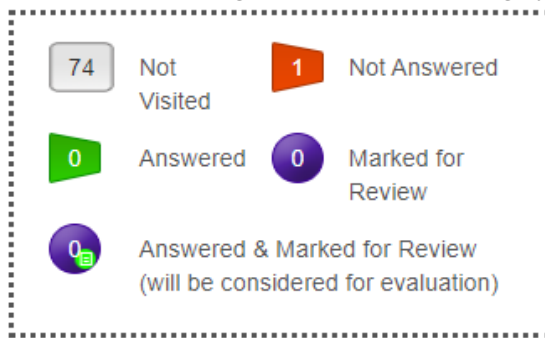

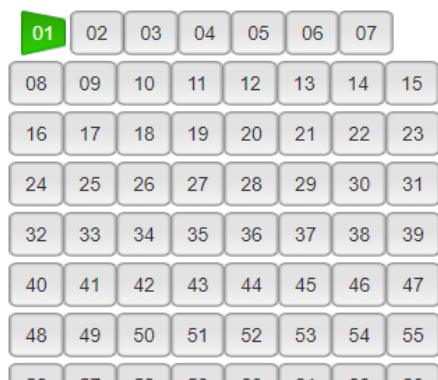
- (b) Candidate can click on the “>” arrow which appears to the left of question palette to collapse the question palette thereby maximizing the question viewing window. To view the question palette again, candidate can click on “<” which appears on the right side of question window.

- (ii) After clicking the “Save & Next” button on the last question for a section, candidate will automatically be taken to the first question of the next section.
- (iii) Candidate can shuffle between sections and questions within sections anytime during the Examination as per the convenience only during the time stipulated.
- (iv) Candidate can view the corresponding section summary as part of the legend that appears in every section above the question palette.
