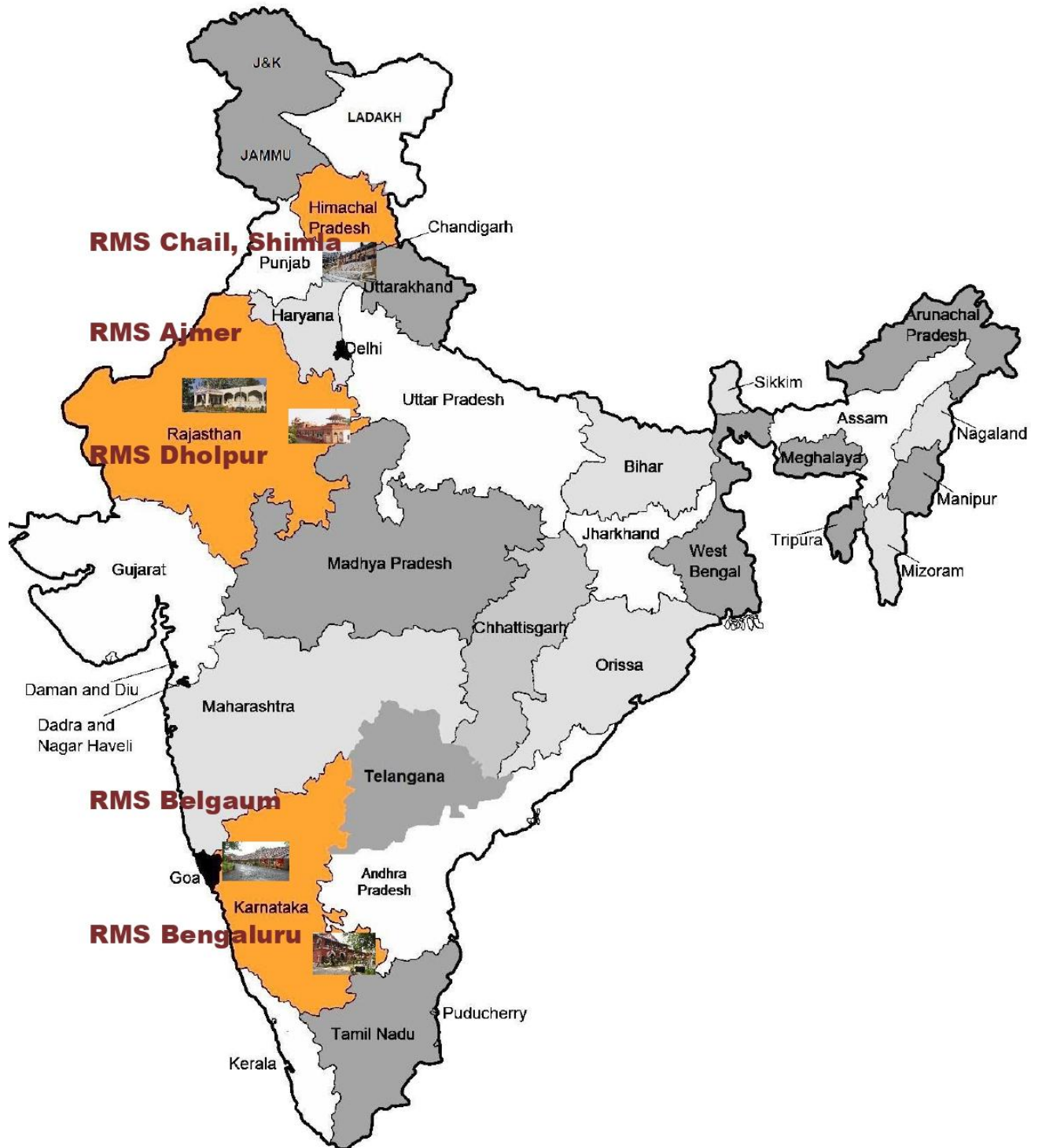

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CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

ABOUT NATIONAL TESTING AGENCY (NTA).

The Ministry of Education (MOE), Government of India (GOI) has established National Testing Agency (NTA) as an independent autonomous and self-sustained premier examining organization under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 for conducting efficient, transparent and international standards exams in order to assess the competency of candidates for admissions to premier higher educational institutions.

The objectives of NTA, inter-alia, include: -

- (a) To conduct efficient, transparent and international standard exams in order to assess the competency of candidates for admission.
- (b) To undertake research on educational, professional and examining system to identify gaps in the knowledge systems and take steps for bridging them.
- (c) To produce and disseminate information and research on education and professional development standards.

ABOUT RASHTRIYA MILITARY SCHOOL (RMS).

Rashtriya Military School are English medium residential Public Schools run by the Ministry of Defence to impart quality education to the wards of defence personnel and civilians from classes VI to XII. These schools are the founding members of the Indian Public Schools' Conference (IPSC). Established in the year 1925, these schools are among the oldest Public Schools in India. There are five Rashtriya Military Schools (RMS) located at Chail in the Shimla Hills of Himachal Pradesh, Ajmer and Dholpur in Rajasthan, Belgaum and Bengaluru in Karnataka. Cadets are admitted in to class VI & IX through a Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted under the aegis of the Integrated Headquarters, Ministry of Defence (Army).

1. **RMS CET-2026** will be conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA).
2. The responsibility of NTA is limited to inviting online applications, operating the online application portal, conducting Stage-I (Written Examination), initial scrutiny of applications for issuance of Admit Cards, processing/evaluation and declaration of the Stage-I result, and providing the processed merit data to RMS. RMS remains responsible for framing and administering eligibility, vacancy, reservation/merit and admission criteria; Stage-II Medical Examination, Stage-III Interview, Stage-IV final merit/selection and admission; and final verification of original documents and eligibility at subsequent stages.

AIM

2. The aim of Rashtriya Military Schools is “to impart quality education and prepare the cadets to join the Defence Service”.

ACADEMICS

3. Rashtriya Military Schools are affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). The medium of instruction in the schools is English and academic year is from April to March. All schools offer science stream only after 10th class. Rashtriya Military Schools prepare cadets for the following examinations: -

3.1. Central Board of Secondary Education:-

3.1.1. All India Secondary School Examination (Class X).

3.1.2. All India Senior School Certificate Examination (Class XII).

3.2. Union Public Service Commission Examination for admission to National Defence Academy.

CHAPTER 3**ADMISSION GUIDELINES****ADMISSION**

1. The Common Entrance Test for admission to Classes VI and IX will be conducted in December. The examination will be OMR-based and will cover the subjects specified under the heading “**ADMISSION TEST.**” For admission to Class VI, candidates should not be less than 10 years and more than 13 years of age as on 31st March of the year of admission. For admission to Class IX, candidates should not be less than 13 years and more than 16 years of age as on 31st March of the year of admission. Admission in Classes VI and IX is on the basis of availability of vacancies. Parents/students should also note that all admissions are into the category of Boarders only. No day scholars are allowed. Important Dates for admission in Rashtriya Military Schools are as under: -

RESERVATION

2. Following reservation will be applicable:

2.1. Category wise Reservation

• Entitled Category	JCOs/OR (Serving & Retired of Army, Air Force & Navy only)	70%
• Non-Entitled Category	Officers # (Serving & Retired of Army, Air Force & Navy only)	20%
	Civilians	10%

In case seats are vacant, the same can be offered to civilian category in the same academic year.

2.2. Reservation as per Govt of India reservation policy. The following reservation will be applicable in all categories mentioned at para 2.1 above. Unfilled vacancies will be transferred to Unreserved Category.

2.2.1. OBC NCL - 27%.

2.2.2. SC - 15%.

2.2.3. ST - 7.5%.

2.3. Reservation in Killed in Action (KIA) candidates. A total of 50 seats (Not more than 15 in either of the school) are earmarked for wards of personal killed in action (KIA) (Applicable for wards of Army, Air Force & Navy only).

2.4. Reservation for Girls

2.4.1 Class VI. 10% seats or max 30 seats whichever is less (put together in all 05 RMSs) of total seats declared for current CET.

2.4.2. Class IX. 10% seats (put together in all 05 RMSs) of total seats declared for current CET.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

3. **Educational Qualification.** For admission to Class VI, the candidates must have passed Class V or be studying in Class V and pass it before that date of admission to Rashtriya Military School. For admission in Class IX, the candidate must have passed Class VIII from a government/recognized school before the date of admission to Rashtriya Military School. Candidates should also preferably have knowledge of English which is the medium of instruction in Rashtriya Military Schools.

4. **Age. Boys & Girls aged between 10-13 years as on 31st March 2027 (born between 1st April 2014 to 31st March 2017, both days inclusive) for admission in Class VI and aged between 13-16 years as on 31st March 2027 (born between 1st April 2011 to 31st March 2014, both days inclusive) for admission in Class IX. Six months relaxation in upper age limit is permissible for wards of personnel Killed in Action. The authority for date of birth will be Date of Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporations/authorized local Govt bodies only. Certificates issued by Gram Panchayat or any other local body will not be acceptable. Any variation in the Date of Birth or any other particulars in the sheet role and the School Leaving Certificate will render the candidature of the candidate null and void.**

5. **Important Instructions.**

5.1. Parents/candidates should exercise due care while filling up the online application form. **If on verification or otherwise at any stage of selection, incorrect information or some variation found, the candidature is liable to be cancelled automatically. No request for change in category, Date of Birth or medical examination centres will be entertained.**

5.2. **Verification of eligibility conditions with reference to original documents will be done during admission process.**

6. **Admission Test.** The CET written examination for Class VI & Class IX will be through Optical Mark Reader (**OMR**) based examination and scheme of marking for these papers will be as given below: -

7. **Syllabus.** Written test will generally be of Class V standard for Class VI and Class VIII standard for Class IX admission. Question Paper in Entrance exam will be bilingual (English and Hindi) for Class VI and only in English for Class IX.

9. **Result for Written Part.** Result will be hosted on NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RMSCET/> with category wise cut off marks. All registered candidates can login to their accounts on NTA website to check their individual marks.

10. **Medical Fitness.** All qualified and shortlisted candidates will undergo medical examination before interviews and final selection as per norms/ criteria specified in AFMSF-2 and only in the hospitals given at **Appendix A**. Candidate found medically unfit by the board of officers at listed hospitals will not be admitted. The candidates will also be required to remain medically fit during the course of their stay at Rashtriya Military School. The admission of the candidate will be provisional till Fitness Certificate is received from the Hospital. **NO REQUEST FOR CHANGE OF MEDICAL EXAM CENTER WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

11. **Interview.** Those candidates who qualify in the written exam will be called for medical and interview. Medicals will be conducted at nominated Military Hospitals (MHs)/ Command Hospitals (CHs) (to be selected by candidate) and interviews will be conducted at any one of the RMS. Marks of interview will be added to the score of the written exam before deciding final merit list. No travelling or any other allowances will be admissible in connection with the journeys under taken for the CET interview.

12. **Final Result.** Based upon the cumulative marks in written exam and interview, category wise final merit list will be prepared and hosted on NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RMSCET/>. Candidates can use their login credentials to check their marks. No separate intimation will be sent to unsuccessful candidates.

13. **Final Selection.** Candidates selected in order of merit on the basis of total marks scored by them in the admission test and the interview will be admitted to different Rashtriya Military School based on availability of vacancies, medical fitness and as per the reservation's norms laid down for various categories by Government of India. Qualified candidates will be allotted school purely on the basis of Merit and vacancy available in school.

CHAPTER 4

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.

1. **RMS CET-2026** will be conducted as per the guidelines of the Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army).
2. Merely appearing and passing in **RMS-2026** does not confer any right to the candidate for admission to the Rashtriya Military School.
3. The selection and admission to Rashtriya Military School (RMS) is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, rank in merit list, medical fitness, verification of original documents and such other criteria as may be prescribed by the Rashtriya Military Schools (RMSs)/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army).
4. Applications of candidates submitting false and fabricated information will be rejected and such candidates will be further debarred from appearing in future examinations.
5. Incomplete application and applications not in accordance with instructions are liable to be rejected without any further intimation.
6. The examination fee once deposited will not be refunded. Fee will neither be carried forward to a future examination nor refunded.
7. Applications once submitted cannot be withdrawn. It must be noted that mere deduction of fee from the bank account is not a proof of fee payment. The payment should be supported by fee payment and generation of Confirmation Page.
8. Instructions in the Information Bulletin may change /be updated based on decisions taken by the NTA / Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) and other authorities from time to time. Therefore, it is advised to regularly check the website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RMSCET/> for any further updates or information.
9. NTA/RMS retain the statutory authority to amend vacancy numbers, alter the examination structure, and establish minimum qualifying cut-off marks, subject to administrative approvals. All declared vacancies remain provisional and contingent upon institutional requirements. Candidates are legally bound to comply strictly with all issued directives and guidelines throughout the Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army).
10. NTA / Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) reserves the right to withdraw permission, granted inadvertently, if any, to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the **RMS CET-2026**, even though the Admit Card had been issued by the NTA.
11. Candidates are required to keep with them at least one identity proof along with the admit card issued to the candidate and shall produce the same on demand at the time of examination at the center.
12. Candidate's admission to **RMS-2026** is purely provisional and is subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria prescribed by the Rashtriya Military School as applicable.
13. Application Form of candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria shall be rejected.
14. Selection of a candidate in the Examination is provisional, subject to being found otherwise eligible for selection.

15. The decision of Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) shall be final in all matters relating to Eligibility, Acceptance or Rejection of the applications/ candidature of any Candidate, Penalty for false information, Selection & Admission in RMS etc.
16. In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions/terms/rules/criteria regarding determination of eligibility/conduct of examination/registration of candidates/information contained therein, the interpretation of the Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) shall be final and binding in accordance with the applicable rules.
17. Candidates are advised to keep visiting the NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RMSCET/> and RMS website www.rashtriyamilitaryschools.edu.in regularly for all examination related updates and to check their emails.
18. Candidates are NOT allowed to carry Hand bag, Purse, cap, goggles, jackets, any kind of Paper/ Stationery/ Textual material (printed or written material), Eatables (loose or packed), Mobile Phone/ Ear Phone/ Microphone/Pager, Calculator, Docu-Pen, Slide Ruler, Formulae, Log Tables, whitener, Camera, Tape Recorder, Electronic Watches with facilities of calculator, any metallic item or electronic gadgets/devices, pointed instruments etc. in the Examination Hall/ Room.
19. A candidate needs to give her/his preferences for examination Centre cities during submission of online application form. However, centres shall be allocated taking into account logistical considerations. While filling up the Online Application Form, candidates can select maximum four Convenient Cities from **Chapter 8** as their Choice of Cities for the exam Centre in order of their priority. Choice of Centre Cities will be limited to the State of Permanent Address or State of Present Address only.
20. The information about the examination centres will be given in the respective admit cards.
21. No request for change of centre/venue/date/session for Examination shall be entertained.
22. NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army), however, reserves the right to cancel any of the Examination Centres and/ or add some other Centres, with approval of competent authority, depending upon the response, administrative feasibility, etc.
23. NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) also reserves the right to allot the candidate to any city even other than the preferences given by her/him.
24. Candidate will appear for the examination at an Examination Centre at her / his own risks and expenses and NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) will not be responsible for any injury or losses etc. of any nature.
25. No TA/DA will be paid to any candidate for appearing in the examinations.

26. In case it is found at any time in future that the candidate has used / uploaded the photograph and signature of someone else in her/his Application Form / Admit Card or she/he has tampered her/his Admit Card /result, these acts of the candidate shall be treated as Unfair Means (UFM).
27. In case, it is detected at any stage of examination that a candidate does not fulfill the eligibility norms and/or that she/he has suppressed/twisted or truncated any material acts or any other grounds which the NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) consider to be sufficient clause, her/his candidature shall stand cancelled without giving any reasons and notice to the candidate concerned. If any of these shortcomings is detected even after selection/admission, their admission may be liable to be terminated.
28. No recommendation for selection either written or oral, other than those for whom required as per Rules applicable will be taken into consideration. Any attempt on the part of a candidate to enlist support directly or indirectly for his candidature by other means shall disqualify him/ her for selection/admission.
29. The candidates are required to fill in the Online Application Form with correct and complete information carefully. If any incomplete or false information is given, then the candidate will be solely responsible for the same and on the basis of false and incomplete information, the Application Form shall be rejected at any stage of the selection without giving any reasons/notice. On furnishing any false information, particulars, certificates or indicating wrong category/sub-category etc.in the application form or in case of any other default, NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) may reject the candidature at any stage of the selection/admission.
30. Requests for information under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act 2005) shall be dealt with by the designated competent authority in accordance with the provisions of the Act and applicable rules. Information may be withheld only to the extent permitted under the applicable statutory exemptions. The information uploaded on the website shall remain for a specific period only. Therefore, the candidates are advised to download the uploaded information and keep up with them for future.
31. It is to be noted that if a candidate has been allowed to appear in the examination, it does not imply that the candidate's eligibility has been verified. It does not vest any right with a candidate for selection/admission. The eligibility is subject to final verification by the Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) at subsequent stages. The candidate shall satisfy her/his eligibility before applying and shall be personally responsible in case she/he is not eligible to apply as per the given eligibility criteria on the last date for submission of Application Form.
32. Furnishing of false, wrong or inaccurate information may lead to cancellation of the candidature of the Applicant and/or her/his Result. Canvassing in any form and use of Unfair Means (UFM) during the examinations shall disqualify the candidature of the applicant.

33. The Result of the Candidates who indulge in Unfair Means (UFM) practices shall not be declared (and may be cancelled).
34. Mobile Phones, Pagers, Bluetooth devices or any other communication device is not allowed inside the premises where the examination is being conducted. Any infringement of these instructions may entail suitable actions/restrictions as NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) may deem fit and proper, including ban from future examinations.
35. The NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) will not be responsible for any inadvertent error and reserves the right to correct such errors that might have inadvertently crept in. However, it does not owe any responsibility for error committed by the candidate.
36. NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) reserves the right to conduct additional examination (as applicable) at any stage in accordance with the applicable rules and with approval of competent authority. Furthermore, Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) also reserves the right to cancel modify, or suspend any part or the entirety of the selection and admission process across all notified stages, in this Information Bulletin at its discretion and without liability.
37. NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) reserves the right to incorporate any subsequent changes/modifications/additions in the terms & conditions of selection/ admission under the notice as necessitated and applicable by issuing necessary addendum/corrigendum to their Notification.
38. Candidates should not consider themselves selected until Joining Instruction to this effect is issued and Call Up Notices are sent to them by the competent authorities.
39. Under no circumstances, any candidate or parents/guardians/relatives or friends are permitted to approach any officer in the Service Headquarters or any other person concerned with the selection of the candidates with the intent of canvassing or any form of preferential treatment. Any attempt to do so is liable to result in rejection of the candidate.
40. Any matter not specifically covered in this Information Bulletin or elsewhere shall be decided by the NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army), whose decision in this regard shall be final, binding and subject to applicable law.

Caution: Selection of the candidates shall be purely on the merit basis in a transparent way. Hence, the candidate has to be careful of touts and selection racketeers, who promise to get them selected unlawfully on illegal considerations/means. Candidates/ Parents/ Guardians are cautioned not to fall prey to unscrupulous touts, crooks and fraudsters who may make false, bogus and misleading assurances/ claims while approaching them (using spoofed emails, SMS, fake telephone calls or forged documents or personally in the name of NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) for assistance with admission in exchange of monetary considerations. They are also likely to collect personal data of the aspiring candidates which may be misused by them in future. Neither NTA nor Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) has authorised any person or agency to offer help for online registration and support for RMS CET-2026 on their website or to use the name, logo and their website contents. It is hereby made clear that NTA or Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) do not have any agents or touts, liaison, admission offices, representatives or any other office/ school than those mentioned on the official website. In case candidates are approached by any such agent promising undue favours, they should not respond to such offers and should immediately approach the police Authorities if the situation so warrants. Candidates could get their grievances addressed and ascertain the status of their candidature from the public grievances and nodal officers at NTA/Helpdesk.

Further, the NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) has not appointed any agent(s) or coaching advertisement for action on its behalf. Candidates are warned against any such claims being made by persons/agencies. Candidates are selected purely as per merit. Beware of unscrupulous elements and do not fall in their trap. Candidates attempting to influence NTA/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) directly or indirectly shall be disqualified and legal action can be initiated against them. Candidates are advised to visit only the official website of NTA and/or Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) and beware of FAKE websites put up by unscrupulous elements/touts.

LEGAL JURISDICTION:

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of RMS CET-2026 including results of Stage-1 shall fall within the jurisdiction of NTA. Further, any legal question arising out of the Stage-1 of Examination shall be entertained only when raised within 30 days from the declaration of result.

RETENTION POLICY:

The record of RMS CET-2026 would be preserved up to maximum period of ninety (90) days after declaration of result of each Stage and thereafter will be weeded out as per standard operating procedures.

CHAPTER 5

PROCEDURE FOR FILLING THE ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

Important Points.

1. It is advised to go through the website of RMSs www.rashtriyamilitaryschools.edu.in the and understand their Admission Policy/Procedure clearly.
2. The Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army) reserves the right regarding number of vacancies/seats for admission in RMSs. 3. Admission of boys/girls in the RMSs is as per the admission policy of the Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army).
4. Medium of education, residential facilities, Education Board, fee structure, etc. is the prerogative of the RMSs/ Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD(Army).
5. **It is strongly advised to read the Information Bulletin carefully and check and ensure your eligibility before for the examination and admission. Neither NTA nor RMS will be responsible for any error committed by the candidates in selection of state/domicile/filling of incorrect particulars etc. and possible loss of opportunity to join the RMSs, on this account.**
6. Wrong information/ data during registration will lead to cancellation of candidature automatically.
7. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Information Bulletin and on NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RMSCET/>. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.

9. Scanned clear signature in JPG/JPEG format clearly legible (size between 10kb to 50kb).
10. Service certificate (for wards of defence personnel/ govt/ transferrable job applying for Centre other than domicile) in pdf format (size between 50kb to 300kb).
11. A valid e-mail ID as important communications will be made in this e-mail ID.
12. A valid mobile number as important information via SMS will be sent to this number.
13. **Mobile Number and e-mail Address:** Candidates must provide Mobile Number and email address (their own or that of their parents). The Mobile Number and email will be verified through One Time Password (OTP) prior to creation of online credential.
14. Information Bulletin may be downloaded and read carefully by the candidate that to be sure about his/her eligibility and to acquaint with requirements for submission of Online Application Form.

- (b) The photographs must be taken on or after 1st July 2026 preferably indicating clearly the name of candidate along with the date of taking the photograph. Photograph should not be with cap or goggles. The focus needs to be on face (80% face coverage, ears clearly visible, on white background).
- (c) Spectacles are allowed only if being used regularly.
- (d) Polaroid and Computer-generated photos are not acceptable.
- (e) Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected.
- (f) Application without photographs shall be rejected.
- (g) The photographs need not be attested. Candidates are advised to keep 6 to 8 passport size and colour photographs with white background.

Candidate found medically unfit by the board of officers at listed hospitals will not be admitted. The candidates will also be required to remain medically fit during the course of their stay at Rashtriya Military School. The admission of the candidate will be provisional till Fitness Certificate is received from the Hospital. **NO REQUEST FOR CHANGE OF MEDICAL EXAM CENTER WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

- (a) **Interview.** Those candidates who qualify in the written exam and medical will be called for interview. Medicals will be conducted at nominated Military Hospitals (MHs)/ Command Hospitals (CHs) (to be selected by candidate) and interviews will be conducted at any one of the RMS. Marks of interview will be added to the score of the written exam before deciding final merit list. No travelling or any other allowances will be admissible in connection with the journeys under taken for the CET interview. **The intelligence and personality of the candidate will be tested in the Interview. It is mandatory to pass the Interview as well. 50% Marks must be obtained.**

Stage-IV : Result

Final Result. Based upon the cumulative marks in written exam and interview, category wise final merit list will be prepared and hosted on NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RMSCET/>. Candidates can use their login credentials to check their marks. No separate intimation will be sent to unsuccessful candidates.

Final Selection. Candidates selected in order of merit on the basis of total marks scored by them in the admission test and the interview will be admitted to different Rashtriya Military School based on availability of vacancies, medical fitness and as per the reservation's norms laid down for various categories by Government of India. Qualified candidates will be allotted school purely on the basis of Merit and vacancy available in school.

1. While filling up Online Application Form, candidates should opt for Convenient City from the above list as their choice of examination cities in order of their priority (if applicable).
2. NTA will not be responsible for any inconvenience due to incorrect selection of city codes by the candidates.
3. In case, the number of candidates opting for a city is less than a certain minimum, NTA reserves its right not to allot any centre in that City.
4. In case, the number of candidates opting for a city as centre is less than certain minimum, candidates may be allotted Centre in another city irrespective of the city opted by the candidates for appearing in the examination.
5. Though, every effort will be made to allot a centre in one of the cities selected by the candidate, the NTA reserves its right to allot a centre in a city other than the candidate's choice. Allotment of centre's will be done by the computer and there will be no human intervention.
6. All efforts will be made by NTA to consider the comfort and convenience of candidates while allotting centres. However, Center/City allocation will depend upon technical and logistical feasibility. Candidates may have to travel to other Cities/States.

CHAPTER 9

BARRED ITEMS

1. Candidates are not allowed to carry the following items inside the examination centre under any circumstances. Candidates will be subjected to extensive and compulsory frisking before entering the exam centre with the help of hand-held metal detectors.
 - (a) Any stationery item like textual material (printed or written) bits of papers, Plastic Pouch, calculator, scale, writing pad, pen drives, eraser, electronic pen or scanner etc.
 - (b) Any communication device like mobile phone, blue tooth, earphones, micro phone, pager, health band etc.
 - (c) Other items like wallet, goggles, handbags, belt, cap etc.
 - (d) Any watch or wristwatch, bracelet, camera etc.
 - (e) Any ornaments/metallic item.
 - (f) Any food item opened or packed.
 - (g) Any other item which could be used for unfair means, by hiding communication device like microchip, camera, Bluetooth device etc.
2. No arrangement will be made at the centres for keeping any articles, /items belonging to the candidates.
3. In case any candidate is found in possession of any of the barred items inside the centre it will be considered as use of Unfair Means and action will be taken against the candidate in accordance with the relevant provisions.

CHAPTER 10

INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES/PARENTS/GUARDIANS

1. It is expected that parents/guardians will guide their wards appropriately on the following issues before leaving home for appearing in **RMS CET**.
2. Candidates should avoid coming with more than one escort (parent/ guardian). Escorts shall remain outside the gate during the conduct of the examination.
3. Candidate will not be allowed to enter the exam centre after the gate closing time. Therefore, the candidate shall leave home well in advance, taking into consideration various factors such as traffic, location of the centre and weather conditions etc. It would be appropriate to visit the centre a day before the examination to confirm the location, distance etc. to avoid any problem of reaching late at the centre and then not being allowed to appear in the examination.
4. Candidate shall follow all the instructions and maintain discipline in the examination hall.
5. Candidate shall not breach any examination rule.
6. Candidate shall not use or promote any unfair means activity during the examination.
7. Candidate will not be allowed to leave the exam hall till the conclusion of the exam. Candidate is advised not to attend examination on an empty stomach.
8. In case the candidate finds another candidate using unfair means in the examination, the same shall be immediately informed to the invigilators on duty.
9. Candidate are permitted to bring only the following items, to the examination centre:
 - (a) Admit card (with Self Declaration on it downloaded from NTA website) with passport size photograph and thumb impression affixed on it.
 - (b) Valid and original Photo ID proof.
 - (c) Drinking water in a personal transparent water bottle.
 - (d) A simple transparent black/blue ball point pen only.
 - (e) Passport size photograph for affixing on the attendance sheet.
 - (f) A candidate shall not bring any barred items to the centre.

- 10 Candidate shall co-operate in frisking with the staff at Examination Centre.
- 11 Candidate will report at the centre at the time indicated on his/her admit card to make themselves available for compulsory frisking and completing other registration procedures.
- 12 Candidates are advised to regularly visit website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RMSCET/> also check registered email /SMS for any update regarding examination.
- 13 In case your ward is found breaching any of the above-mentioned rules, your ward will not be permitted to enter the examination centre and will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- 14 If your ward indulges in any unwanted activities, he/ she shall be debarred from taking this examination as per rules and shall also be liable for criminal action and or any action as may be deemed fit by NTA.

CHAPTER 11

ADMIT CARD AND CITY INTIMATION

1. The Admit Card is issued provisionally to all the candidates, subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility conditions.
2. Admit Card will be hosted on the NTA website approximately 05-07 days before the date of the examination. A city intimation slip will be available to the candidate 12-15 days before date of examination. Any change in this schedule will be notified on the official NTA website.
3. The candidate has to download the Admit Card from the NTA website using their login credentials and appear for the Examination at the allotted Centre, date and time as indicated in his/her Admit Card.
4. Admit card is not transferable to any other person. Impersonation is a legally punishable offence.
5. No candidate will be allowed to appear at the examination centre, on Date and Timing other than that allotted to him/her in his/her Admit card.
6. In case candidate is unable to download Admit Card from the website, the candidate should approach the **NTA Help Line between 10:00 am and 05:00 pm**.
7. The candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Information Bulletin as well as on the Admit Card carefully and follow them during the conduct of the examination.

Note:

- (a) Candidate must be in possession of the Admit Card to appear in the examination.
- (b) Candidate may please note that Admit Card will not be sent by post.
- (c) In no case, the duplicate Admit Card for RMS CET would be issued at the Examination Centres.
- (d) Candidate must not mutilate/disfigure the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- (e) The validity of the Admit Card is only up to the day of Examination. Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
- (f) No Admit Card shall be issued to the candidates whose Applications are found to be incomplete for any reason (including indistinct/ doubtful photographs/without uploaded signatures) or who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria for the examination.
- (g) Issue of Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of admission process.

CHAPTER 12**USE OF UNFAIR MEANS/ MALPRACTICE****1. DEFINITION**

1.1 Use of unfair means or malpractice allows a candidate to gain an undue advantage over other candidates. It includes, but is not limited to:

- (a) Being in possession of any item or article which has been prohibited or can be used unfairly, including any stationery item, communication device, accessories, eatable items, ornaments or any other material or information relevant or not relevant to the examination in the paper concerned;
- (b) Using someone to write examination (impersonation) or preparing material for copying;
- (c) Breaching examination rules or any direction issued by NTA from time to time in connection with the conduct of **RMS CET** examination.
- (d) Assisting other candidates to engage in malpractices, giving or receiving assistance of any kind, directly or indirectly or attempting to do so;
- (e) Writing questions or answers on any material other than on the answer sheet given by the Centre Superintendent for writing answers;
- (f) Tearing of answer sheet, any page of the exam booklet etc.;
- (g) Contacting or communicating or trying to do so with any person, other than the Examination Staff, during the examination time in the Examination Centre;
- (h) Taking away the answer sheet out of the examination hall/room;
- (i) Smuggling out answer sheet or part thereof;
- (j) Threatening any of the officials connected with the conduct of the examination or threatening any of the candidates or using violence against anyone;
- (k) Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the examination;
- (l) Manipulation and fabrication of online documents viz. admit card and any other documents;
- (m) Forceful entry/exit in/from Examination Centre/Hall;
- (n) Use or attempted use of any electronic device after entering the Examination Centre;

- (o) Affixing/uploading of wrong/morphed photographs on the application form/admit card/proforma;
- (p) Erasing or obliterating any information printed on the OMR sheet;
- (q) Providing incorrect information on the OMR sheet;
- (r) Making fake claims by manipulating the responses in OMR sheet uploaded on website for challenge before or after declaration of result.
- (s) Creating obstacles in smooth and fair conduct of examination or creating disturbance to others inside the examination hall/room/centre.
- (t) Making an approach or attempting to influence the outcome of the result after the examination.
- (u) Any other malpractice declared as unfair means by the NTA.

2. PUNISHMENT FOR USING UNFAIR MEANS/MALPRACTICE

2.1 During the course of, before or after the examination if a candidate indulges in any of the above or similar incident, he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair practices and booked under UNFAIR MEANS (UFM) case. The candidate may be debarred from future exams.

3. CANCELLATION OF RESULT

3.1 The candidature and result of **RMS** of the candidates who indulge in Unfair Means/ Malpractice will be cancelled and will not be declared.

3.2 Similarly, the result of those candidates who appear from the Centre other than the one allotted to them, write on the Exam booklet/ OMR Sheet of other candidates or allow other candidates to write on their Exam Booklet/ OMR Sheet will be cancelled (and will not be declared).

CHAPTER 13**POST EXAMINATION ACTIVITIES AND DECLARATION OF RESULT (STAGE-1)****PROCEDURE FOR DECLARATION OF RESULT****Evaluation and Declaration of Stage-I Results:**

The NTA shall conduct the initial evaluation of examination scripts and subsequently submit the processed results to RMS/Additional Directorate General of Army Education/Army Education-2, IHQ of MOD (Army) for administrative approval. Upon receipt of formal approval from the competent authorities, the NTA will officially declare the Stage-I results through its dedicated online portal. The respective Score Card (Stage-I) can be downloaded by individual candidates through their login credential on the website. Concurrently, RMS shall host the results on its official website www.rashtriyamilitaryschools.edu.in and the shortlisted candidates will be called upon for Stage II – Medical Examination.
