JOURNEY OF COMPUTERIZATION IN HIGH COURT 1993-2007

1993: First step to computerize records - deployment of NIC team.

1996: List of Business Information System (LOBIS) introduced. UnixWare was used as Operating System and FoxBase+ was used as database. Filing Centre was established.

1999: Computer Committee was constituted for High Court. Initially, efforts were made to computerize data from filing till disposal.

2007: ISHiCo (Integrated Software for High Court) as developed by NIC, PHHC was implemented. It replaced the old system and provided basis for electronic entering of case details.



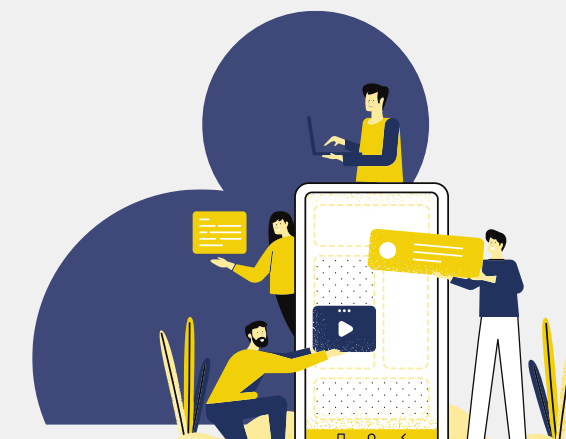
JOURNEY OF COMPUTERIZATION IN HIGH COURT 2007-2012



2011: Punjab and Haryana High court has been the **first one** to start process of digitisation of Judicial records as early as in May 2011.

2011: Punjab and Haryana High Court was amongst the **first ones** to install State-of-Art servers, Display boards and Touch Screen Kiosks at strategic places in High Court premises for the benefit of advocates and litigants.

2012: The process of **automatic preparation of Notices** and sending the same to different stakeholders through different modes including email was started.



JOURNEY OF COMPUTERIZATION IN HIGH COURT 2013-2018



2013: Integrated Automatic SMS Service was started through ISHICo. SMS were automatically sent to advocates/litigants, informing them about every stage of their case.

2013: Digitally signed bail/stay orders: This facility was started through ISHICo wherein copy of bail/stay orders etc. was sent to different stakeholders through email. This module is akin to FASTER as implemented in the year 2022.

2014: Process of providing access to digital data i.e. paperbook etc. as available on DMS was provided to Judges through **Virtual Private Network (VPN)**.

2017: Entire **Judicial and Administrative Record** in High Court was digitised and put on **Document Management System (DMS)**. Weeding guidelines were approved by Computer Committee and 250 tons of wastepaper was disposed of.

DIGITISATION IN HIGH COURT

Punjab & Haryana High Court has been the **first** in the country to start digitisation of Judicial Records as early as in May 2011

Whole process of digitisation completed in the year 2017. Entire scanned data is available on DMS of this Court in digitally signed PDF/A format.

As on date, entire record is digitised (including incremental data) which consists of **22.58 Crore** scanned pages of Judicial and Administrative files.

86 High speed Scanners have been installed for scanning fresh cases and for scanning of incremental data.



GREEN INITIATIVE



As the result of complete digitisation in High Court, the decided cases have been shifted to a separate building namely **Judicial Archives Building**, which is 12 Kms from the High Court.

Moreover, 250 tons of wastepaper has been disposed directly in the pulp tank of paper mill and thereby, minimizing health concerns as well as eliminating any chance of misuse of judicial record.

Resultantly 28,000 sq. ft. area has become available in the main High Court Building Complex.

Revenue of Rs. 24 Lakhs was generated by disposing wastepaper with paper mill.



DIGITISATION IN DISTRICT COURTS

Scanning of decided Judicial files in District Courts started in the year 2018.

The scanning of fresh cases has also started in all District courts from July 2022. Now, the same is active in all Districts and about 2 Crore pages have been scanned.

Process of scanning of historical data is also active in all 44 Districts in Punjab, Haryana and UT Chandigarh. As on date, 26.3 Crore pages of decided Judicial files have been scanned.

Document Management System (DMS) for displaying District Courts scanned data is in the final stages of development. It is being developed in DSpace.

- KOHA is integrated with Radio-Frequency Identification (RFID) which has enabled library automation & security.
- There is automated book issuance and return system through e-Card.
- Complete physical verification of inventory of books is being done with handheld scanners.
- **Electronic Article Surveillance (EAS) Security Gates** has ensured security and detection of any theft or accidental removal of books.
- High speed automatic **book scanner** is also available for scanning of old gazettes and old books without disturbing their binding. This facilitates sharing information from these rare books/gazettes without their physical movement.

- This software has been developed in-house by High Court in consultation with NIC, PHHC. It has been developed to create centralized database of persons standing as sureties in different cases at District courts.
- It stores vital information like UIDAI number, DOB, property details and real time photograph of surety & his verifier.
- It is integrated with existing CIS, resulting in linkage of case details with surety details. This amalgamation has been helpful in identification of defaulters standing sureties in multiple cases with false/bogus identities.
- The process of its integration at state and intra-state level is in progress. This module has been shared with other High Courts.

e-Custody Module : Launched in year 2017 in State of Haryana, in consultation with the High Court, this module helped to manage online custody certificates from different jails of State, for production in Courts, thus saving time and money of officials. This module is presently completely implemented in States of Haryana and Punjab.

e-Vetting: Launched in year 2017 in State of Haryana, in consultation with the High Court, this module helped to facilitate officials concerned to get their reply or affidavit vetted from AG Office online. Thus, eliminating physical movement of file and manpower thereby saving huge resources and efforts.

LCR eCopy : The entire case record of District Courts is received in digital form, for appellate / revisional purposes thus, saving time and paper.

Digitized Agenda: Administrative files are digitized in High Court. All agendas of the Committee Meetings as well as Full Court meeting are circulated digitally, since long.

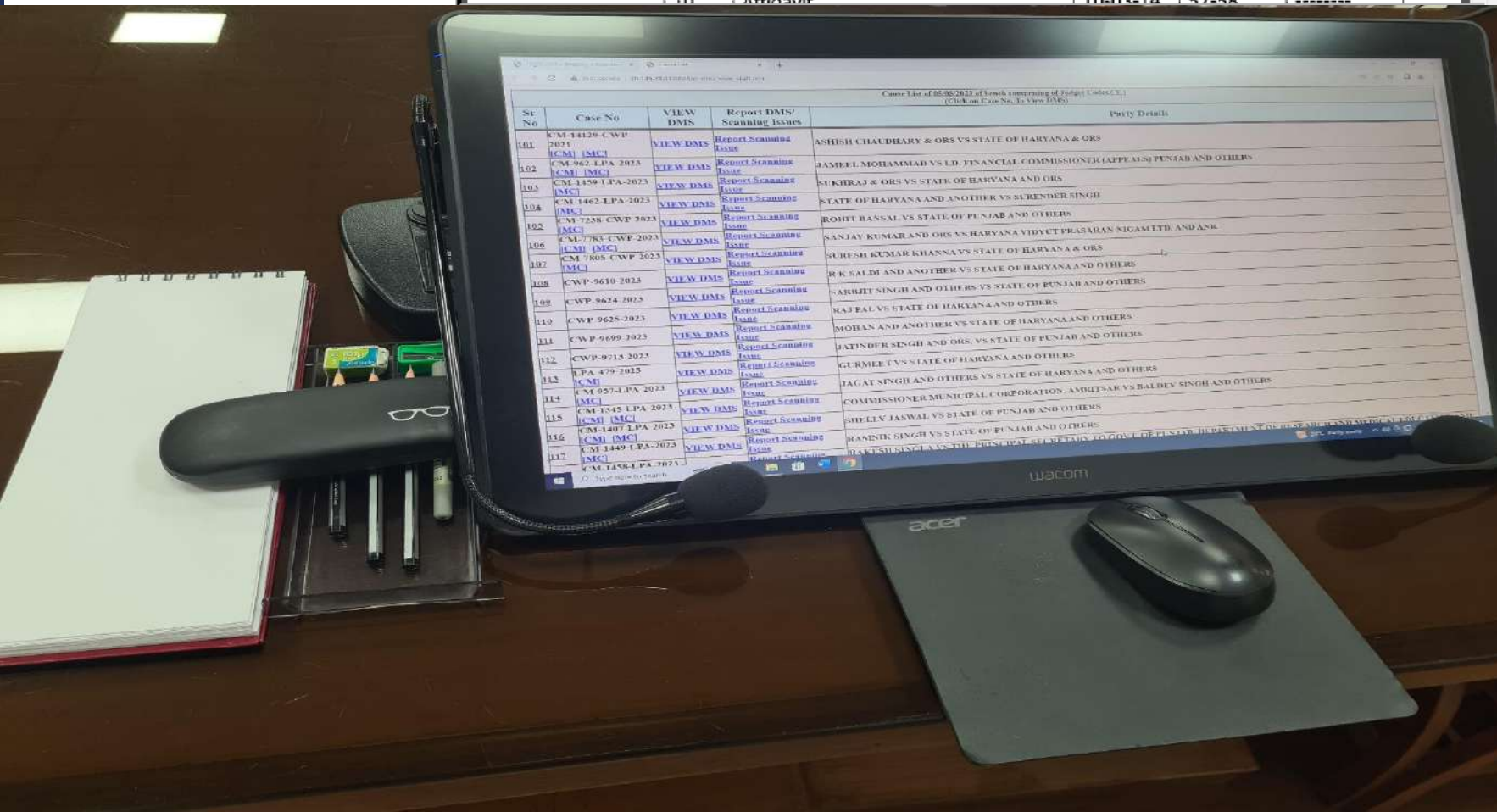

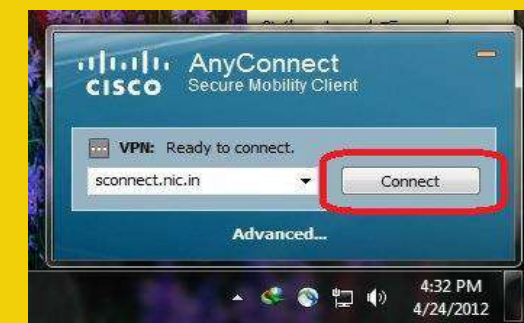

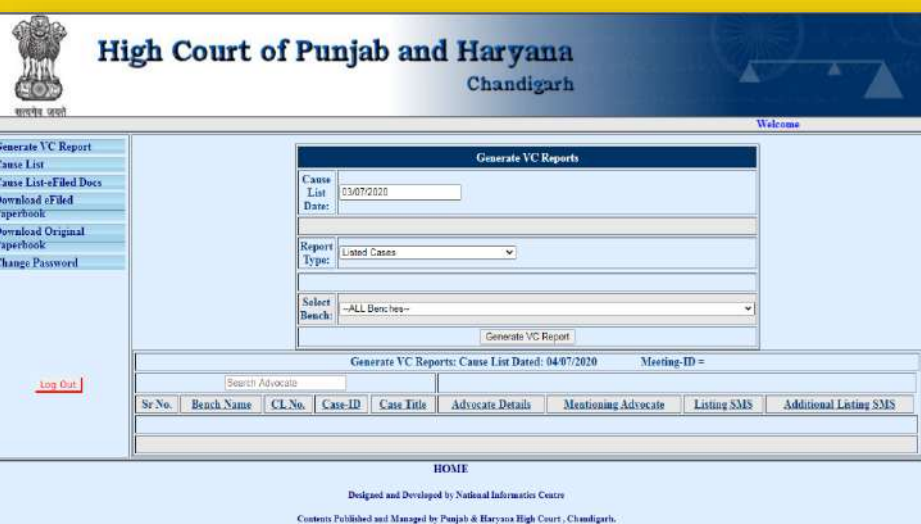

- During pandemic, facility to access and download complete paperbook was extended to advocates and Government Offices and Court proceedings were conducted through V.C. using downloaded digital paperbook data.
- Touch screen WIACOM machines have been provided. More and more Judges are opting for paperless courts.



INNOVATIVES STRIDES DURING PANDEMIC IN HIGH COURT

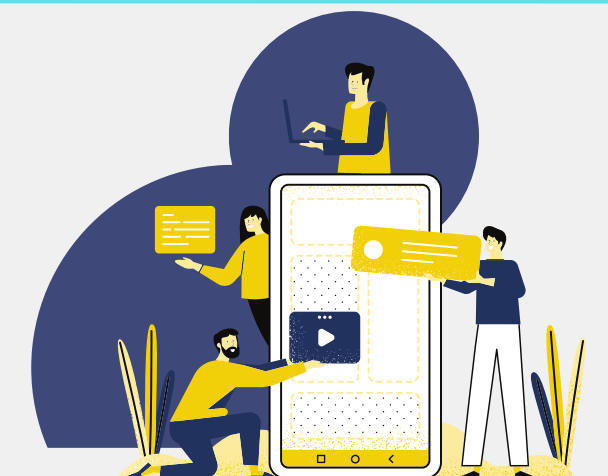


Online Mentioning Module: Punjab and Haryana High Court was first to develop this module wherein advocates could make request for mentioning of cases online. After approval, mentioning list was generated and displayed on website.

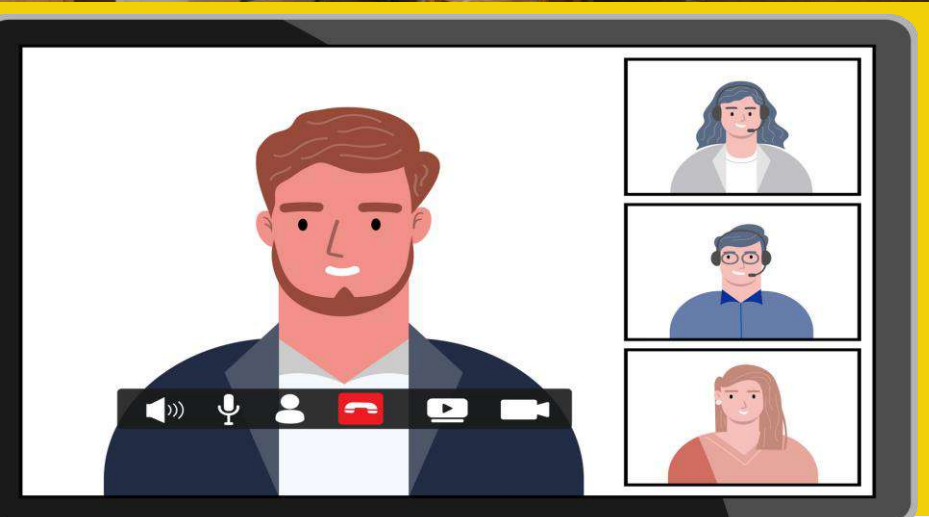
Android Mobile Application: Through this application, court staff had facility to check cause-list and to conduct V.C. by contacting concerned advocates on a single click through their mobile phone.

Judges Diary Module: Facility of e-Diary/DMS was extended to all Judges without using VPN wherein they could download paperbooks of all cases. This module facilitated judges to deal with cases from camp offices digitally through VC.

Email Service to Advocates and Government offices: During pandemic, facility of downloading complete paperbook was extended to Government Offices and Advocates through eDiary, on similar lines as provided to Judges.
