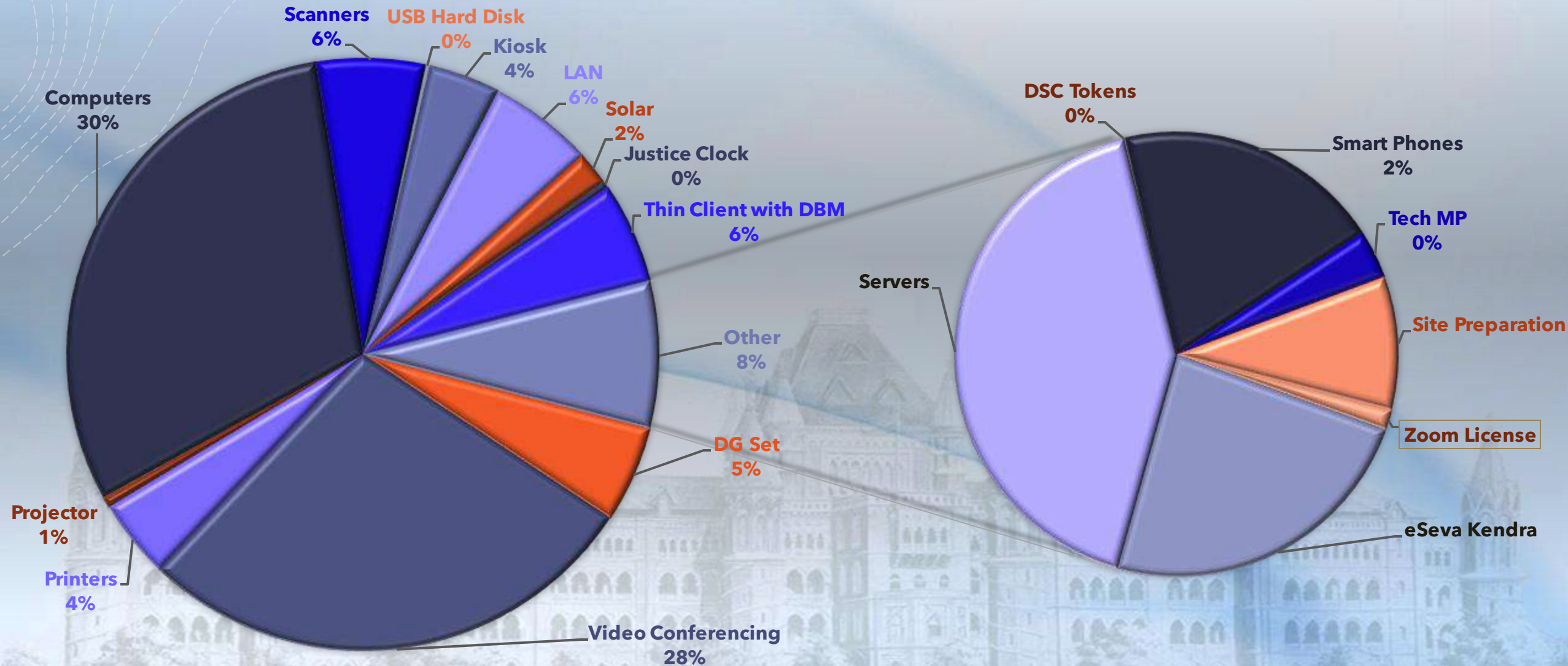

Component wise eCourts Fund Utilization



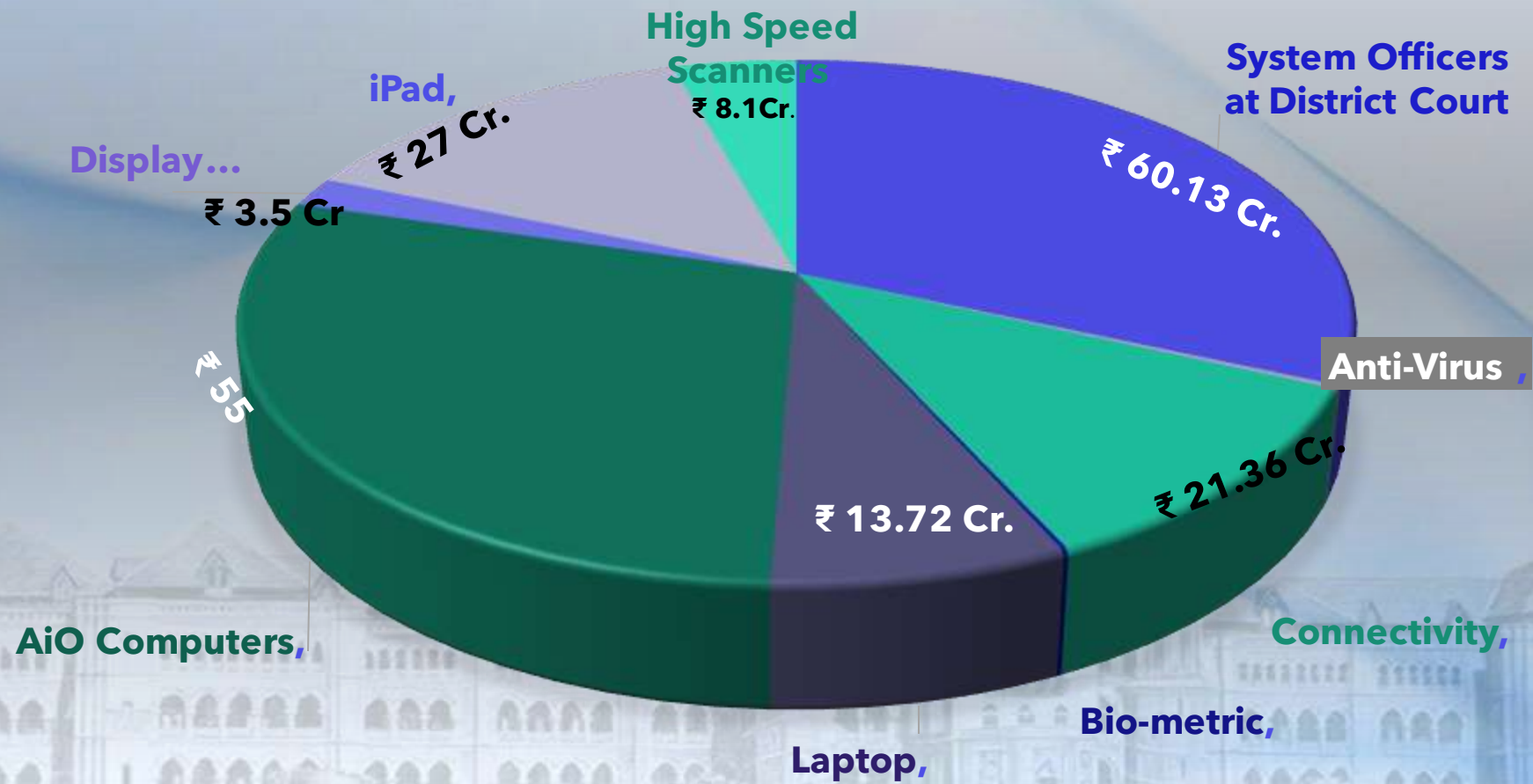

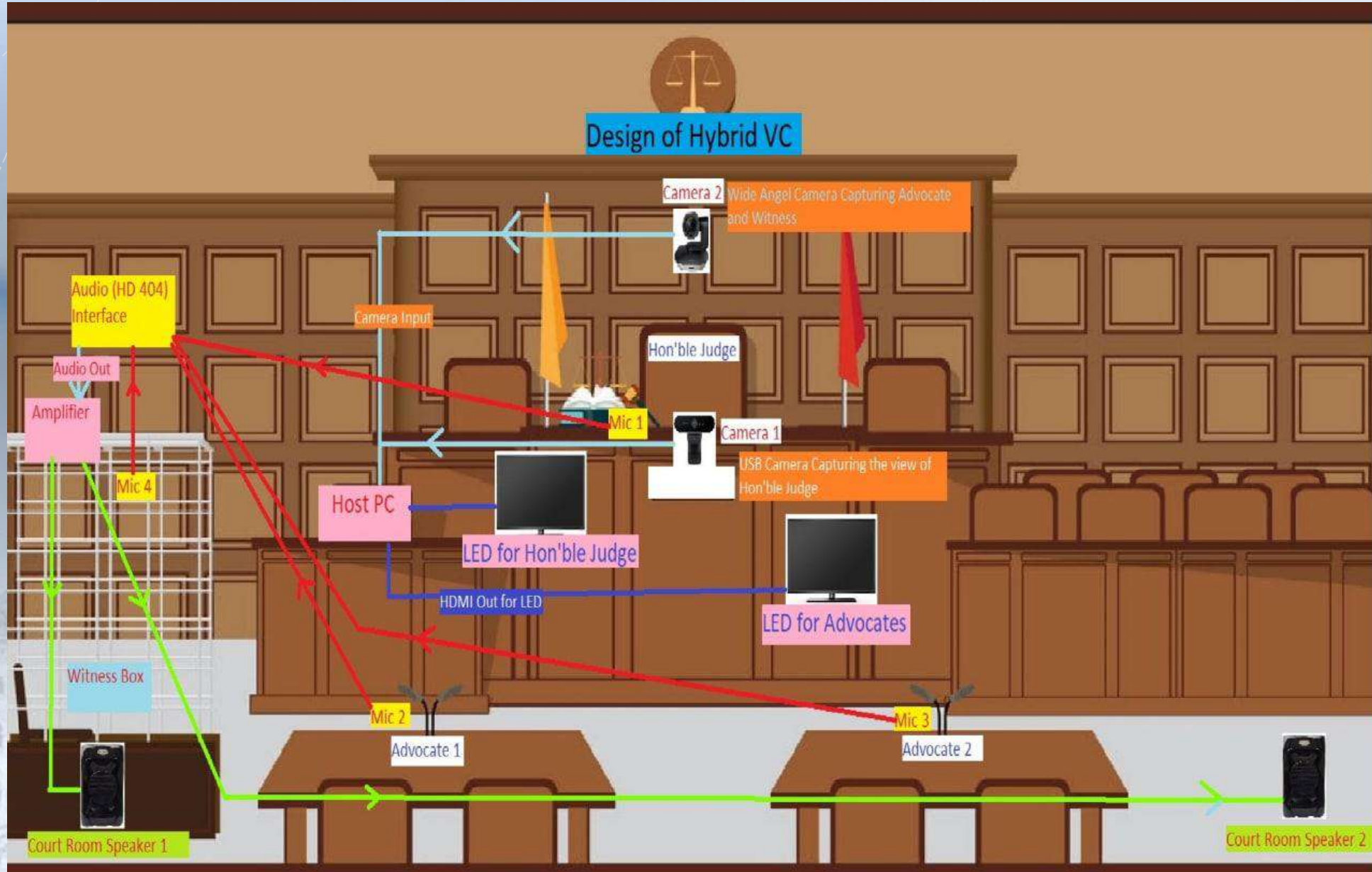

Paperless Courts, Efforts & Planning



Hardware required for paperless Courts.

- All the Hon'ble Judges at Principal seat at Bombay, Benches at Nagpur and Aurangabad and High Court of Bombay at Goa are provided with Mac Book Pro laptops with M2 chipset.
- All the Hon'ble Judges at Principal seat at Bombay, Benches at Nagpur and Aurangabad and High Court of Bombay at Goa are provided with iPad Pro 12.9 inches device with pencil. Thus writing interface is provided to the Hon'ble Judges to facilitate annotations and notes taking on pdf file.



Sensitization and Awareness

- Hands on training session for all the Hon'ble Judges at Principal seat at Bombay, Benches at Nagpur and Aurangabad and High Court of Bombay at Goa is conducted under the directions of the then Hon'ble the Chief Justice of High Court of Bombay (**Full Court meeting was called only for this training**).
- The Hon'ble Chairperson of the Computer Committee conducted the training session with focus on applications in iPad which facilitate paperless mode of working.
- At present many High Court Judges are accessing their digitised case files through their iPads, laptops and computer provided in the Court room. It is indeed a proud moment that e-filed cases are not printed but accessed through iPads or laptops.



Management for paperless Courts

- There are certain case types wherein new cases can be instituted adopting mode of e-filing only.
- In such cases soft copies of the case files are shared to the Hon'ble Judges through online mode. The e-filed cases are never printed or shared in physical form with the Hon'ble Judges.
- The Hon'ble Judges, now, have accustomed to read the soft copies on their iPads. Often notes on digitised files are taken using tools provided encouraging paperless mode of working in the High Court.
- Staff of the High Court have also adjusted to paperless mode of working and acquired skills to arrange case files which contains their remarks, served notices/summons, reports, and orders passed by the Court from time to time.

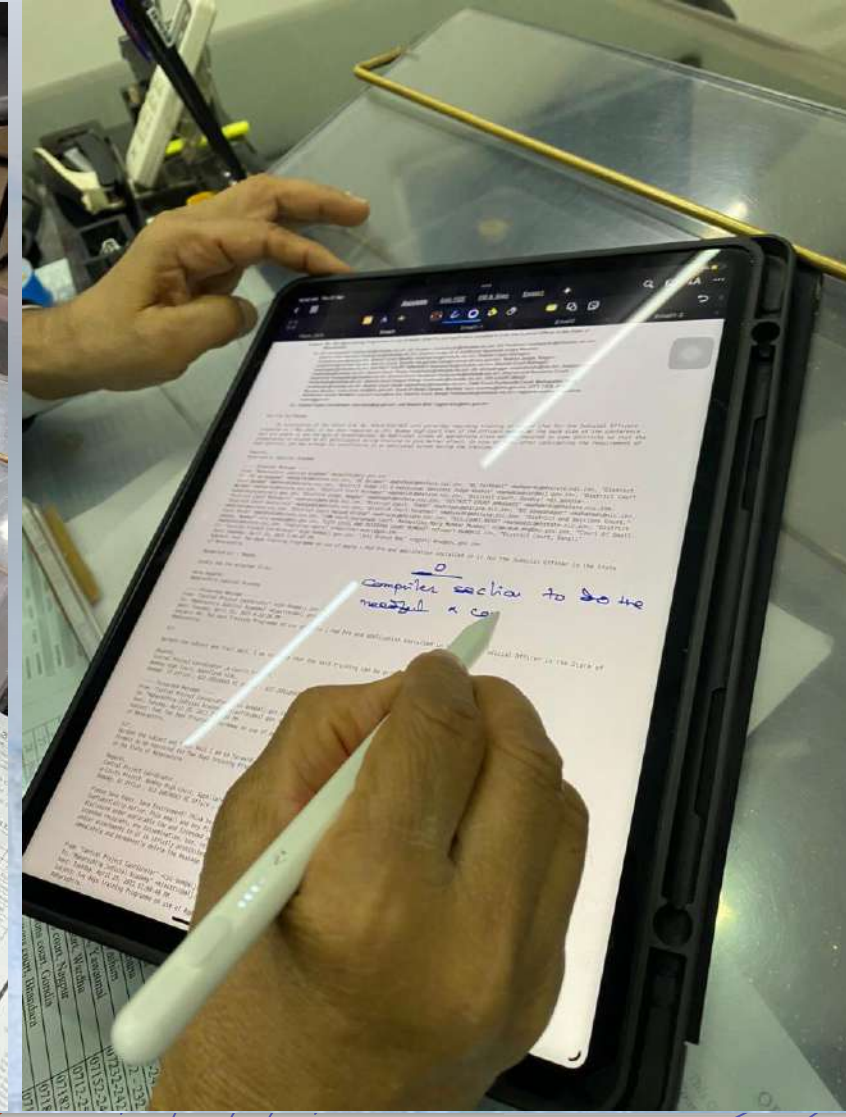
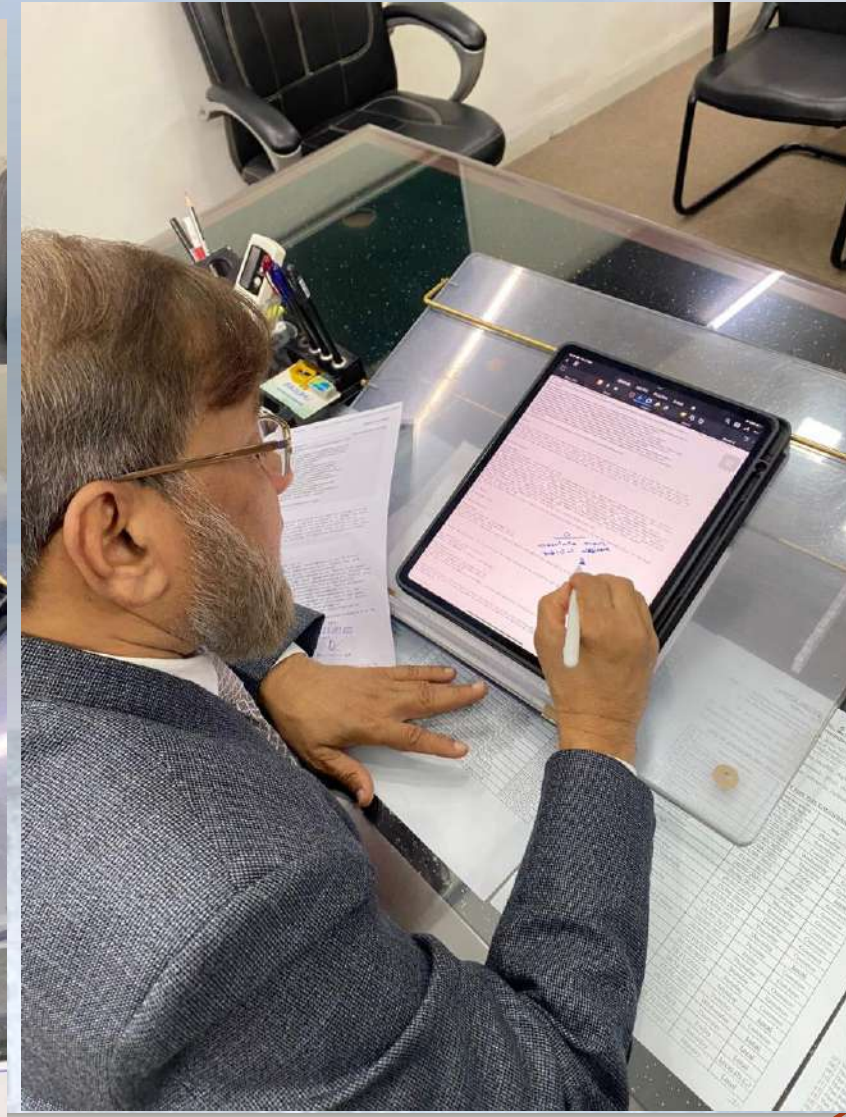


iPads for District and Taluka Courts

- Every Judicial Officer in the State of Maharashtra is provided with iPad and pen.
- All the Judicial Officers in the State have undergone training about iPad and making use of the iPad in paperless mode of working.
- Many judges have started using iPad for paperless mode of working.
- They download e-filed cases. They annotate the case files. They take notes.
- Judicial Officers use iPads for correcting their judgements and orders. This mode of working is resulting in saving paper and printing. The aggregate result of saving printing and paper is definitely saving the environment.

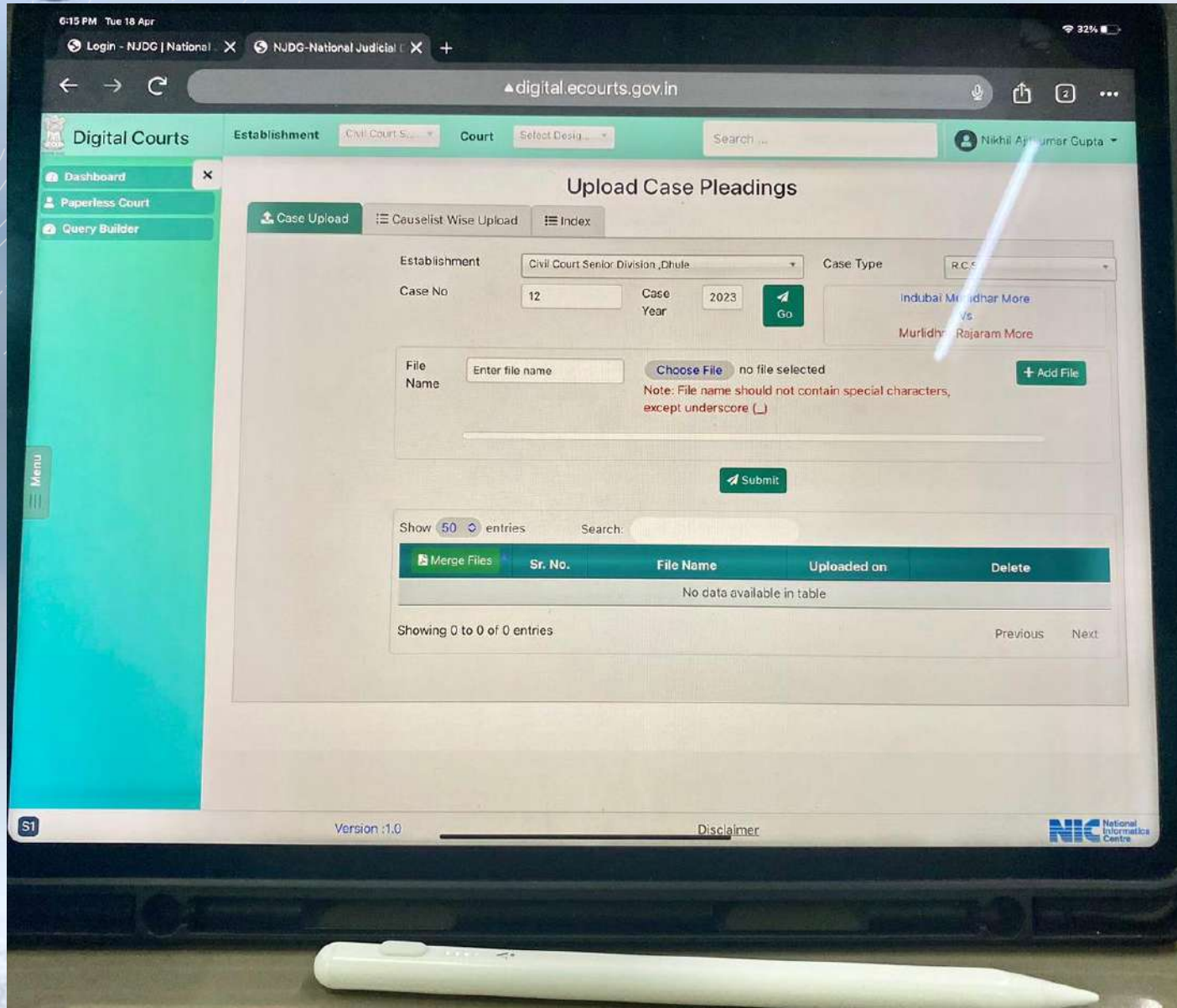


Use of iPads for paperless mode of work

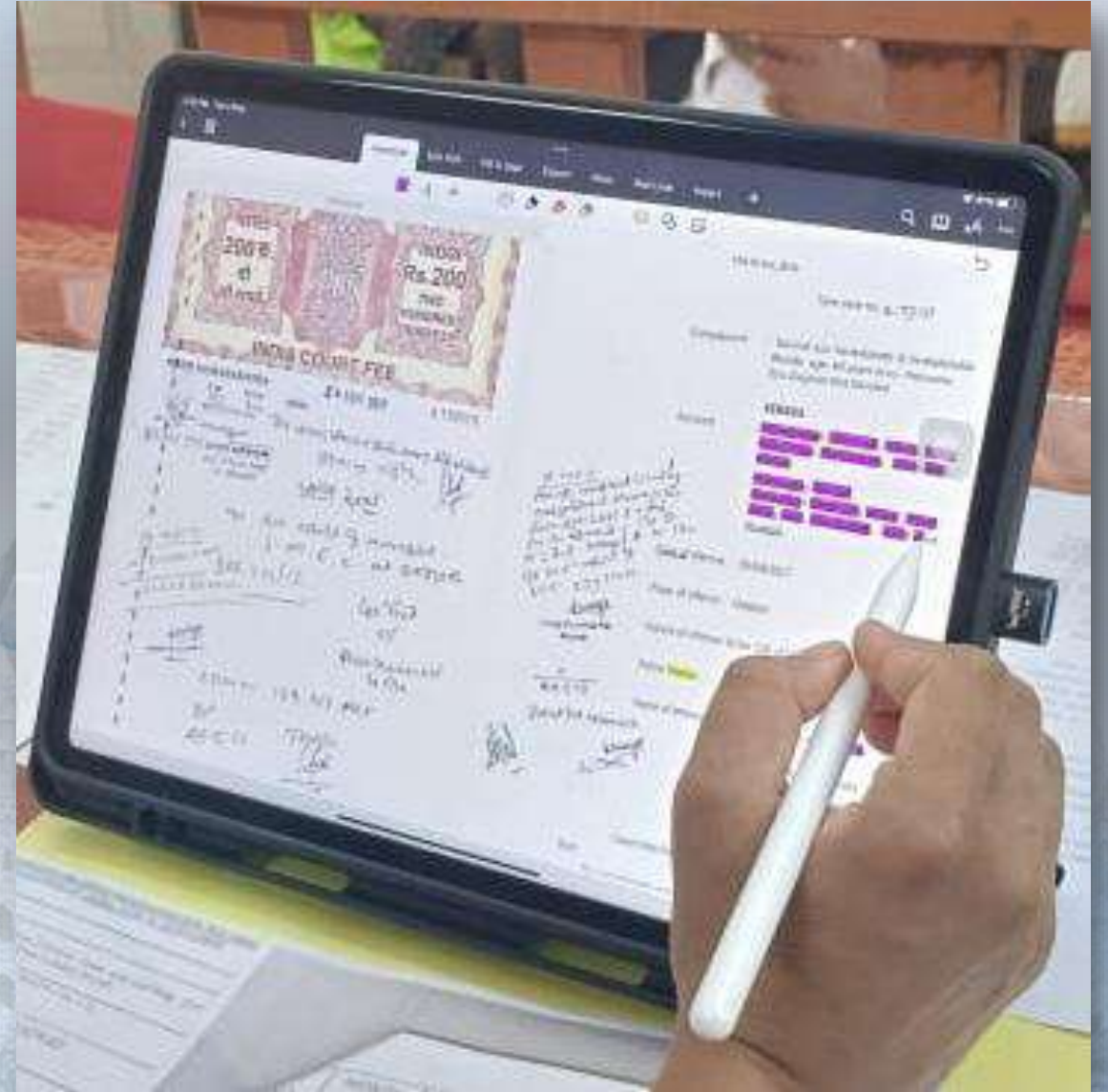

Dear Judge,

I am sure you will agree with me that *paperless courts* are no longer a distant dream: they are a reality that can be achieved. It will take your leadership to reach this goal.

You know that our staff organized a one-day training programme on 1st May 2023 and 5th May 2023 on the suggested use of the iPad Pros newly provided to each judge. Applications for efficiency in paperless mode were demonstrated. The programme was directed to every judicial officer in the State. We have also conducted similar awareness sessions at the High Court.

I should enter a clarification here: there is no 'one right way' to use the iPad, nor is there one 'perfect' app. The iPad is, by design, flexible, malleable, and adaptable — it lends itself beautifully to working with *any* app of choice. Some users will prefer one app over the other. From our perspective, this is *perfectly all right*, and we do not insist on anyone using the iPad for a paperless court in one particular way. Indeed, and on the contrary, we encourage you and each of your fellow judges to experiment and try out different apps to

Please also remember that your laptops should be used for CIS and video-conferencing (VC), and the iPads for all other work.

It is my very great privilege to tell you that many of my own colleagues, even those who were at first hesitant, have embraced this new methodology not only with great enthusiasm, but also with remarkable success.

The staff, too, needs to be sensitized and made aware of the new working protocols and advantages. As judges migrate to paperless courts, the support staff must follow. Again, this is an initial additional task for the head of each establishment. Yet, we have every confidence in all our judicial officers, and are sure that with your constant guidance and steering, we will achieve our goal sooner rather than later.

But the lead must be yours, and yours alone. As the administrative head of the entire district, this burden is on you. I would encourage you to advise the District Computer Committee members to formulate policies and put out suggestions for daily paperless court working. The DCC can assist you in monitoring progress and resolving issues.

Separately, we have already provided District Court with advanced high-end scanners. Taluka courts will be similarly provisioned soon. Physical/paper files can thus be rapidly converted to digital documents. But this means establishing a system (initially at least for final hearing and judgment caption matters) so that the judges have soft copies easily accessible in an organized and systematic manner. My CPC and I are always available should you have any issues.

Judicial officers who encounter any issues should be allowed to inform the DCCs. A brief consolidated report of these issues can then be sent to the office of our Central Project Coordinator for suggested action and corrective measures. Based on your feedback, follow up sessions can be arranged, and training videos can be prepared in identified areas for Judicial Officers who require further assistance.

My best wishes for progress in the paperless courts project.

Data Driven Decisions & Data Accuracy



Data Driven Decision

- Large repository of data stored in CIS or NJDG can be put to use only when the data entered is accurate and reliable.
- Bombay High Court has taken corrective measures to improve the data entered in CIS from time to time.
- Data Accuracy exercise must have been conducted on dozens of times only with an object that the data in CIS must be so accurate that it can be acted upon for various administrative and policy decisions.
- The Computer Committee of the Bombay High Court has taken decision that business entered in CIS shall be primary record and printed copy of roznama shall be the secondary. For this decision, the litigants in Maharashtra are now habituated to read the business transacted in a case on listed before the Court through the mobile app or the website.



Data Driven Decision

- The reports generated through NJDG are believable as data is accurate.
- Act and Sections entered in a case are effectively monitored at the time of institution. Seldom cases wherein entries are missed are captured in data accuracy drives.
- Office of SCMS Committee of the High Court used NJDG tools to provide list of more than 10 years old, 20 years old, 30 years old cases pending before 2000 officers.
- Each Judicial Officer was supplied with list of cases which are to be targeted for this year. The list is updated again after the Annual General Transfers. This is possible only due to NJDG and data accuracy.

- The Monthly Planner is for District Court Computer Committees to monitor regular updation and citizen centric services.
- The Court Managers are primarily assigned with responsibilities to generate different reports and place it before the Committee after necessary analysis, as per the fixed schedule of subjects and week mentioned in the Monthly Planner.
- The Monthly Planner helps to supervise IT based initiatives and services under eCourts Project, data accuracy in CIS and Data Driven Decisions through the tools provided under NJDG.

Virtual Courts – Traffic Challan

- 15th May 2020 first Virtual Court for traffic Challan was inaugurated at Pune
- On 31st October 2020 Virtual Court for Transport related Challans was made operational.
- The Government of Maharashtra adopted “One State One Challan” system for generation of traffic challans.
- Integration of Virtual Courts is completed with OSOC.
- Now there is a reason to believe that the State Government is adopting e-Challan system for generation of traffic challans. The Hon’ble Acting Chief Justice asked to roll out virtual courts for all the Districts.

Digitisation



Digitisation

- Services of NICS empanelled vendor DataSoft are hired under Contract. Demonstration was given wherein it was ensured final output in DSpace is in conformity with the SOP given by the eCommittee, Supreme Court of India.
- Locations for scanning activities at Bombay, Nagpur, Aurangabad and Goa are identified and necessary site preparations are done.
- Four High end servers are deployed at Four Locations and testing completed. 1Gbps separate internet connectivity line obtained only for digitisation.
- "**BHC Ingestion**" and "**BHC Interact**" two software are deployed at all four locations and tested for entire scanning flow.
- "**BHC Connect**" is software deployed at four locations which permits the District and Taluka Courts to upload record and proceedings concerning any case at High Court. After uploading, the record and proceeding becomes accessible to the Hon'ble Judges in the cause-list along with main case record.
