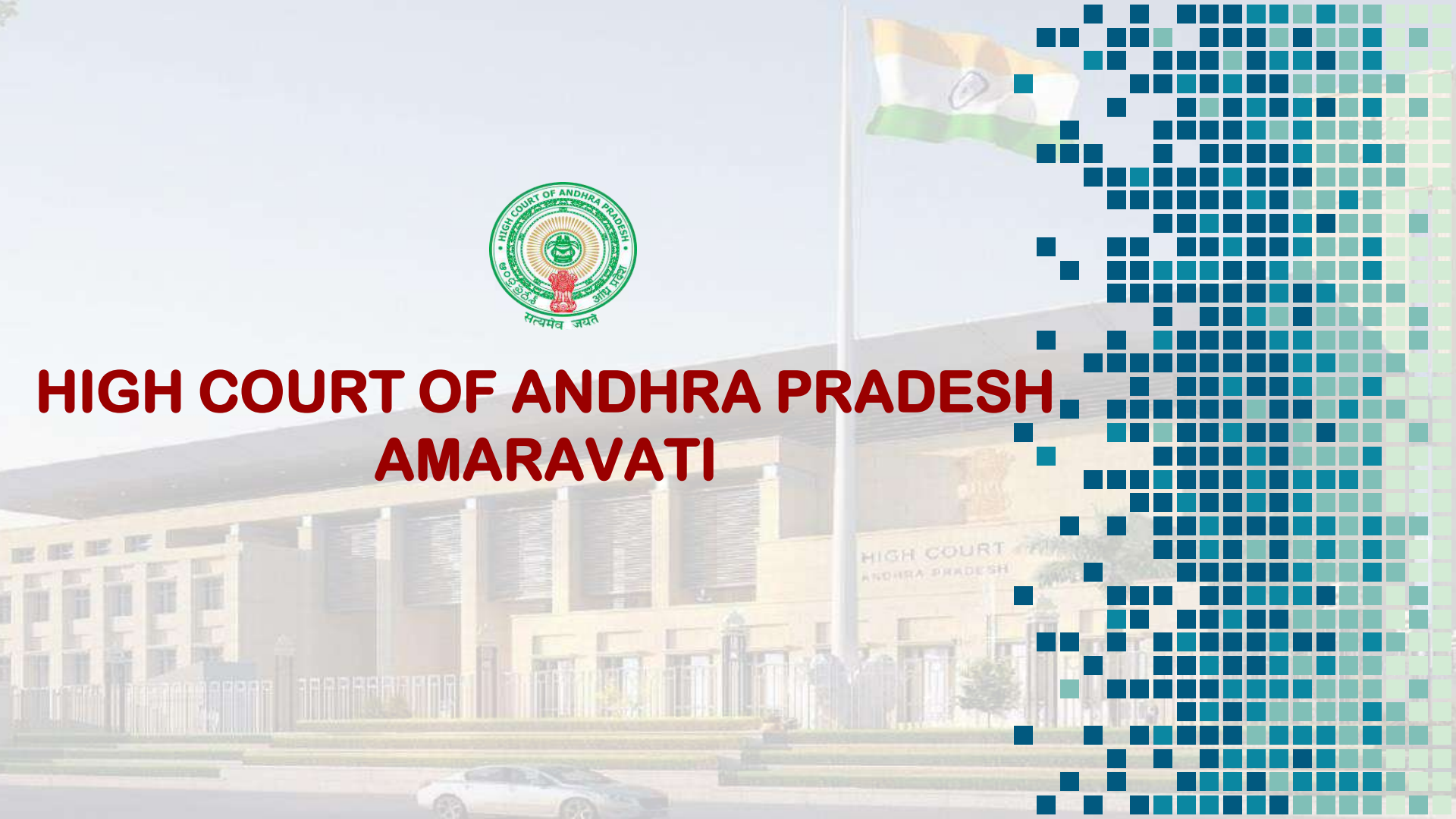




HIGH COURT OF ANDHRA PRADESH AMARAVATI



Brief Introduction

The High Court of Andhra Pradesh, after bifurcation from the common High Court, started functioning from 01.01.2019 in the Interim Judicial Complex at Amaravati in Nelapadu.

The High Court started development of ITC Infrastructure with available resources. But, unfortunately, Covid-19 stood in the way of completing the activities.

The High Court developed its own indigenous e-filing module during Covid-19 pandemic for the use of High Court as well as District Courts in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

Brief Introduction



64,964 cases were filed in High Court during the pandemic period. 4,59,283 number of cases were filed through e-Filing in District Courts.

The High Court and the District Courts in Andhra Pradesh State conducted Court proceedings through Video Conferencing using BlueJeans software and available hardware.

46,901 number of cases were disposed during the pandemic period in the High Court through Video Conferencing.

2,49,579 number of cases were disposed during the pandemic period in the District Courts through Video Conferencing.

Brief Introduction



After the pandemic, the High Court has been taking steps to implement all e-Initiatives as directed by the Hon'ble e-Committee, Supreme Court of India in the High Court as well as in the District Courts.

The High Court as a part of e-Initiatives implemented ICJS and NSTEP projects in the District Courts.

The High Court also developed a mobile application for the use of stakeholders. Also an online certified copy application for the use of stakeholders in the High Court.

In this presentation, I have privilege of sharing information about the mobile application, online certified copy application developed and implemented in the High Court of Andhra Pradesh, and about the ICJS project in the District Courts, as a part of e-Initiatives.

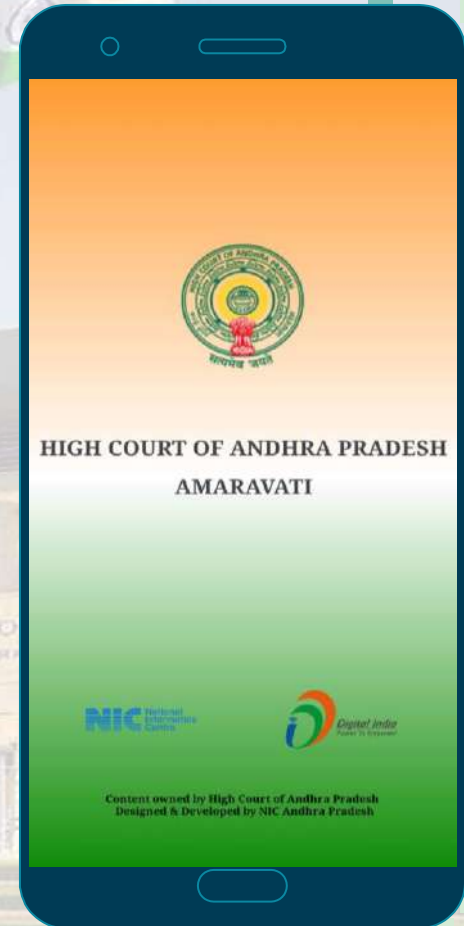

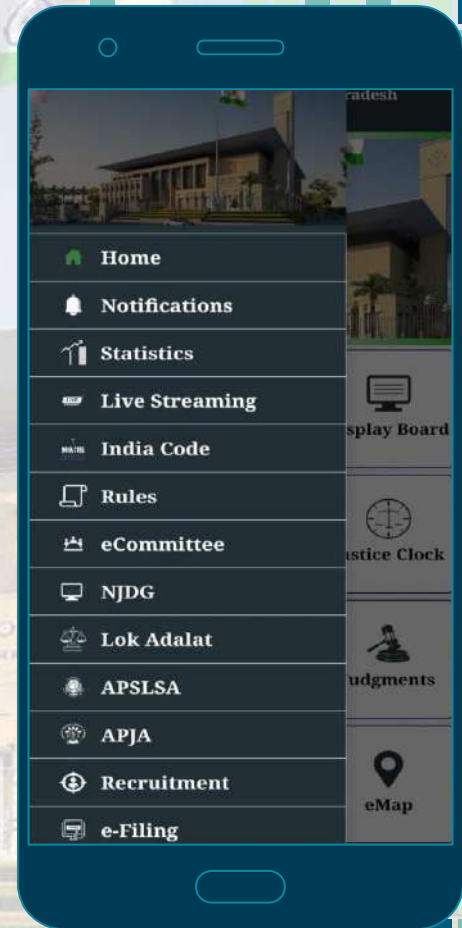

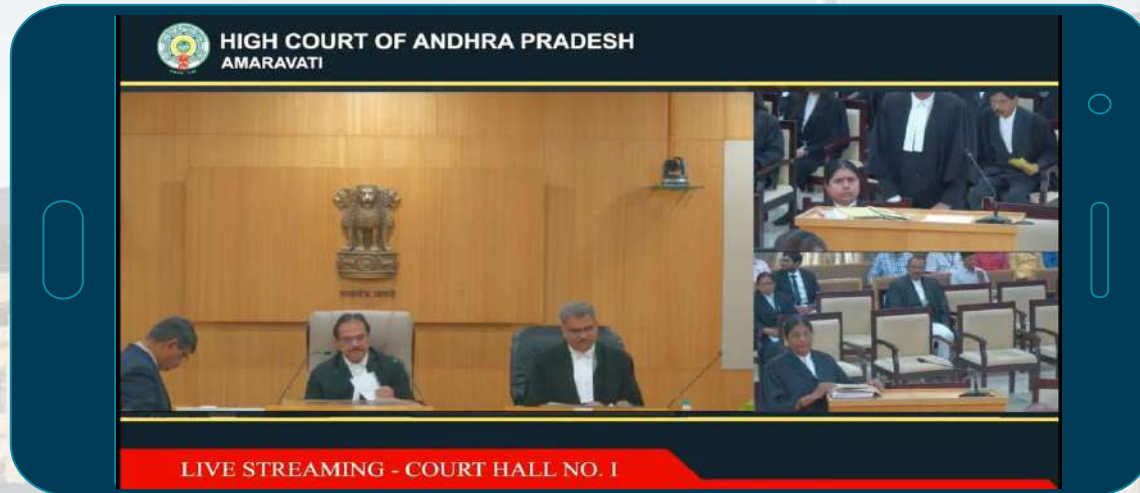
The menu provides important information for the Judicial Officers, Advocates and litigant public.

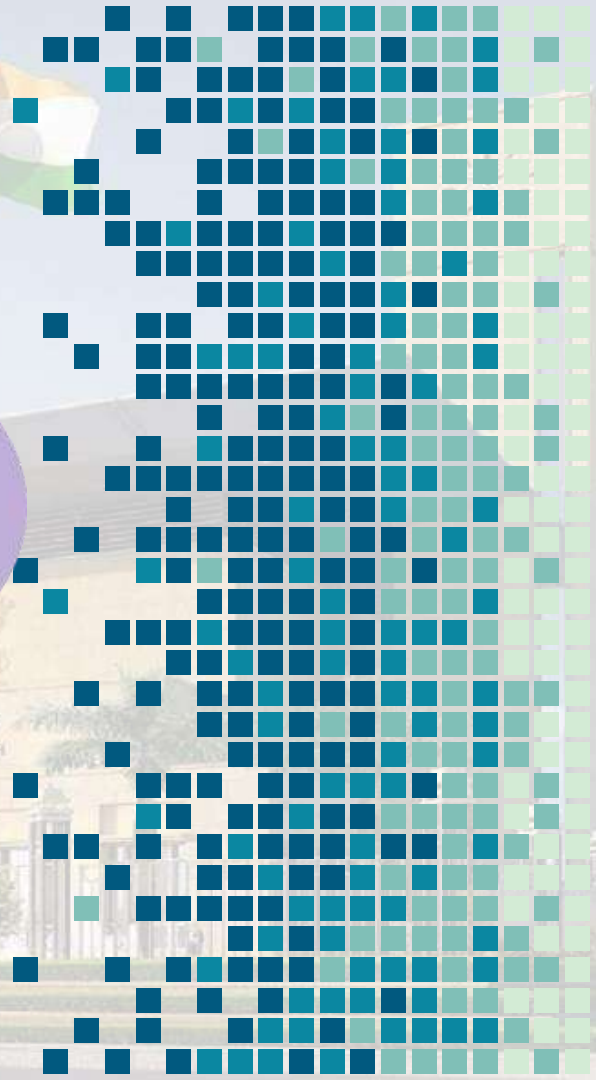

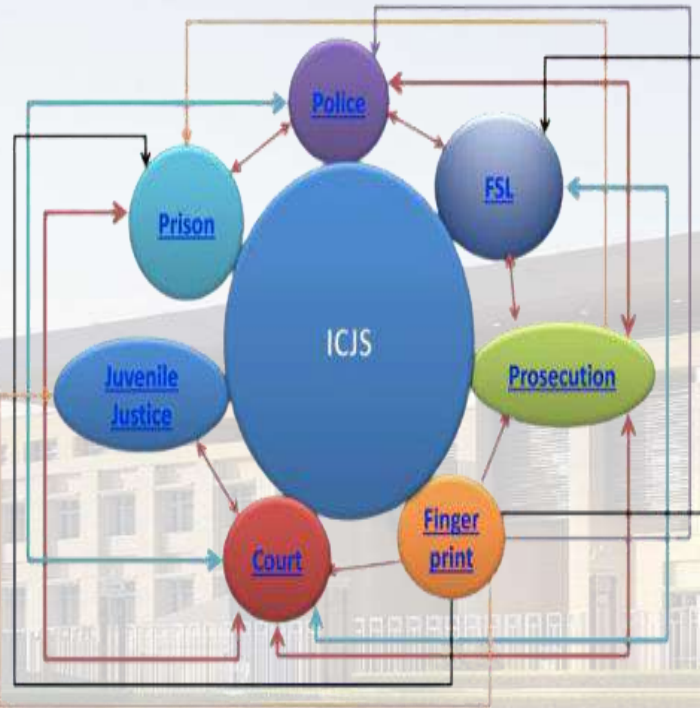

- Details of FIR shall be made available for verification



- Go to ICJS and Click on Consume Charge Sheet
- Charge Sheets filed by Police will be made available for Consumption

- Then, Charge Sheets data will be verified
- After verification Case will be Acknowledged with CNR number and SR No. (Filing No).
- After generation of SR No in CIS it shall be registered through Case Registration option.





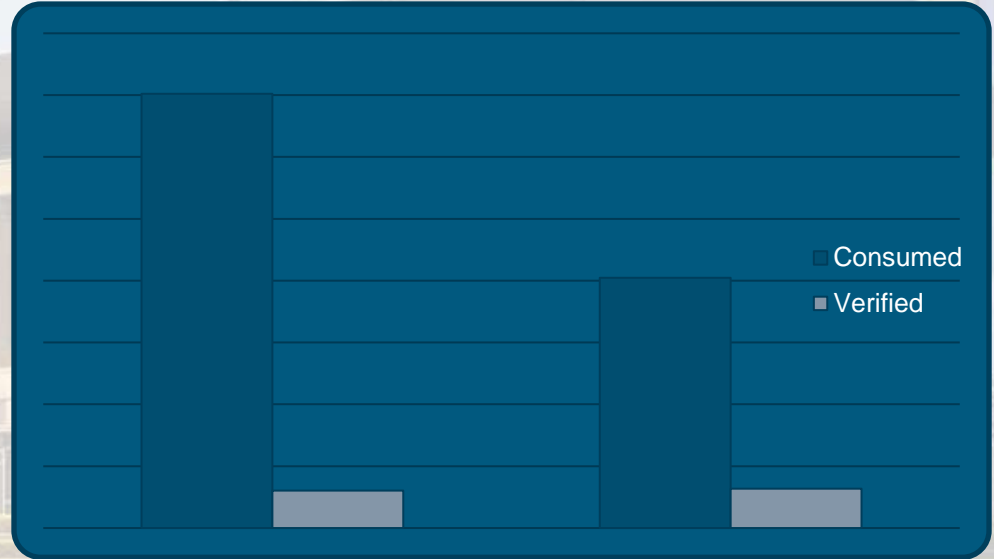


