## eCommittee Conducts the First Ever Digital Accessibility Training for Visually Challenged Judicial Officers & Court Officials

























Thee-Committee, Supreme Court of India conducted the first ever Digital Accessibility ICT training for Visually challenged Judicial Officers and Court staff on 17&18 April 2023 at IIPA, New Delhi. The Hon'ble Chief Justice of India, Dr Justice D.Y.Chandrachud, interacted with the participants from various parts of the country and heard their suggestions and feedback on the training. Making the digital infrastructure of the Indian judicial system more accessible to persons with disabilities is one of the core components of the e-Committee, Supreme Court of India. As Hon'ble Chairperson of the e-Committee, Dr Justice D.Y. Chandrachud exhorted all High Courts to make their digital infrastructure accessible to all, in conformity with the constitutional and statutory entitlements of people with disabilities. The letter contained a series of structural interventions for all High Courts to undertake towards enhancing digital accessibility. A significant milestone in the Ecommittee's efforts towards this objective- the Ecommittee has made all High Court websites, the websites of the E-committee and e-Courts, and the judgement search portal accessible to persons with disabilities. Digital accessibility training for the Differently Abled is a part of the eCommittee's ICT capacity-building exercise. The digital accessibility training will be spread to all categories of disabilities among Judges and Court staff in a phased manner.





In the first phase, Digital Accessibility training has been held for the visually challenged Judges and Court Staff, which is the first of its kind. Hon'ble Justice Rajiv Shakdher inaugurated the two-day programme, Judge Delhi High Court, In the august presence of Hon'ble Justice G R Swaminathan Judge High Court of Madras, Shri SKG Rahate Secretary Department of Justice, S.N.Tripathi, Director General IIPA. Shri Rajesh Aggarwal, Secretary, Department of of Persons with Disabilities, **Empowerment** addressed the Valedictory function. The two-day digital accessibility training was held in two separate batches for six visually challenged Judicial officers and 14 visually challenged Court staff. The training was held as Hands-on training covering various assistive technologies like the accessible reading of court documents with a screen reader and instant reading device; accessible documentation & notemaking in a digital work environment; techniques and tools for scan and creating Digital Accessible format; using the internet, judgement searching with smartphone-based readers; assistive screen technologies, the orientation of keyboard and input in regional languages, Artificial intelligence tools and techniques for the visually impaired, digital office handling & usages. Ms. R. Arulmozhiselvi, Member (HR), eCommittee, coordinated the programme with Er Manish Verma, Director NIEPVD, and Dr. Surabhi Pandey, IIPA.

The eCommittee organized a two-days training on digital accessibility training for visually chal-lenged court staff in the coordination with the National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Visual Disabilities (NIEPVD). This transformative program took place at the Tamil Nadu State Judicial Academy from 19th December, 2023 to 20th December, 2023 (Batch 1) and 21st December, 2023 to 22nd December, 2023 (Batch 2). The digital accessibility training for visually challenged starts with an inaugural session and Mr. C. Sanjai Baba, Director of Tamil Nadu State Judicial Academy, address welcome speech to all the participants & Ms. R. Arulmozhiselvi from the eCommittee delivered a scope and objective of digital accessible training and vote of thanks to all participants given by Dr. R. Sathya, Additional Director, TamilNadu State Judicial Academy.

The two-day training witnessed a convergence of dedicated participants from various courts across the nation, eager to acquire skills and knowledge to better serve individuals with visual im-pairments.

In this training, 33 court staff participate from High Court and District Courts and Mr. G.M. Sridhar, Computer Faculty, NIEPVD and Ms. A. Anushiya, Computer Faculty, NIEPVD trained participants to easily accessible the document. The eCommittee, a body formed by the Supreme Court of India to promote the use of technology in the judiciary, organized this training as part of its ongoing efforts to make justice more accessible to all. The two-day training was held in the hands-on training model wherein each participant have system which is provided by Tamil Nadu State Judicial Academy loaded with accessibility software like NVDA, Jaws, etc.











e-Committee Conducts a Digital Accessibility Training For Visually Challenged Court Staff at Kerala on 15.01.2024 and 16.01.2024(Batch-I) and January 2024 17.01.2024 and 18.01.2024(Batch-II)

















The e-committee's digital accessibility 2-day hands-on training program for the visually challenged court staff was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Justice of the Kerala High Court, Justice Ashish Jitendra Desai on the 15th of January. Justice A. Muhamed Mustaque, Chairperson (computerisation committee), delivered a special address while Ms. R. Arulmozhiselvi, Member (HR), e-committee introduced the attendees with the scope and object of the digital accessibility training program. The event was then concluded by a vote of thanks by Sri. Joseph Rajesh K. A., Deputy Director (IT). This transformative program was held at the Kerala High Court in collaboration with Kerala Judicial Academy from the 15th to 18th January, 2024 in the I.T. Training Hall in two batches. The two batches covered a strength of 53 visually challenged court staff members.

The special educators from the NIEPVD Regional Centre, Chennai, Mr. GM Sreedhar along with Ms. Anushiva A, computer faculty, conducted a hand holding training in using various assistive technologies, covering various aspects such as accessible reading of court documents, documentation and note-making in a digital work environment, creating digital accessible format, using internet and judgement search through the e-SCR portal, judgement search portal using the screen readers, smartphone-based assistive technologies, and input in regional languages.

The training program aims at making the digital infrastructure of the Indian Judicial System more accessible to persons with disabilities which is one of the core objectives of the e-committee, executed under the guidance of the hon'ble Chief Justice of India, Dr Justice D. Y. Chandrachud.

- The program's journey was captured in a documentary.
- Participants talked about their satisfying training experiences.
- Mr. Shivaram S. Deshpande presented project options for staff members with visual impairments, and Dr. Sanjay Jain praised the program as an international success story and a model for implementing accessibility.
- In order to create an inclusive workplace, Hon. Mr. Justice S. Sunil Dutt Yadav emphasized teamwork and ongoing development. The participants' eagerness for more instruction in court-related software applications demonstrates their dedication to lifelong learning and career advancement. For the Indian judiciary, this ground-breaking eCommittee effort represents a ray of hope for establishing a fully inclusive workplace where people with disabilities can realize their full potential.
