All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE) -2023.

All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE) -2023 was conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) on 08.01.2023 in the paper-pen mode at 406 centres, located in 175 Cities across India, for admission to Class VI of the 33 Sainik Schools and approved New Sainik Schools and Class IX of the Sainik Schools across the country.

The examination for admission to Class VI was conducted in 13 languages and that for admission to Class IX was conducted in English.

19 Zonal Coordinators, 10 Regional Coordinators, 175 City Coordinators, 599 Observers and 138 Deputy Observers were deployed across the country to conduct the exam smoothly.

Post exam, the questions, provisional answer keys, OMR answer sheets and the recorded responses of the candidates were hosted on the NTA website during 12.02.2023 to 15.02.2023 and challenges were invited from the candidates who appeared in the exam.

Challenges received were verified by the experts and the results were processed as per the answer keys finalised by the experts.

Results of the exam are declared on 24.02.2023 and score cards of individual candidates are hosted on NTA's website https://aissee.nta.nic.in.

Qualifying criteria of minimum marks does not apply to SC/ST. Hence the appeared count of SC/ST is the same as qualified.
