- Candidates whose names are appearing in the National Merit List are required to approach the concerned training institutions for provisional admission alongwith the following original documents and 02 sets of photocopy for verification:
 - Printout of the online Application form submitted for Centralized Admission Process.
 - II. 10th, 12th Marksheets and certificates
 - III. 02 Passport size latest coloured photograph
 - IV. Aadhar Card
 - Caste Certificate, PwD Certificate by the appropriate authority, in case of reserved category candidates.
- Candidates may obtain acknowledgement on the printout of online application form duly signed and stamped with date from the Institution for future reference.
- Provisional admission to the candidate(s) will be given by the Institutions as per their choice of course based on the National Merit list subject to verification of the documents.
- Once provisional admission is given by the Training Institute, the candidate will
 not allowed to change the course under any circumstances.
- Prescribed Admission fee (Maximum Rs. 40,000/- per year) to be deposited by the candidate at Training Institute to confirm admission and obtain receipt of the same.

6. Candidates who could not get admission in 1st Round, may be given opportunity to take admission in the subsequent rounds, subject to the availability of vacant seats and fulfilment of the other prescribed conditions issued by the Council in due course.

General Guidelines and Instructions for RCI approved training institutions for admission to Diploma Level Courses through Centralized Online Admission Process for the academic session 2020-21.

- During the 1st and subsequent rounds of admission provisional admission to be granted to the candidates strictly as per the merit list of the concerned Training Institutions in Diploma Level Courses in respective disability areas for the academic year 2020-21.
- Head of the Institutions shall strictly adhere to the reservation policy of the concerned State Govt. for admission of OBC, SC, ST & PWD candidates as per the approved intake. Head of the Institution shall be solely responsible for any kind of deviation in this regard.
- The Training Institution shall nominate a Coordinator well versed with the admission process for admission to Diploma Level Courses and display his name, mobile number, e-mail ID etc. on their website as well as on the Notice Board.
- Help Desk to be set up in the institute to facilitate the candidates for hassle free admission during the admission period between 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.
- Training Institutions shall be responsible for verification of original documents submitted by the candidates before admission as per merit list and choice of course.
- One set of all the documents submitted by the candidates to be retained by the training institutions for future reference.
- Candidates to be given acknowledgement for admission duly signed and stamped with date by the Institute. Refusal of the acknowledgement to candidate reported for the admission will be viewed seriously by the Council.
- No additional amount or fee to be charged from the candidates except the course fee (Maximum Rs. 40,000/- per year) prescribed by the Council.
- Head of the Institution will submit the final list of admitted candidates on the prescribed format online as per the admission schedule.
- Institution has to ensure that admission is taken from the merit list only sent by the Council to
 each training institution separately. Admission taken out of the merit list will be treated as
 invalid.
- Candidates whose verification to be done by the Council as per Circular no. 25-15/NBER(AIAOT)/2016/RCI date 5th Nov., 2020 may be considered for admission to their choice of course and institutions on receipt of the confirmation from the Council.
