Function of the State Coordination Committee :

Subject to the provisions of this Act, the function of the State Coordination Committee shall be to serve as the State Focal Point on disability matters and facilitates continuous evolution of a comprehensive policy towards solving the problem faced by persons with disabilities.

In particular and without prejudice to the generally of the foregoing function, the State Coordination Committee may within the State Performa all or any of the following functions namely: -

Review and coordinate the activities of all the Departments of Government and other Governmental and non- Governmental organisation which are dealing with matters relating to persons with disabilities.

Develop a State policy to address issued faced by persons with disabilities.

Advice the State Government on the formulation of policies programmes legislation and projects with respect to disability.

Review in consultation with the donor agencies their fixing policies from the perspective of their impact on persons with disabilities.

Take such other steps to ensure barrier free environment in public places, public utilities, schools and other institutions.

Monitor and evaluate the impact of policies and programmes designed for achieving equality and full participation of persons with disabilities.

To perform such other functions as may be prescribed by the State Government.

The State Coordination Committee shall meet at least once in every six months and shall observe such rules of procedure in regard to the transaction of business at its meetings as many prescribed.

Save as otherwise provided by under this Act, a Member of a State Coordination Committee nominated under clause (f) of sub-section 2 of section 13 shall be held office for terms of two years from the date of his nomination.

Function of the State Executive Committee:

The State Executive Committee shall be the executive body of the State Coordination Committee and shall be responsible for carrying out the decisions of the State Coordination Committee.

Without prejudice to the provisions of sub-section (1) the State Executive Committee shall also perform such other functions as may be delegated to it by State Coordination Committee.

The State Executive Committee shall meet at least once in three months and shall observe such rules of procedure in regard to the transaction of business at its meetings as may be proscribed by the State Government.

The State Coordination Committee shall be bound by such directions in writing as the Central Coordination Committee or the State government may give to it.

Subject: - Reservation for Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes (Block 'A' & 'B') Ex-servicemen and physically handicapped persons in direct recruitment of Class-III and Class-IV Government Jobs.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Government instructions issued vide No. 22/36/95-3GSIII, dated 20.7.95 on the subject cited above and to say that vide these instruction. 3% Horizontal reservation in direct recruitment to Class-III and Class-IV posts was provided to physically handicapped (Orthopaedically Handicapped, Deaf & Dumb and Blind). But keeping in view 'THE PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES, PROTECTION OF RIGHTS AND FULL PARTICIPATION) ACT, 1995' passed by Parliament this matter has further been considered and after careful consideration the State Government has now decided to convert the present 3% 'Horizontal' reservation into 'Vertical' reservation (Deaf or blindness or low vision, 1% for hearing impairment and B for Locomotor disability or cerebral palsy persons) in direct recruitment of Class-III and IV posts. In a block of 100 post in each cadre the posts No. 33, 66 and 97 shall be filled up by the physically handicapped.

These instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned working under you for strict compliance.
