2. The functions of the Committee will be:-
- a. Ensuring formulation and implementation of the Campaign including in districts covered under District Nasha Mukht Campaign.
 - b. Conducting awareness generation programmes in all schools and colleges in the district for students, teachers and parents.
 - c. Formulation of students' clubs in colleges to discuss and spread awareness.
 - d. Identification of victims and users, and taking them to Rehabilitation Centers/Hospitals for counseling and treatment.
 - e. Monitoring of counseling and treatment facilities in the district.
 - f. Ensuring strict implementation of ban on sale of cigarettes within 100 meters of educational institutions.
 - g. Obtaining information on the availability/sale of drugs and review the action taken on such information.
 - h. Visit institutions, hospitals which are providing services.
 - i. Conducting training programmes for the service providers at district level and below district level.
 - j. To increase community participation and public cooperation.
 - k. Having a social media strategy for the District campaign and implementation of the same.
 - l. Feedback on the progress to the State Level Committee and to the Ministry.
 - m. Identifying volunteers in the community, giving them ID card/badge, training them as a community peer for spreading awareness in the community.
 - n. The Committee will review the progress of cases detected/raided by respective agencies during the month by coordinating/sharing the intelligence about drug trafficking.
 - o. The Committee will submit its report to Health DGHS, with a copy to Director, Social Justice and Empowerment Department and ADGP (Crime).
 - p. The Committee shall also take all appropriate actions for proper implementation of orders issued from time to time by Hon'ble High Court in CWP No.20359 of 2013-Court on its own Motion Vs. State of Punjab etc.

3. The order issued vide No.268/SW(4)/2016 dated 15.03.2016 constituting the District Level Coordination Committee and order issued vide No.269/SW(4)/2016 dated 15.03.2016 constituting the District Level Social Mobilization Committee are hereby superseded with immediate effect.
4. The Committee shall function as District Level Nasha Mukta Bharat Campaign Committee in districts covered under the Nasha Mukta Bharat Campaign.
5. The Committee shall meet once in a month.

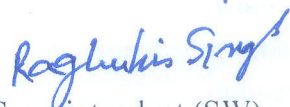
