Tourism- An Overview

- Tourism in India is important for the country's economy and is growing rapidly. The World Travel and Tourism Council calculated that tourism generated ₹16.91 lakh crore (US\$240 billion) or 9.2% of India's GDP in 2019 and supported 42.673 million jobs, 8.1% of its total employment.
- The sector is predicted to grow at an annual rate of 6.9% to ₹32.05 lakh crore (US\$450 billion) by 2028 (9.9% of GDP).
- The Travel and Tourism Competitiveness Report 2019 ranked India 16th out of 140 countries overall.
