The Task Force may co-opt any other officer/ expert, as and when required.

The charter of function of the UT Level Task Force shall be as follows:-

- i. To assess technological solutions being currently adopted by different Agencies/Police Organizations on various issues and identify technological requirements.
- ii. To explore technology that would result in improving policing, develop applications to adopt technology for meeting the requirements, run pilot study to assess the efficacy of the solution, and work with industry to develop and roll out the customised application.
- iii. To study such solutions, identify overlapping efforts, standardize existing solutions and disseminate applications to other forces for similar use. It is imperative that technological solution is inter-operable.
- iv. To explore applications being used in other Government Departments and Institutions and adopt them for police organisation. Conversely, applications devised for police could be shared with other users.
- v. To focus on special requirements, such as requirements in megacities, in insurgency-affected areas, in the field of communication, security of vital installations, big data analytics, voice and facial recognition, training, forensics, etc.
- vi. To promote networking of Police Organizations with Educational and Industrial Bodies in order to utilize their expertise in devising technological solutions for policing.
