I. About Department: -

Brief information of the department:

The Department of Technical Education and Skill Development Ladakh, came into existenceafter formation of Ladakh as a new Union Territory in 2019, having under its ambit Polytechnic Colleges and Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).

The Department has 02 ITIs and 02 Polytechnic Colleges one each at Leh and Kargil, operating under the administrative control of Technical Education and Skill Development Department.

The Ladakh Skill Development Mission (LSDM), a two-tier structure comprising of the Governing Council and Executive Committee has been constituted in the Union Territory in the year 2021, registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860. The Mission will be the single point of the UT Administration to formulate and steer various skill development schemes and to bring necessary synergy, oversight and effective coordination in the implementation of various Skill development schemes across the Departments in the UT of Ladakh. The Ladakh Skill Development Mission conducts "Short Term Trainings" in various job roles and is also the implementing agency of the SANKALP Scheme of the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, Gol.

Further District Skill Committees (DSCs) at District Level (Leh & Kargil) have been constituted with the Deputy Commissioner of the respective districts as the Chairperson of the DSCs.

Vision: -

Our vision is to create constant opportunities for the youth of Ladakh to be able to acquire skills of choice and to support them with the means of creating sustainable livelihoods.

To coordinate the efforts and policies regarding Skill Development and empowering all individuals especially the youth of Ladakh through improved skills, knowledge, nationally recognized qualifications to gain access to decent employment and eliminate the problem of unemployment.

- 1. To constantly strive and integrate the efforts of various departments engaged in skilling the youth of Union Territory of Ladakh.
- 2. To bring necessary scale, synergy, oversight and effective coordination in the implementation of various Skill development schemes.
- 3. To Improve the quality of Training, Staff and Infrastructure of Government ITIs and Polytechnics.
- 4. To Facilitate the development of entrepreneurs.
- 5. To provide the best possible technical education facilities for training of youth in job relevant sectors.
- 6. To Promoting research and development in Institutions so as to inculcate Entrepreneurial culture.

Citizen Charter:

The Department of Technical Education and Skill Development conducts Diploma level courses through the Govt. Polytechnics (Leh & Kargil) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (1 year/2 year/6 months) courses, Short Term Training courses through the Industrial Training Institutes.

Conducts Short Term Training courses in collaboration with various SkillSector Councils and reputed institutions. 

VI. Short Term Trainings

VII. Events & Activities

1. Ladakh Education Fair

The first Ladakh Education Fair 2022 organised by Higher Education Department in collaboration with Ladakh Skill Development Mission and University of Ladakh, was hosted by the Government Degree Colleges of Ladakh at Leh, Kargil, Nubra, Drass, Zanskar and Sankoo. 'Ladakh Education Fair 2022' targeted the students of Higher Secondary Schools of Class X-XII and their parents, students of ITIs, Polytechnic Colleges besides students of Colleges itself and offered counselling on choice of subjects, career guidance, apprise students about various scholarship schemes of GoI and Ladakh Administration and facilitated them for applying for the Scholarships besides exposing students to skilling and apprenticeship opportunities. Free Psychometric Tests for students and Career Counselling was also available at the Ladakh Education Fair.

Stalls were set up by Sector Skill Councils Paints and Coating Sector Skill Council, Handicrafts and Carpet Sector Skill Council, Food Industry Capacity and Skill Initiative, Apparel, made-Ups & Home Furnishing Sector Skill Council, Beauty & Wellness Sector Skill Council, Media & Entertainment Sector Skill Council and Skill Council for Green. Various Banks also set up their stalls at the venue and made students aware about the education loan.

The technical sessions included panel discussion on Subject choices which has Faculty of Humanities and Social sciences who interacted with students of Class XI-XII and detailed out the scope and expanse of their respective subjects so that students make infomed choice while

seeking admissison in colleges in coming years. Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, L K Mathur virtually inaugurated the fair and also launched the Ladakh Skill Development Portal (https://lsdm.ladakh.gov.in).

Chairman, LAHDC Kargil, Feroz Ahmed Khan, C. Phuntsok (IAS retd), Deputy Chairman, LAHDC Leh, Tsering Angchuk, Executive Councillor, LAHDC Leh, Stanzin Chosphel and Vice-Chancellor, UoL, Prof SK Mehta were present at the venues and the inaugural session was webcast at all the six venues followed by separate technical sessions at each venue.

Prof. S K Mehta (Vice Chancellor, UoL), Magsaysay awardee, Sonam Wangchuk (Founder HAIL), Dr Norden Otzer (Otolaryngologist); Ms Zahra Begum (Lecturer Technical Education), Dr Tashi Tundup (Psychiatrist) and other luminaries spoke on a wide range of topics like career options in alternative education, career opportunities: an insight for one and all, apprenticeship training programme awareness, scope of research and publication and other significant topics. All the sessions throughout the fair were open to interaction in which students asked questions to the experts and deliberated upon respective challenges faced by them and explored solutions with the experts.

Aim of the Apprenticeship and Self-Employment Mela:-

• Combined industry drive and apprenticeship mela for onboarding of establishment for engagement of apprentices under the apprenticeship Act 1961.

- Interactive session with the students with successful entrepreneurs.
- Presentation to educate the students about various schemes of the MSDE, Gol.
- Bank representatives present in the Mela thoroughly explained the schemes and guided the students on how to avail benefits of the various schemes.
- National Banks, State Banks, Public Sector Undertaking like NHPC, PGCIL along with UT Administration Departments like District Industries Centre and Employment Department participated in the Mela.
- On the spot loan clearance to the ITI pass-outs/ youth in order to encourage them to take up entrepreneurial activities was also facilitated at the Mela.

- 5. Under PMKVY 3.0 (DGT Component) ITI Leh & ITI Kargil have conducted Short Term Training (STT) under PMKVY 3.0 (DGT Component) in the number of courses of 3 months duration namely; Plumber General, Assistant Fashion Designer, Self Employed Tailor, Automotive Service Technician, Junior Software Developer.
- 6. Special Short term training courses have been conducted for Ladakh Police Personnels at Govt. ITI Leh/Kargil on request of the Ladakh Police.
- 7. Latest Machinery Equipment's have been procured for Polytechnic Leh/Kargil & ITI Leh/Kargil, besides installation of 03 Smart Classrooms at Polytechnic Leh.
- 8. Various infrastructure projects have also been initiated in the Polytechnics & ITIs.
- 9. Library Management Systems have been installed at Polytechnic Leh & Kargil.
- 10. In bid to attract good faculty for the Polytechnic Colleges and to improve the academic activities in Polyethnic Colleges, the honorarium of Guest Faculty has been enhanced to Rs. 25000/- per month for Degree holder and Rs. 23000/- per month for diploma holder, w.e.f:-21.07.2021.
- 11. To make the classrooms & workshops fully winter friendly Heating System has been installed at Govt. ITI Kargil.
- 12. Photovoltaic Solar Power Plant of 25 KWp has been installed at Govt. Polytechnic Leh and Govt. Polytechnic Kargil.
- 13. Development of Landscape and beautification of campus has been done at Govt. Polytechnic Kargil.
- 14. For last two years more than 80% Seats have filled up at Govt. Polytechnic Leh/Kargil.
