1. Scope of Consultancy

The scope of work for which tender is invited comprises hiring the Services of Consultant for Conservation of Heritage Site as under:-

- a) Conservation, Facade Improvement & Development of Old Leh Town, Leh
- b) Conservation of Hanlay Monastery Nobra Leh with Site Development.
