PROCEDURE FOR APPOINTMENT OF NOTARY PUBLIC

Application for appointment as a Notary

As per Rule 4(1) of Notaries Rule, 1956, a person (hereinafter called "the applicant") may make an application (in original) for appointment as a notary. The applications in this regard can be sent on following:

Form-I meant for those Advocates who have been

- a) Practice experience of at least for 10 years i.e. 10 years' experience from the date of the enrolment in the concerned Bar Council, which is to be ascertained and certified from the respective District Judge or Presiding Officer of the Court or Tribunal where he actually practiced as an Advocate.
- b) Practice experience of at least 07 years for those belonging to Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes / Other Backward Classes / Woman / a person with benchmark disability as defined in clause (r) of section 2 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016) i.e. 07 years' experience from the date of the enrolment in the concerned Bar Council, which is to be ascertained and certified from the respective District Judge or Presiding Officer of the Court or Tribunal where he actually practiced as an Advocate.

Form-II is meant for those Retired Government Officers who had been

- a) A member of the Indian Legal Service under the Central Government, or
- b) He had been at least for 10 years,
 - i. A member of Judicial Service; or
 - ii. Held an office under the Central Government or a State Government requiring special knowledge of law after enrolment as an Advocate; or
 - iii. Held an office in the department of Judge Advocate General or in the legal department of the armed forces.

Documents to be attached with the Application Form:

a) An Attested copy of the Matriculation Certificate (for date of birth);

- b) An Attested copy of the Original Graduation Degree Certificate;
- c) An Attested copy of the Original LLB Degree Certificate whether 3 years or five years;
- d) An Attested copy of the Original Enrolment Certificate issued from the concerned Bar Council;
- e) Name in the application form should be same as that in the Enrolment Certificate issued from the Bar Council, if any Advocates want to change his/her name, generally in case of Women after marriage he/she has to change his/her name in the Enrolment Certificate also;
- f) Married Women Advocates should attach an attested copy of the Marriage Certificate;
- g) Domicile / Resident Certificate along with the cast certificate;
- h) Disability Certificate on the prescribed format in case of a person with benchmark disability;

Note. Candidates, whose names have not been recommended by the Interview Board earlier, may apply afresh.
