**Notification,
Ladakh, the 18 of September, 2025**

S.O. 107. — In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Contractors Act, 1956 (*Act No. XVI of 1956*) in its application to the Union territory of Ladakh and in supersession of the Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Contractors Rules, 1991; the Lieutenant Governor of Union territory of Ladakh hereby makes the following rules, namely. —

1. Short title, commencement and application. —

(1) These rules may be called the **Union Territory of Ladakh Registration of Contractors Rules, 2025.**

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

(3) They shall apply to the following Departments, in the Administration of Union territory of Ladakh, which require to execute civil / construction works:

- (a) Public Works (Roads & Buildings) Department,
- (b) Public Health Engineering / Irrigation & Flood Control Department,
- (c) Mechanical Engineering,
- (d) Power Development Department,
- (e) Rural Development Department (Rural Engineering Wing),
- (f) Tourism Department, and
- (g) Any other Department which may require to execute civil / construction works.

2. Definitions. — (1) In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires, —

- (a) **"Act"** means the Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Contractors Act, 1956 (*Act No XVI of 1956*) in its application to the Union territory of Ladakh;
- (b) **"Contractor"** means contractor registered as such under these rules;
- (c) **"Form"** means a Form appended to these rules;
- (d) **"Department"** means Departments as mentioned in sub-rule (3) of rule 1;
- (e) **"Register"** means the Register of Contractors maintained under these rules;
- (f) **"Competent Authority"** means:
 - (i) Chief Engineer in the Department of Public Works (Roads & Buildings) and / or Public Health Engineering / Irrigation and Flood Control, in respect of 'Class A'.

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(ii) Superintending Engineer in the Departments of Public Works (Roads & Buildings) and / or Public Health Engineering / Irrigation and Flood Control in respect of Class 'B', 'C' and 'D'.

(2) All words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meanings as assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Contractors Act, 1956 (Act No. XVI of 1956) in its application to the Union territory of Ladakh; and Union territory of Ladakh Reorganization (Adaptation of State Laws) Order, 2020.

3. Categories, classification of contractors and area of operation. —

(1) The enlistment of Contractors shall be done in the following three categories:—

- (a) Civil Works;
- (b) Sanitary and Water Supply Works; and
- (c) Internal Electrical Works.

(2) There shall be following classes of civil works contractors in each Department, namely: —

Class	Limits upto which works can be allotted	Areas of operation
Class "A"	Any amount above Rupees eighty (80) lakhs	Union Territory of Ladakh.
Class "B"	Any amount above Rupees fifty (50) lakhs upto Rupees two hundred and fifty (250) lakhs	
Class "C"	Any amount above Rupees twenty-five (25) lakhs upto Rupees hundred (100) lakhs	
Class "D"	Any amount upto Rupees fifty (50) lakhs	

4. Eligibility. —

(1) No person shall be eligible for being registered as a contractor under these rules unless: —

(a) In the case of **Class 'A'** contractors, the firm or individual: —

- (i) should have successfully and satisfactorily completed as a Class 'B' contractor at least two works of an aggregate value of not less than Rupees 20.00 lakhs, for women contractors not less than Rupees 10.00 lakhs and should have worked as a Class 'B' contractor for two years;
- (ii) shall be required to employ technical staff at the time of award of works on the following basis: —

- a. For works costing Rupees twenty lakhs to fifty lakhs. At least one Degree holder (Civil) and one Diploma holder (Civil) or (Mechanical).
- b. For works costing between Rupees ten lakhs to Rupees twenty lakhs. At least one Diploma Holder (Civil).


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(iii) possess the following plant and equipment, namely:—

Truck or tipper	1
Concrete Mixer	2
Concrete vibrator	2
Compressor	1
Diesel Generating set with welding plant	1
Concrete Compression Testing Machine	1
Surveying Level	1; and

(iv) in case of technically qualified individual or firms the field requirement in respect of construction of civil works by an individual / any one of the partners of the firm required shall be five years for a Degree holder in Civil Engineering and ten years for a Diploma holder in Civil Engineering.

(b) In the case of **Class 'B'** contractors the firm or individual: —

(i) should have successfully and satisfactorily completed as a Class 'C' contractor at least two works of an aggregate value of not less than Rupees 10.00 lakhs, (for women contractors not less than Rupees 8.00 lakhs) and should have worked as a Class 'C' contractor for two years; and

(ii) shall be required to employ at least one Diploma Holder (Civil) at the time of award of works costing Rupees 10.00 lakhs (Rupees 8.00 lakhs in case of women contractors), and

(iii) possess the following plant and equipment, namely: —

Truck or tipper	1
Concrete Mixer	1
Concrete vibrator	2, and

(iv) in case of technically qualified individual or firms, the field requirement in respect of construction of civil works by an individual or any one of the partners of the firm required shall be three years for a Degree holder in Civil Engineering and three years for a Diploma holder in Civil Engineering.

(c) In the case of **Class 'C'** contractor the individual or firm: —

(i) should have successfully and satisfactorily completed as a contractor at least two works of an aggregate value of not less than Rupees 2.00 lakhs (in case of women contractors not less than Rupees 1.00 lakh), and should have worked as Class 'D' contractor for two years; and

(ii) possess the following plant and equipment namely:—

Concrete Mixer	1
Concrete vibrator	1, and


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Provided that no field experience shall be required for enlistment in this class for Degree and Diploma holder in Civil Engineering.

- (d) In the case of **Class 'D'** contractors, the individual or firm: —
(i) should have worked with at least any registered 'D' Class contractor for a period of one year (six months in case of women contractors) and has/have acquainted himself/themselves sufficient elementary knowledge required for execution of Civil Works. The certificate to this effect should among other things indicate the name of work where the applicant has worked:

Provided that no field experience shall be required for enlistment in this class for Degree and Diploma holder in Civil Engineering.

5. Application for Registration. —

(1) An application for registration by a person or firm intending to carry on business as a contractor of a particular class shall be submitted to the Competent Authority in *Form I*, along with following certificates/affidavits, namely: —

- (a) Ladakh Resident Certificate;
- (b) Solvency certificate from a Scheduled Bank (for all classes except Class 'D' and women contractors);
- (c) Property Certificate issued by Tehsildar concerned; except in case of private limited company, limited liability partnership or public company registered under Company Act, 2013 and in case for application for Class "D" registration.
- (d) Certificate of Plant & Machinery indicating possession of sufficient shuttering material issued by not less than the rank of Assistant Executive Engineer;
- (e) Legal bond to the effect that machinery and immovable property declared by him/them is free from all encumbrances except the mortgage of the lending bank/public sector financial institutions and will not be transferred or disposed of by him/them without specific authorization of the Registering Authority (for all classes);
- (f) Legal bond authorizing the Department to recover any money due from him / them on any account by sale, auction of his / their movable property (for all classes);
- (g) Character certificate to be issued by an officer being not below the rank of Superintendent of Police of the District concerned after due verification from CID;
- (h) Certificate from Chief Engineer or District Superintending Engineer concerned that the applicant(s) has not / have not backed out from any contract and the work and conduct in relation to works of any of the Department have been satisfactorily executed and has / have not been blacklisted; and
- (i) An affidavit (for all classes) to the effect: —
 - (i) that the applicant has not been enlisted earlier or refused enlistment or blacklisted;
 - (ii) that the applicant is not already in service in any Government Department / Corporation or Undertaking or a Member of either House of the Parliament, Legislature or LAHDC or a student of any Educational Institute or in receipt of any stipend from the Government;


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- (iii) that the applicant(s) if a retired employee(s) of Government / Corporation or Undertaking is not disallowed for undertaking contract works under Service Conduct Rules of the Government / Corporation / Undertaking from where he has retired;
- (iv) that the applicant has not been declared insolvent by a court of competent jurisdiction;
- (v) that the applicant has not been convicted of an offence by any competent court under any act / law; and
- (vi) that the applicant(s) has not / have not backed out from any contract in Public Works Department or any other Department(s).

(2) On receipt of application accompanied by certificates and affidavits indicated in sub-rule (1) the applicant or authorized representative of the firm seeking enlistment may be called upon for personal attendance before the Competent Authority.

(3) The Competent Authority to whom application has been made shall thereupon scrutinize the application and unless the applicant is found ineligible, he shall enter the contents of the application in a register maintained by him for the purpose and inform the applicant accordingly for payment of the registration fee, prescribed hereunder: —

(4) The applicant may be registered even for a Class lower than that applied for.

6. Grounds of refusal of registration. —

Notwithstanding anything contained in rule 4, the Competent Authority may refuse registration or renewal of registration of a person/firm under these rules on any of the following grounds, namely: —

- (a) if he has been declared as insolvent by a court of competent jurisdiction and has not been discharged; or
- (b) if he is convicted for an offence punishable under Chapters XVII and XVIII of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023; or
- (c) if the Competent Authority is of the opinion that the contractor has habitually backed out from the contract tendered by him in the Public Works Department or any other Department(s); or
- (d) if the Competent Authority is of the opinion that the work and conduct of the applicant have not been satisfactory in relation to the work of the Public Works (R&B) Department or any other Department(s) executed by him in the past.


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7. Notice for refusal. —

If the Competent Authority proposes to refuse registration of an applicant on any ground mentioned above in rule 6, he shall serve upon the applicant a notice indicating the ground on which the registration is proposed to be refused and the applicant may either himself or through his authorized agent submit his objections, if any, regarding the contemplated order of the refusal within a period of ten (10) days.

8. Order of refusal. —

If the Competent Authority is of the opinion that the objections filed by the applicant are not satisfactory, he shall pass orders refusing the registration and communicate the orders to the applicant.

9. Issue of certificate. —

(1) The Competent Authority to whom application, has been made shall thereupon scrutinize the application and, unless the applicant is ineligible under rule 4 or the registration or renewal thereof is refused under rule 5 or 6 and ensuring that the contents of the application have been recorded in a register maintained by the Department for the purpose, issue a certificate of registration of the class in *Form II*.

(2) Once the certificate of registration has been issued, the contractor shall be eligible to purchase a tender form against fee to be prescribed by the tender inviting authority depending upon the cost of the tender document vis-a-vis cost of work and, thereafter cast his tender in the manner so stipulated.

10. Validity of Certificate. —

(1) The certificate of registration under these rules shall be valid for one consecutive financial year (including the one during which the certificate of registration is issued) and shall be renewable after every financial year, subject to the provisions of these rules.

(2) The certificate of registration shall be got renewed preferably before the end of the financial year in which the validity expires or latest before the end of the month of April following that financial year. Fresh affidavits/certificates shall be required to be furnished in respect of the below mentioned requirements: —

- (a) Income Tax clearance certificate pertaining to preceding year;
- (b) An affidavit to the effect: —
 - (i) that the applicant has not been blacklisted;
 - (ii) that the applicant is not already in service in any Government Department, Corporation or Undertaking or a Member of either House of the Parliament, Legislature or LAHDC or a student of any educational institution or in receipt of any stipend from the Government; and
 - (iii) that the applicant has not been declared insolvent by any court of competent jurisdiction.
- (c) Besides the above affidavit, the following certificates shall be produced while seeking renewal of registration: —
 - (i) Character certificate to be issued by an officer not less than the rank of Superintendent of Police of concerned District after verification from CID;
 - (ii) A certificate to be issued by an officer not less than the rank of Superintending Engineer concerned that the applicant has not/have not


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backed out from the contract in Public Works Department or any other Department(s) as the case may be;

(iii) A certificate to be issued by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer that the applicant's work and conduct remained satisfactory in relation to work of Public Works Department or any other Department, as the case may be and the quality of work executed by the contractor remained good;

(iv) A certificate to be issued by an officer not below the rank of Assistant Executive Engineer that the applicant has not been a defaulter in making payment to the labour engaged by him and there has not been or is any labour claim/award pending against him in a labour court on account of works allotted.

(3) An application for renewal of registration shall be made to the Competent Authority in *Form III* and shall be accompanied by the following fees for a period of 5 years:

(i)	Class A	Rs. 12,500/-
(ii)	Class B	Rs. 6,250/-
(iii)	Class C	Rs. 3,250/-
(iv)	Class D	Rs. 1,250/-

(4) In case any contractor fails to renew the registration as specified above, the registration can be renewed after charging a penalty equal to the renewal fee. However, if a contractor fails to renew his registration for two consecutive terms, it will automatically cease to be operative and he shall have to apply for a fresh registration, if he is desirous of continuing his business.

11. Suspension or blacklisting. —

(1) If at any time, after a person is registered as a contractor, the Competent Authority is satisfied that such contractor has incurred any of the disqualifications in these rules, he shall serve a notice upon the contractor, indicating the ground on which it is proposed to suspend or black-list or remove his name from the register, to show cause why such order should not be issued.

(2) If the Competent Authority is of the opinion that the explanation tendered by the contractor is not satisfactory, he shall pass an order of suspension or blacklisting or removal of the name of the contractor from the register and such order shall be communicated to the contractor:

Provided that no such order of suspension or black-listing or removal shall prevent the contractor from executing and completing the works or effect his rights and obligations in respect of any contract sanctioned to him in that Department or any other Department while the registration was in force.

12. Communication of orders. —

All orders passed by the Competent Authority under rule 11 shall be communicated to the Department and also be got published in the Official Gazette.

13. Contractors from outside the UT of Ladakh. —

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The provisions of Rule 3 in respect of the works which can be allotted, shall apply to such contractors from outside the Union territory of Ladakh, who offer to execute the works in the Union territory of Ladakh in response to all India or the global tenders.

Provided that, they shall be registered in the respective Class under the relevant Rules / enactment under any State Government, Union territory Administration, or the Government of India.

14. Repeal and saving. —

(1) The Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Contractors Rules, 1991 are hereby repealed in its application to the Union territory of Ladakh.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything duly done or any action taken in exercise of any powers conferred by or under the said rules shall be deemed to have been done or taken in exercise of the powers conferred by or under these rules.



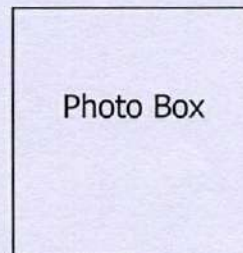
