Union of India and Others (Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202 of 1995) that acted as a precursor to the CAF Act, 2016 and CAF Rules, 2018.

ACF (H/Q) informed about the institutional mechanisms provided in the CAF Act, 2016 at the National and State/UT level for the management and utilization of funds 4.1.2 received from the User Agencies towards Compensatory Afforestation, Additional Compensatory Afforestation, Penal Compensatory Afforestation, Net Present Value and other amounts under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. He also discussed about the organisational set up of the Ladakh CAMPA Authority, i.e., the Governing Body, Steering Committee and the Executive Committee.

He further discussed in brief about the account heads for operating the CAMPA Funds.

4.2 AGENDA 2: Fund position of Ladakh CAMPA

4.2.1 ACF apprised that after the formation of Ladakh CAMPA, an amount of Rs 249.27 Cr has been transferred to the Ladakh CAMPA by the National Authority vide MoEFCC letter No.1-15/2012-CAMPA dated 7th December 2020. He also delved in brief about the manner of utilisation of Net Present Value (NPV) realised from the User Agency, in accordance with the CAF Rules, 2018.

4.3 DISCUSSION

- **APOs of Forest Department** 4.3.1
 - 4.3.1.1 The abstract of Annual Plan of Operations (APOs) of Leh and Kargil Forests Divisions were presented. The total proposal for Kargil and Leh Forests Divisions are Rs 1197.405 Lakh and Rs 897.442 Lakh respectively.
 - 4.3.1.2 The authorities sought the micro plans of the abstract plan. Micro plans indicating geo locations of unit wise activities proposed, physical and financial targets were provided as asked for.
 - 4.3.1.3 Sh. Tsewang Gyalson, CPO Leh and Sh. Tahir Hussain, Director Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, sought details regarding the pasture development in Leh Forests Division in terms of benefits to local communities. Details of pasture development were given as requested. DFO, Leh informed that the local people cut the grasses from forest units for livestock feeding and some royalty is also charged for the same. Wildlife Warden, Leh informed that pastures are being developed for habitat improvement in case of Wildlife Protected areas.



been kept in the 'establishment, operation and maintenance of rescue centre and veterinary treatment facilities for wild animals' and an additional amount of Rs. 1.24 crore has been kept in the "management of biological diversity and biological resources" component to prevent the Human Animal Conflict. Also, Sh. Raza Ali Abidi, Wildlife Warden, Kargil Wildlife Division stated that the APO of Wildlife Division, Kargil has mainly been prepared from the point of view of Human-Animal Conflict Management.

4.3.2.5 Sh. Bhatti enquired about the reason for less fund (Rs 43 Lakh) being kept under "publicity-cum-awareness programme and exhibition on the various schemes being implemented by the State Authority from State Fund" for Kargil Wildlife Division as compared to Rs 3 crore for Leh Wildlife Division. He stated that Kargil Wildlife Division should spend more on publicity cum awareness so as to sensitize the local public about wildlife issues. The Chairman assured him that the funds under the said component for Kargil Wildlife Division will be enhanced.

4.3.3 Manpower for smooth functioning of State CAMPA Authority under CEO, CAMPA/CCF

4.3.3.1 The Chairman stated that under section 6(f) of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016, the interest accrued on the amounts available in the State Fund can be utilized for the non-recurring and recurring expenditure including the salary and allowances payable to its officers and other employees. For this, a proposal for "Manpower for smooth functioning of State CAMPA Authority under CEO, CAMPA/CCF" has been kept with a total yearly budget of Rs 49.20 Lakh. A detailed list of employees to be hired, along with the qualification, experience required and monthly remuneration was also shown to the members of the Executive Committee.



The Chairman welcomed all the inputs and thanked everyone for the valuable contribution in discussions during the 1st meeting of the Executive Committee of Ladakh CAMPA, Union Territory of Ladakh.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the Chairman.
