NOTIFICATION

Ladakh, the 12th of November, 2025

S.O. 130.-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi Notification No. S.O 5088(E) dated 1st November, 2022 and in supersession of all earlier notifications on the subject matter, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator) of Union territory of Ladakh, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Lecturer-I (Engineering) in the Ladakh Technical Education & Skill Development Department(Polytechnic Sector) namely:

1. Short title and commencement: -

- (a) These rules may be called the Ladakh Administration, Lecturer-I (Engineering) in Ladakh Technical Education & Skill Development Department Recruitment Rules, 2025.
- (b) These rules shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix: -

The number of said post, its classification and level in the pay Matrix attached hereto shall be as specified in column 2, 3 & 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications: -

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, and other matters relating to said posts shall be as specified in paras 5 to 13 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

4. Provision for Resident Criteria for appointment by direct recruitment: -

The eligibility for appointment will be subject to residency requirements prescribed in any Act, Rule, Regulation or Order in force in the Union territory of Ladakh.

5. Disqualification: -

No person,

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living;

 OR
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person(s) shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator) of Ladakh may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law, applicable to such person(s) and the other party to the marriage or there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

- 6. Power to relax: Where the Lieutenant Governor Union Territory of Ladakh (Administrator) is of the opinion that, it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with UPSC, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- **7. Savings: -** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation in age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and the other special category of persons in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Administration of Union Territory of Ladakh.



- 2) Lecturer-I (Computer Engineering):-From Lecturer -II (Computer Engineering) in Level-6F in the Pay Matrix with six years of regular service in the grade.

Note 1: The eligibility service for promotion to the post of Lecturer -I (Civil Engineering)/ Lecturer -I (Computer Engineering) shall continue to be five years for persons holding the feeder post of Lecturer-II (Civil Engineering)/ Lecturer -II (Computer Engineering) on regular basis on the date of Notification of these rules possessing qualification of degree in Engineering or equivalent in the respective branch from a recognized University/Institute or 3 years diploma with 60 percent marks in respective branch of Engineering from a recognized Board/Institute.

Note 2: In case suitable candidates from the category of Lecturer-II (Civil Engineering) / Lecturer-II (Computer Engineering) are not available, the candidates holding posts of Demonstrator (Civil Engineering) / Demonstrator (Computer Engineering) in Level-6D in the pay matrix on regular basis on 31.10.2019 with six (06) years of regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis for persons holding bachelors degree in Relevant / Appropriate branch of Engineering or with eight (08) years of regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis for persons holding 3 years Diploma with minimum of 60 percent marks in Relevant / Appropriate branch of Engineering shall be considered for promotion to the post of Lecturer-I (Civil Engineering) / Lecturer-I (Computer Engineering).
