Subject: Institutionalisation of Sector-wise PRAGATI Reviews through Cascaded Review Mechanism – regarding.

The undersigned is directed to forward herewith a copy of communication received from Cabinet Secretariat; Government of India *vide F. No. 1/120/1/2026-TS dated 20.05.2026* regarding institutionalisation of Sector-wise PRAGATI Reviews through Cascaded Review Mechanism.

2. As per the communication, one major scheme may be identified every month for detailed review under the PRAGATI framework. The concerned Line Ministry/Department of Government of India shall upload implementation issues, bottlenecks, agenda points and information requirements on the PRAGATI Portal along with district-wise and State-wise data requirements.
3. All Administrative Secretaries/Heads of Departments/Deputy Commissioners shall ensure timely examination of issues uploaded on the PRAGATI Portal and furnish responses, comments, progress updates, best practices and specific constraints through designated PRAGATI logins issued through NIC.
4. Departments shall ensure necessary coordination with District Administrations and other stakeholders for timely submission of requisite information. Detailed review meetings may also be convened under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, UT Ladakh, for deliberation on implementation bottlenecks and coordination issues before escalation to the national level.
5. The outcomes of deliberations, action points and pending intervention issues shall be uploaded on the PRAGATI Portal in a timely manner. *The review process is required to be completed before the 20th of every month* to facilitate subsequent national-level consultations/workshops and PRAGATI review before the Hon'ble Prime Minister during the last week of the month.
6. The tentative calendar of Ministries/Departments and schemes identified for review under the PRAGATI framework is enclosed as Annexure-A for information and necessary action.

7. All concerned shall accord priority to the matter and ensure strict compliance of the directions issued by Cabinet Secretariat.



Office Memorandum

Subject: Institutionalisation of Sector-wise PRAGATI Reviews through Cascaded Review Mechanism

In pursuance of the directions issued during PRAGATI regarding institutionalisation of structured State-level reviews for major social sector and infrastructure schemes, it has been decided to operationalise a cascaded review mechanism prior to each PRAGATI meeting.


2. Under the proposed mechanism, one major scheme may be identified every month for detailed review. The concerned Line Ministry would upload key implementation issues, bottlenecks, agenda points and information requirements on the PRAGATI portal at the beginning of the month, along with district-wise and State-wise data requirements.
3. States/UTs and District Administrations would thereafter examine the issues and upload their responses, comments, progress updates, best practices and specific constraints on the portal through designated logins. The process is intended to facilitate structured consultations between the Government of India, States/UTs and District Administrations and create a common digital platform for issue tracking and resolution.
4. Based on the inputs received from districts and States/UTs, detailed review meetings may be convened first at the level of State Governments. The meetings may be convened by the Chief Secretaries and include the nodal State Department, District Administration and relevant stakeholders. Implementation bottlenecks and coordination issues may be deliberated comprehensively before escalation to the national level.
5. Outcomes of the deliberations, action points and pending intervention issues may thereafter be uploaded on the portal by the concerned Ministries/Departments. Thereafter, the concerned Central Ministry can convene a national level

consultation/workshop with all the State Governments/UTs. The meetings may be chaired by the concerned Minister of Government of India.

6. The issues emerging through the above consultative process would subsequently form part of the PRAGATI review before the Hon'ble Prime Minister during the last week of the month.

7. The above mechanism is intended to ensure that issues placed before PRAGATI are supported by adequate field-level examination, inter-governmental consultations and clearly identified action points, thereby enabling more focused and outcome-oriented deliberations.

8. The tentative schemes and Ministries for review in above framework are attached (**Annexure-A**). The same may be disseminated to concerned stakeholders for necessary action. It is expected that review meetings by Ministries/Departments are for 2-3 days and involve States and other stakeholders and are conducted before the 20th of every month. In these review meetings, chaired by the concerned Minister of Government of India, in addition to the detailed review of the selected PRAGATI Scheme, other important schemes of the Ministry/ Sector may also be reviewed.
