Subject: - Reporting of Projects approved in exercise of the financial powers delegated to the Lieutenant Governor, UT of Ladakh, under DFPRs, 2024 - reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer Ministry of Home Affairs' letter No.15020/11/2024-Plg.cell dated 02.01.2026, vide which powers for appraisal and approval of Projects upto Rs.100 crore under DFPRs, 2024, have been delegated to the Lieutenant Governor, UT of Ladakh. Para 1(d) of the said letter requires that details of all Projects approved under these delegated powers be furnished to the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, through the Ministry of Home Affairs, on a quarterly basis. This requirement has since been reiterated by the Ministry of Home Affairs vide its letter of even number dated 30.07.2026, with a request that the pending reports be sent urgently by 31.07.2026.

All Administrative Departments are, therefore, requested to furnish the details of Projects approved by the Lieutenant Governor, UT of Ladakh, under the above delegated powers, in the enclosed format, for the last quarter of FY 2025-26 (January to March 2026) and the first quarter of FY 2026-27 (April to June 2026).

The duly filled-in format may kindly be sent to this Department latest by 31.07.2026 at director-at@ladakh.gov.in, so that the information can be consolidated and forwarded to the Ministry of Home Affairs without further delay. Where no Project has been approved during the above period, a 'Nil' report may please be sent.

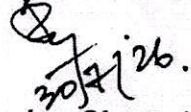
Subject: - Furnishing of quarterly reports on exercise of delegated financial powers by the Administrators/LGs of UTs (without legislature) - reg.

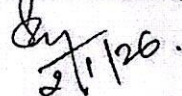
Subject: - Delegation of financial powers to the Administrators/ LGs of UTs (without legislature) - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to convey the approval of the competent authority for the delegation of powers for **appraisal and approval of projects upto Rs.100 crore** under DFPRs, 2024, to the Administrators/ LGs of the Union Territories of Andaman and Nicobar Islands (A&NI), Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu (DNHDD), Ladakh and Lakshadweep, subject to the following conditions-

- a. Such powers shall be exercised by the Administrator/ LG of the UT in consultation with Secretary (Finance)/ Financial Advisor equivalent of the respective UT.
 - b. Adequate budgetary provision shall be available.
 - c. The delegated powers shall not be further re-delegated.
 - d. Details of all proposals approved under these delegated powers shall be furnished to the Department of Expenditure through MHA on a quarterly basis by the end of July, October, January and April, respectively.
2. Further, the powers of Administrator/ LGs of abovesaid UTs to **sanction expenditure (from in-principle approval to final approval, including appraisal) on schemes**, as per delegated power may continue under Rule 16 of DFPRs, 2024, only after appraisal and approval of schemes by the concerned authorities in terms of Department of Expenditure's OM No.24(35)/PF-II/2012 dated 05.08.2016 of the Ministry of Finance.
 3. These powers are delegated in supersession of earlier order issued vide this Ministry's letter No.15020/11/2024-Plg.cell dated 19.09.2025.
 4. This issues with the approval of the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India vide OM No.01(13)2025-E.II(A) dated 26.12.2025.
